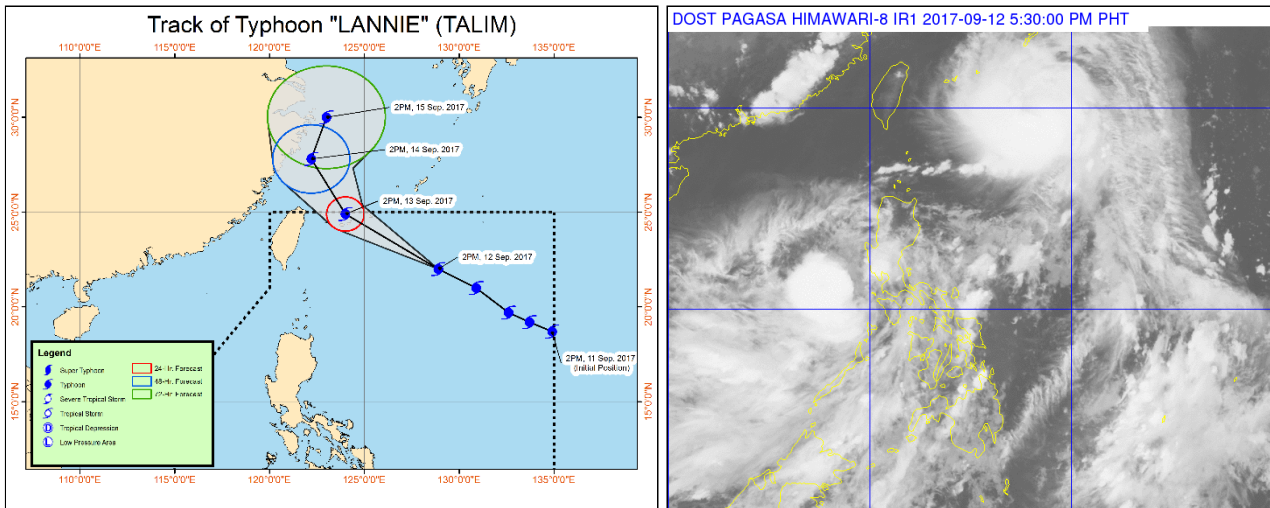


DSWD DROMIC Preparedness for Response Report #1 on Typhoon Lannie as of 12 September 2017, 6PM

Situation Overview



- Estimated rainfall amount is moderate to occasionally heavy rains within the 350 km diameter of the Typhoon.

Location of eye/center:	At 10:00 AM today, the eye of Typhoon "LANNIE" was located based on all available data at 865 km East of Basco, Batanes (21.5 °N, 130.2 °E)
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 120 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 145 kph
Forecast Movement:	Forecast to move West Northwest at 24 kph
Forecast Positions:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 24 Hour(Tomorrow morning): 495 km Northeast of Basco, Batanes(23.7°N, 125.2°E) • 48 Hour(Thursday morning):620 km North of Basco, Batanes(26.0°N, 122.3°E) • 72 Hour(Friday morning): 955 km North of Basco, Batanes(29.0°N, 121.8°E)

1. Status of Prepositioned Resources: Stockpiles and Standby Funds

The DSWD Central Office (CO), Field Office Region 2 (FOII), and National Resource Operations Center (NROC) have stockpiles and standby funds amounting to **₱666,395,278.20** (see Table 1) with breakdown as follows:

a. Stockpiles

A total of **24,129 Family Food Packs (FFPs)** (see Table 2) amounting to **₱8,375,310.10** and available **Food and Non-food Items (FNIs)** amounting to **₱99,909,709.05**.

b. Standby Funds

A total of **₱558,110,259.05** standby funds in the CO and FOII. Of the said amount, **₱555,110,259.05** is the available Quick Response Fund in the CO.
