

## DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flooding Incident in Talomo-A District, Davao City as of 12 September 2017, 10PM

### SUMMARY

On 11 September 2017 at around 8:00 PM, heavy downpour of rain caused flooding in Talomo-A District, Davao City affecting three (3) barangays. The incident left 17 families or 85 persons affected and 11 damaged houses as of writing.

### Number of Displaced and Affected Families and Persons

**17 families or 85 persons** are currently affected and displaced by the flooding in Talomo-A District, Davao City (Table 1). All the affected/displaced are presently taking shelter with families/friends.
