

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Armed Conflict in Lake Sebu, South Cotabato as of 7 December 2017, 9PM

SUMMARY

On December 3, 2017, an armed conflict transpired between the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and alleged group of New People's Army (NPA) in Brgy. Ned, Lake Sebu, South Cotabato.

1. Status of Affected Families/ Persons

148 families or **740 persons** were affected by the armed conflict (Table 1).
