

## DSWD DROMIC Report #6 on the Armed Conflict in Pikit, North Cotabato as of 31 July 2020, 4PM

### SUMMARY

On 09 May 2020, an armed conflict transpired between two (2) groups in Barangays Nunguan, Balatican, Kalakacan, and Balabac in Pikit, North Cotabato, which resulted to the displacement of thousands of families.

#### I. Status of Affected Families / Persons

A total of **2,770 families** or **11,549 persons** were affected by the armed conflict in **4 barangays** in **Pikit, North Cotabato** (see Table 1).

#### II. Status of Displaced Families / Persons

##### a. Inside Evacuation Center

There are **149 families** or **650 persons** currently taking shelter in **4 evacuation centers** in **Pikit, North Cotabato** (see Table 2).

31 July 2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>DSWD-FO XII released 2,627 family food packs, 10 rolls of laminated sacks and 150 pieces of plastic mats to LGU of Pikit.</li> <li>LGU of Pikit provided 1,837 family food packs and 15 rolls of tarpaulin or “trapal” to the affected families.</li> <li>DSWD-FO XII DRMD staff monitored the IDPs inside evacuation centers in Pikit, North Cotabato.</li> </ul>
