

## DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on Tropical Depression “AMANG” as of 24 January 2019, 5PM

### Situation Overview

Northeast Moonsoon affecting the rest of Luzon.

#### I. Status of Affected Families / Persons

A total of **3,760 Families** or **16,574 persons** were affected in **58 barangays**, **17 cities/municipalities**, and **5 provinces** in **Region CARAGA** (see Table 1).
