"Heavy rains have caused flooding and landslides in the northeastern Departments of Santander and Norte de Santander. 13 people have been killed and close to 30,000 have been affected."



SITUATION

Flooding and landslides caused by heavy rains in the course of last week occurred in the northeastern Departments of Santander and Norte de Santander. Department of Tolima minor affected. 13 people killed and 30,000 affected until 13 February. Most affected cities are Bucaramanga and Puerto Santander. Access to 4 municipalities of Santander cut-off due to landslides.

ACTION

No international assistance requested by the Government.
 Food rations, water, mattresses and blankets airlifted to affected area by the Government.
 Staff deployed from National Disaster Prevention and Response Office to conduct damage and needs assessment.
