



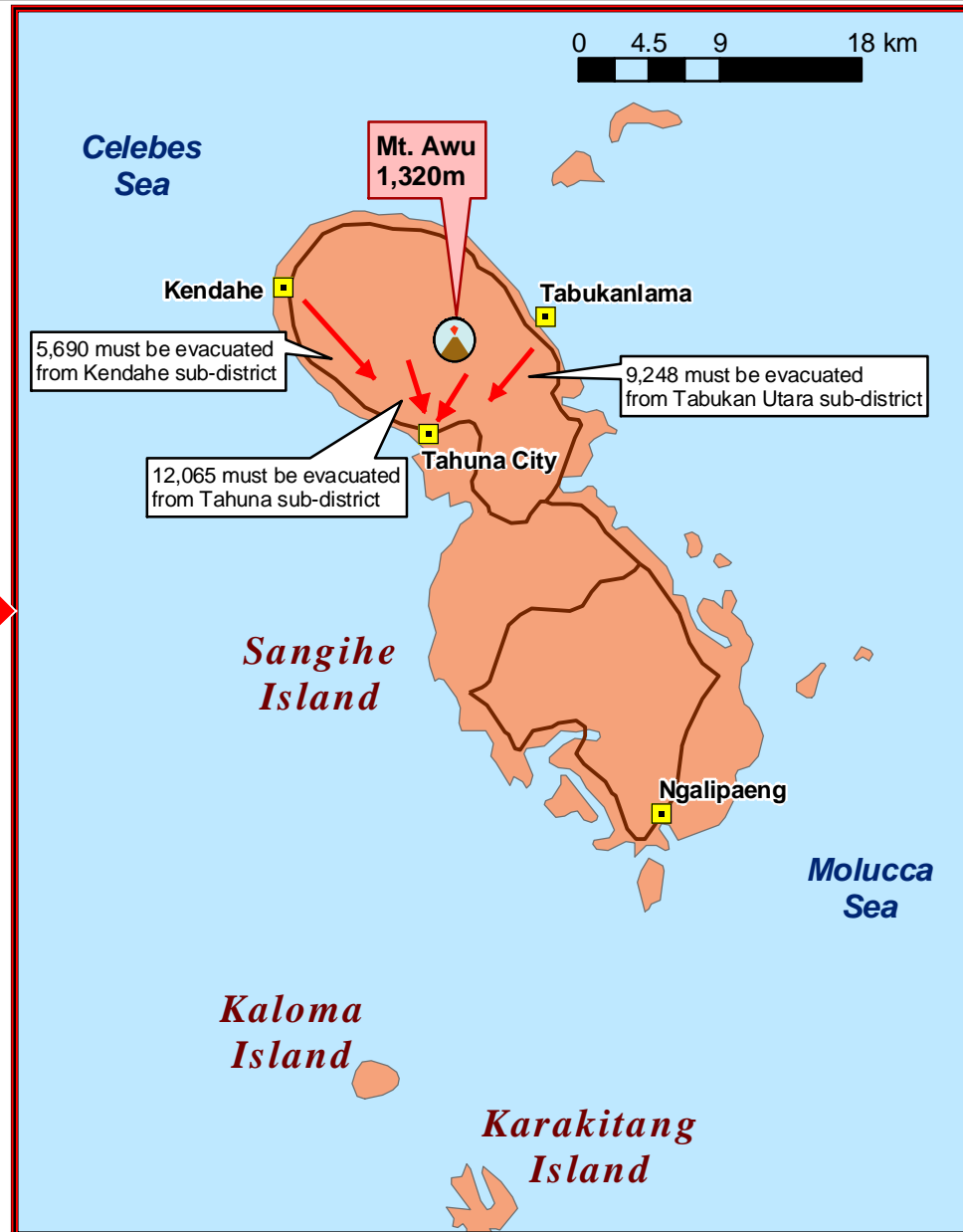
Indonesia - Volcanic Activity Mt. Awu

"The intense level of activity of Mt. Awu, has prompted the Directorate of Vulcanology to raise the level of alertness to the highest level and to instruct the evacuation of people living in the three most hazardous sub-districts..."



The 1,320 meter Mount Awu is located in Sangihe Island, North Sulawesi Province. It is one of the most active volcanoes in Indonesia. The last eruption took place in 1992 with no casualties.

Approximately 27,000 people must be evacuated to Tahuna City. As of 8 June 17,326 people have been evacuated.
