

DSWD DROMIC Report #7 on the Social Disorganization in Lianga, Surigao del Sur as of 7 December 2017, 7PM

SUMMARY

On 25 November 2017, an unknown armed group attacked the community of Km. 9, Brgy. Diatagon, Lianga, Surigao del Sur causing panic among the residents. Families and individuals left their respective houses and stayed in a tribal school in Brgy. Diatagon, Liangan, Surigao del Sur.

1. Number of Affected Families / Persons

To date, **398 families** or **1,862 persons** have been affected in **Lianga and San Agustin, Surigao del Sur** (see Table 1).

2. Status of Displaced Families/Persons

At present, **367 families** or **1,707 persons** are staying in Tribal Filipino Program for Surigao del Sur (TRIPFSS), a tribal school in Lianga (see Table 2). While, **31 families** or **155 persons** are staying with their relatives in Brgy. Buhisan, San Agustin.

7 December 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DSWD-FO CARAGA through its DReAMU will continuously monitor the situation in close coordination with the LSWDOs and LDRRMOs to ensure provision of continuous and timely updates for possible assistance.
1 December 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Agreements during the Municipal Peace and Order Council (MPOC) of Lianga, Surigao del Sur includes: that NGOs like ACCORD, ACF, Diocesan and others are restricted to visit Km 9, Diatagon, Lianga, Surigao del Sur. Accordingly, they were advised to coordinate with the MSWDO of Lianga and San Agustin, Surigao del Sur for any provision of assistance coming from NGOs.
30 November 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> LGU Lianga has started its process of procuring welfare goods to be distributed to the IDPs on December 2, 2017, together with the conduct of medical mission and special supplementary feeding. DSWD-FO CARAGA through its DReAMU will continuously monitor the situation in close coordination with the LSWDOs and LDRRMOs to ensure provision of continuous and timely updates for possible assistance.
28 November 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Municipal Peace and Order Council (MPOC) of Lianga, Surigao del Sur has already convened and discussed issues relating to the status of the IDPs. As per agreement from the conducted meeting, BLGU Diatagon, Lianga, Surigao del Sur would provide ten (10) sacks of rice to the IDPs while BLGU Buhisan, San Agustin, Surigao del Sur would also provide family food packs to the IDPs. MLGUs San Agustin and Lianga, Surigao del Sur together with the PSWDO of Surigao del Sur has an ongoing packing of family food packs which would be distributed to the IDPs.
