

DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Flooding Incident in Cotabato City

08 August 2017, 6PM

This is the final report on the monitored flooding incident in Cotabato City, which happened in 15 July 2017. The flooding was due to the overflow of the Rio Grande de Mindanao.

Summary

1. Status of Affected Families/Persons

23,176 families or **104,108 persons** were affected by the flooding incident in **26 Barangays** in Cotabato City (see Table 1).
