

DSWD DROMIC Report #2 on the Effects of Monsoon Trough

as of 17 June 2021, 6PM

SUMMARY

Issued at 4 PM on 09 June 2021, Monsoon Trough affecting the country. Cloudy skies with scattered rainshowers and thunderstorms with possible impacts of flashfloods or landslides due to scattered moderate to at times heavy rains.

I. Status of Affected Families / Persons

A total of **2,076 families** or **9,923 persons** were affected by the flooding incident in **18 barangays** in **Regions VII and XII** (see Table 1).

There are **320 families** or **1,539 persons** currently taking temporary shelter in **five (5) evacuation centers** in **Regions VII and XII** (see Table 2).

16 June 2021	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DSWD-FO XII Disaster Response Management Division (DRMD) staff conducted an actual validation in close coordination with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of Tantaran, South Cotabato. DSWD-FO XII provided 133 pieces of sleeping kits, 133 pieces of family kits and 30 FFPs to the displaced families. DSWD-FO XII provided 239 family food packs and 239 DAFAC to LGU of Norala.

The Disaster Response Operations Monitoring and Information Center (DROMIC) of the DSWD-DRMB is closely coordinating with concerned DSWD Field Offices for any significant disaster response updates.
