

## DSWD DROMIC Report #10 on the Flooding Incident in Eastern Visayas

as of 26 January 2021, 6PM

### SUMMARY

Issued on 10 January 2021, the entire Visayas and Palawan including Kalayaan Islands have experienced cloudy skies with scattered rain showers and thunderstorms due to Tail-end of Frontal System.

#### I. Status of Affected Families / Persons

A total of **34,331 families** or **149,451 persons** were affected by the flooding incident in **193 barangays** in **Eastern Visayas** (see Table 1).

## II. Status of Displaced Families / Persons

### a. Inside Evacuation Center

A total of **3,681 families** or **13,886 persons** took temporary shelter in **45 evacuation centers** in **Eastern Visayas** (see Table 2).

### b. Outside Evacuation Center

A total of **43 families** or **220 persons** have temporarily stayed with their relatives and/or friends (see Table 3).

A total of **1,846 houses were damaged**; of which, **171 were totally damaged** and **1,675 were partially damaged** (see Table 4).
