

## DSWD DROMIC Report #11 on the Ms 6.9 Earthquake Incident in Matanao, Davao del Sur as of 29 December 2019, 6PM

### Situation Overview

On 15 December 2019 at 02:11 PM, a 6.9 magnitude earthquake jolted the municipality of Matanao, Davao del Sur (06.74°N, 125.20°E - 005 km N 72° W) with a tectonic origin and a depth of focus of 3 km.

### I. Status of Affected Families / Persons

A total of **86,545 families** or **394,355 persons** were affected by the earthquake incident in **218 barangays** in **Regions XI and XII** (see Table 1).

There are **10,505 families** or **40,424 persons** taking temporary shelter in **102 evacuation centers** in **Regions XI and XII** (see Table 2).

### IV. Assistance Provided

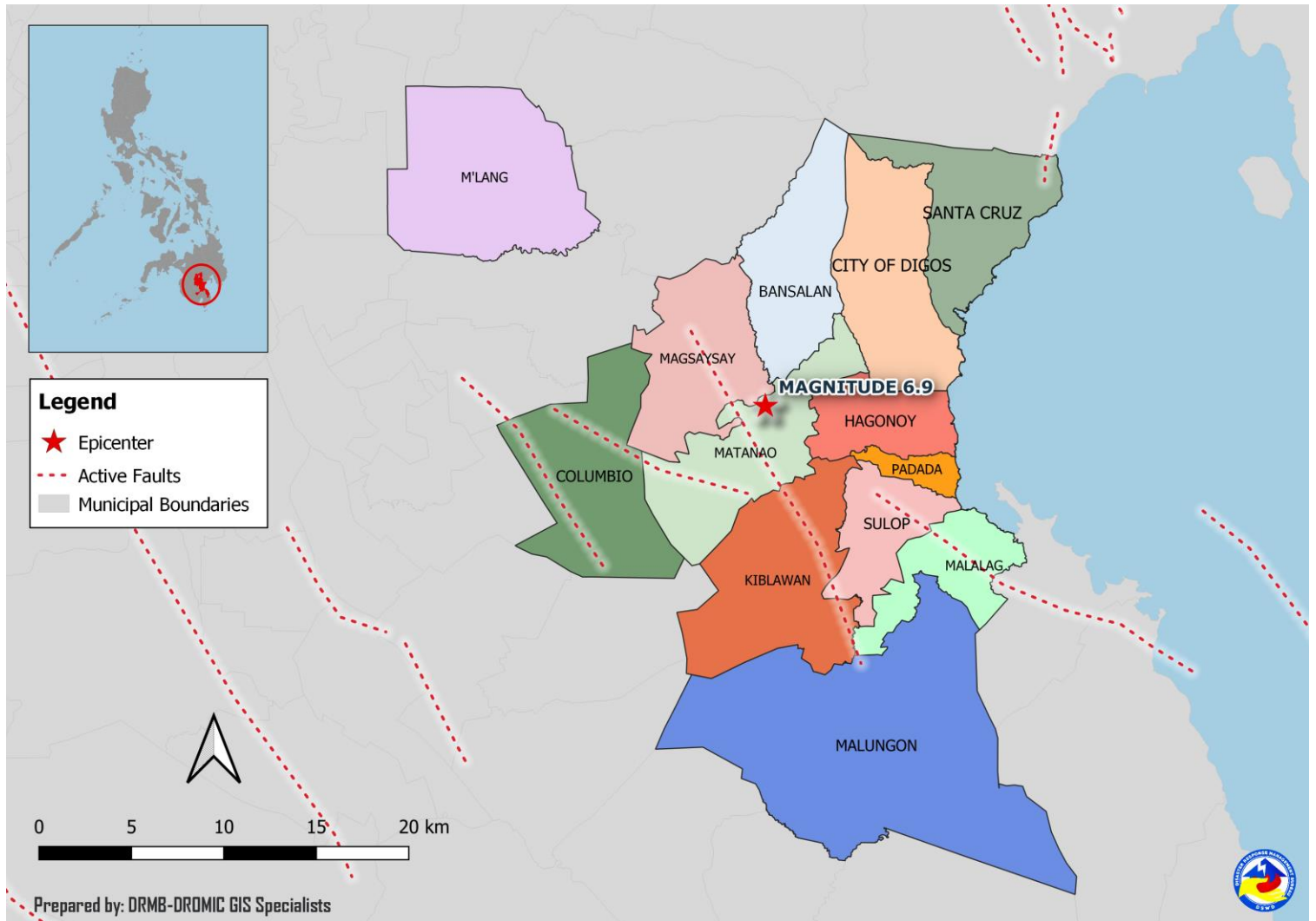
A total of **₱19,368,986.17** worth of assistance was provided by **DSWD** to the affected families (see Table 5).
