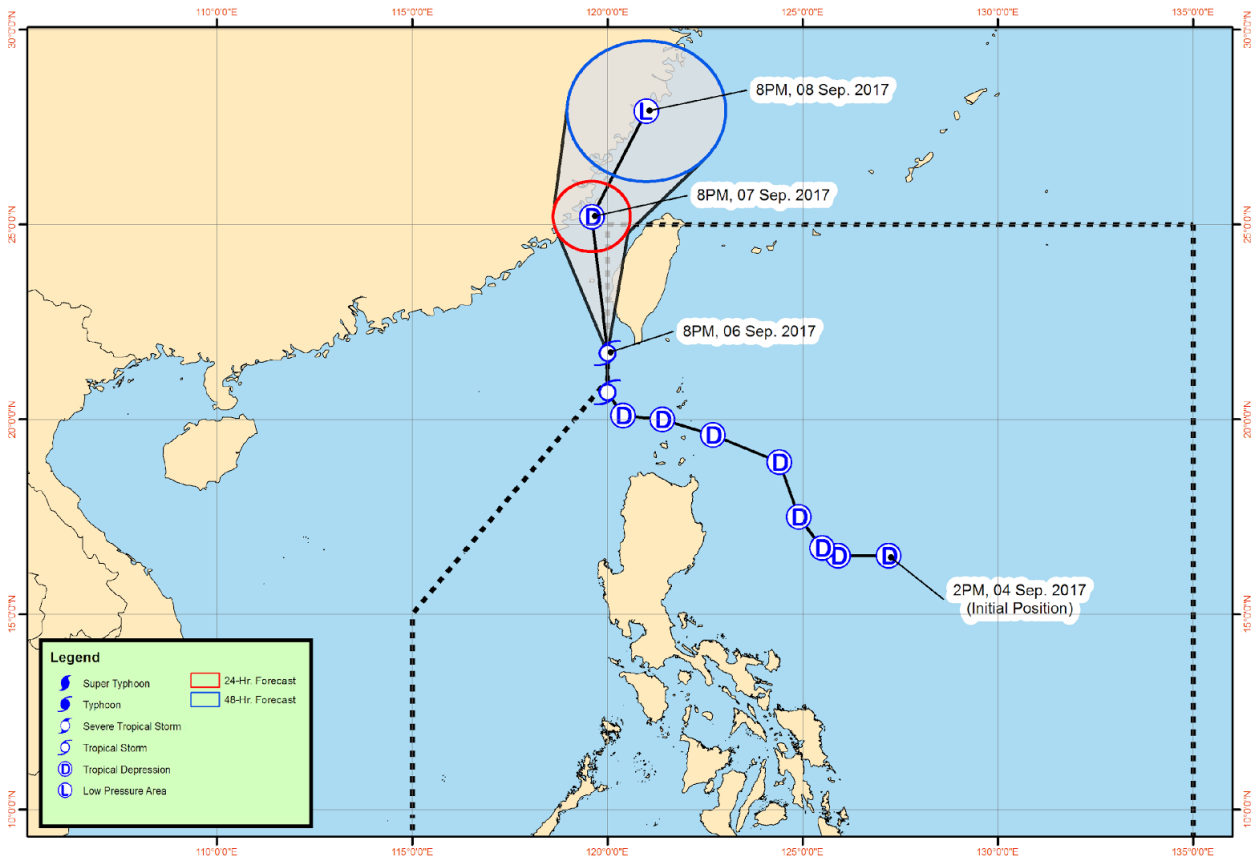


## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on Tropical Depression “Kiko” as of 11 September 2017, 6PM

This is the final report on the monitored Tropical Depression “Kiko” which started on 04 September 2017

### Situation Overview

#### Track of Tropical Storm "KIKO" (GUCHOL)

On 06 September 2017, TROPICAL STORM "KIKO" IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR). Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 200 km diameter of the Tropical Storm. Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the northern seaboard of Northern Luzon. All tropical cyclone warning Signals elsewhere are now lifted.

7 September 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DSWD- FO I submitted Terminal Report</li> <li>Region 1 is experiencing fair weather as tropical depression “Kiko” moved outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) last night. Hence, in coordination with the Social Welfare and Development (SWAD) Teams of Region 1, P/C/MDRRMCs, and P/C/MSWDOs, there are no reports of incidents/ casualties/ affected families during the onset of the tropical depression.</li> </ul>
5 September 2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DReAMS staff is closely monitoring the possible effect of Tropical Depression “Kiko”. Likewise, the Quick Action Response Teams (QUARTs) of the Field Office I and the Provincial Operations Offices are currently monitoring and preparing pre-disaster activities in close coordination with the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) Region I and with the different P/C/MDRRMCs for the adverse effect that might be brought by the tropical depression.</li> </ul>
