



**SITUATION OVERVIEW** as of 30 Jan.

- **688 000** refugees into Bangladesh (of which **585 000** in Kutupalong and Bulukhali camps)
- **4 865** clinically suspected Diphtheria cases and **31** deaths (reported in refugee camps)
- In parallel, an increase in mumps cases has been reported.

**EU CIVIL PROTECTION MECHANISM (EUCPM)**

- UK EMTs and IOM are providing Diphtheria Antitoxin (DAT) with WHO in Leda, Kutupalong and Bulukhali camps
- **496** patients have received DAT treatment

- EUCPM Coordination hub-provided by International Humanitarian Partnership (IHP)
- UK Emergency Medical Team (EMT)
- International Organization for Migration (IOM)
- People dead due to Diphtheria outbreak
- People at risk of being affected by floods and landslides for the upcoming monsoon and cyclone seasons inside camps
