

## DSWD DROMIC Report #3 on Tropical Depression “AMANG” as of 22 January 2019, 4PM

### Situation Overview

#### I. Status of Affected Families / Persons

A total of **1,501 Families** or **5,904 persons** were affected in **44 barangays**, **15 cities/municipalities**, and **4 provinces** in **Region CARAGA** (see Table 1).
