



El Nino Rainfall Monitoring Report on October 30, 2015

Situation Overview

Significant amount of rainfall was recorded in Kakamega, Kericho, Kisii, Siaya, Kisumu Kirinyaga, Homabay, Bungoma and Nandi County whereas Nakuru and West Pokot Counties received average amounts of rainfall yesterday evening. The Coastal region and North Eastern did not receive any rainfall in the last 24hours.

Updates per county

Nakuru County

Average amounts of rainfall were yesterday experienced in Nakuru town, this has been the highest recorded rainfall since the beginning of the season. Molo, Rongai and Subukia also received rainfall.

Narok County

Heavy rainfall was reported in parts of Narok County accompanied by strong winds. A lightning struck a family resulting in a fire. No one was injured in the incident.

Kirinyaga County

Heavy rainfall was received in most parts of the County but no incident was reported. Temperatures remain generally low amid dark cloud cover, an indication that more rainfall is likely in the immediate future.

Kakamega County

Increased amounts of rainfall is being witnessed in most parts of the County. Lugari and Kakamega South witnessed the highest amounts of rainfall. Kakamega town received light showers early this morning. No major incident was reported

Today's Weather Forecast

The latest forecast from KMS indicates that, rainfall is expected to continue over several parts of the Country However, heavy rainfall of more than 50mm in 24 hours is expected around Lake Victoria. Strong winds of more than 25 knots (12.5 m/s) over the northwestern parts of Turkana County.
