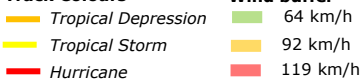

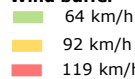

BOLIVIA – Severe Weather

- Heavy rains and consequent river overflows have been affecting parts of Bolivia since late December. Five departments affected (as of 2 January, ABI): Beni, Cochabamba, Chuquisaca, Potosí and La Paz.
- In the department of Beni, another 900 families have been affected by the overflow of Río Sécuré. As of 24 December (Local Media): approx. 3 000 families affected countrywide.

INDIAN OCEAN – Tropical Cyclone BEJISA

- BEJISA passed close to the French island of La Reunion on 2 January, affecting this island and the island of Mauritius with heavy rains and strong winds.
- La Reunion: 1 dead, 16 people injured (two of them seriously), power outages (over 170 000 people), water and telecommunication disruptions.
- After passing La Reunion it started turning south-west, weakening. In the next 48 h it is forecast to continue moving south-west weakening further.
