

DSWD DROMIC Report #1 on the Flashflood Incident in Koronadal City

as of 29 July 2020, 4PM

SUMMARY

On 28 July 2020 at around 3:00 PM, a flashflood incident occurred in Barangays San Isidro, Assumption and Zone III in Koronadal City caused by heavy rainfall due to the Low Pressure Area (LPA).

A total of **149 families** or **895 persons** in **3 barangays** were affected by the flashflood incident in **Koronadal City, South Cotabato** (see Table 1).
