

## DSWD DROMIC Report #102 on the Armed Conflict in Marawi City as of 19 March 2018, 6PM

### SUMMARY

#### 1. Status of Internally Displaced Families / Persons

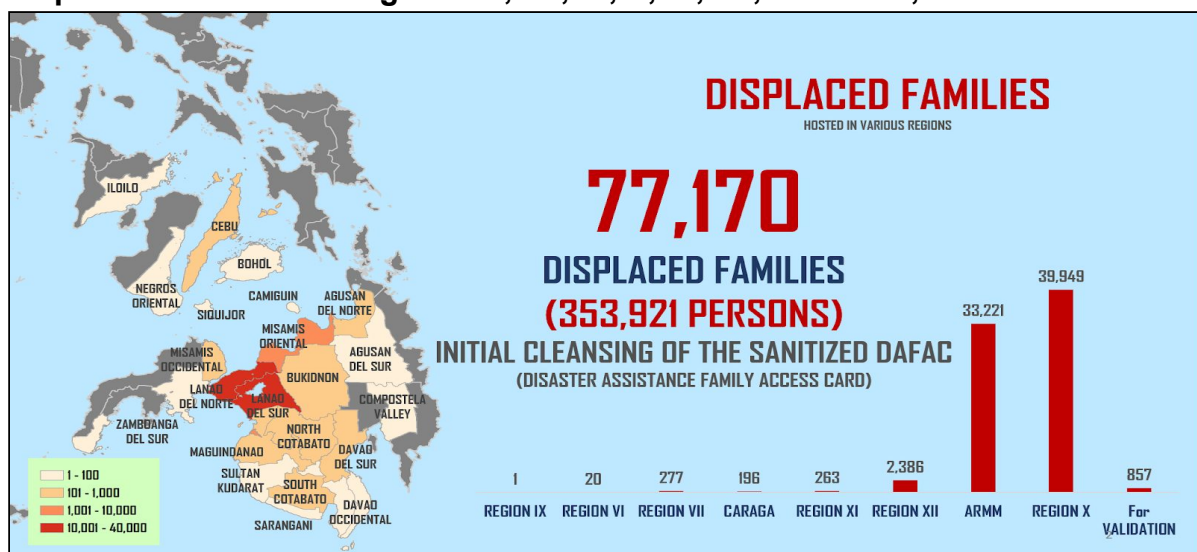
- a) **77,170 families** or **353,921 persons** have been displaced by the Armed Conflict in Marawi City, based on the Disaster Assistance Family Access Cards (DAFAC). At that, there are **857 families** or **3,648 persons** undergoing validation. The effect of this unrest has displaced families / persons coming from Marawi City and neighboring municipalities (Table 1).

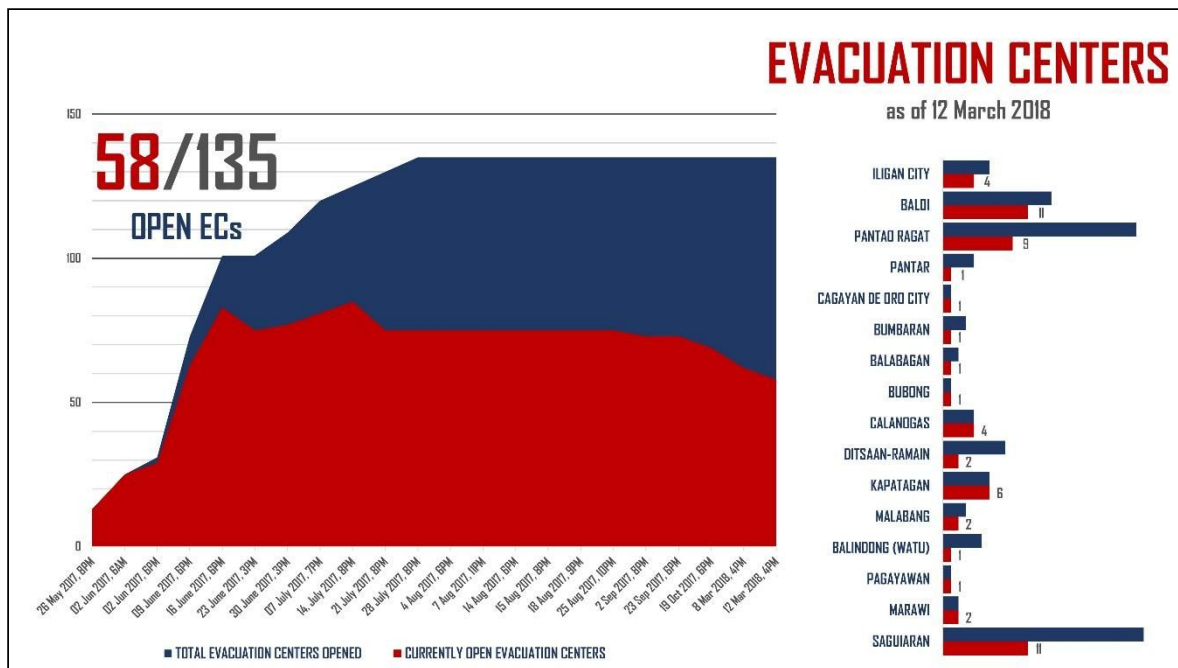

#### 4. Cost of Assistance Received by the Affected Families

The affected families have received **₱764,585,081.57** worth of relief assistance. Of the said amount, **₱596,648,242.10** has been provided by DSWD; **₱51,480,815.00** has been provided by DSWD-ARMM; **₱62,558,155.00** has been provided by ARMM-HEART; **₱21,791,876.90** has been provided by LGUs; and **₱32,105,992.57** has been provided by NGOs (Table 5).
