

Bangladesh - Diphtheria Outbreak: EUCPM response

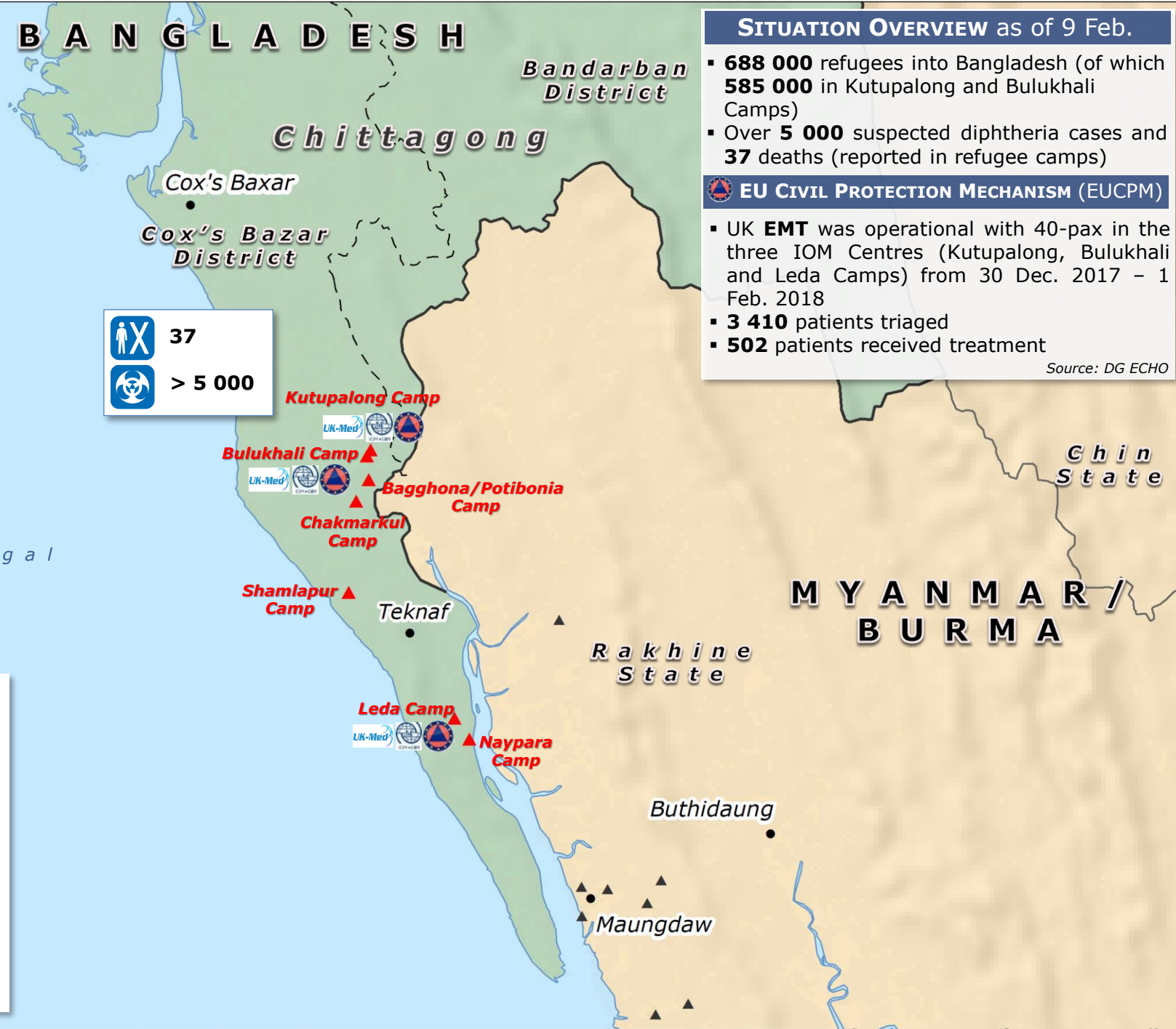
SITUATION OVERVIEW as of 9 Feb.

- **688 000** refugees into Bangladesh (of which **585 000** in Kutupalong and Bulukhali Camps)
- Over **5 000** suspected diphtheria cases and **37** deaths (reported in refugee camps)

EU CIVIL PROTECTION MECHANISM (EUCPM)












- UK **EMT** was operational with 40-pax in the three IOM Centres (Kutupalong, Bulukhali and Leda Camps) from 30 Dec. 2017 – 1 Feb. 2018
- **3 410** patients triaged
- **502** patients received treatment
