

## DSWD DROMIC Report #5 on the Armed Conflict in San Jose de Buan, Western Samar

as of 27 March 2019, 4PM

### SUMMARY

On 08 March 2019 at about 8PM, an armed conflict transpired in Brgy. Hagbay, San Jose de Buan, Western Samar which resulted to displacement of families and individuals in the area.

A total of **247 families** or **988 persons** were affected by the armed conflict in San Jose de Buan, Western Samar (see Table 1).

27 March 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DSWD-FO VIII through its Disaster Response Management Division provided augmentation assistance to the displaced families consisting of family food packs and blankets.</li> <li>The Regional Resource Operation Section (RROS) dispatched food and non-food items to the affected families in San Jose de Buan.</li> <li>The Local Government of San Jose de Buan conducted relief operation to the affected families.</li> <li>The DSWD Field Office VIII through the Disaster Response Management Division had provided additional augmentation assistance for the displaced families consisting 255 Family Food Packs, 150 pcs. of Blankets and 6 sacks of Used Clothing. This used clothing was delivered at the RROC from VDRS wherein cost per sack aren't specified.</li> <li>DROMIC Focal Person is continuously coordinating updates of this incident with the SWADT and MDRRMC.</li> <li>DROMIC Focal Person gather data and in coordination with MSWDO of San Jose de Buan.</li> <li>Regional Resource Operation Section (RROS) dispatched the F/NFI's for San Jose de Buan this morning.</li> <li>DSWD-FO VIII through its Disaster Response Management Division is continuously coordinating with the concerned LGU for possible request of augmentation assistance.</li> </ul>
