



El Nino Rainfall Monitoring Report on November 30, 2015

Situation Overview

Over the last 24 hours, heavy rainfall was experienced in various parts of the country including Wajir, Meru, Isiolo, Marsabit, Samburu, Nyeri and Marsabit sub-counties. Average rainfall was received in Nakuru, Narok and Kakamega Counties. Light showers were received in some parts North Eastern.

Updates per county

Meru County

Heavy rainfall was experienced in the entire Meru County resulting in flash floods in various parts of the county. In Meru town, blocked drainage systems led to flash floods on major roads disrupting transport along these roads. In Kaelo, 14 households were displaced after their houses were sub-merged. The county government and KRCS carried out distribution of NFIs to these families. Several roads were also rendered impassable with the main access road from Kibirichia to Ntirititi cut off.

Isiolo County

Following the heavy downpour, flash floods affected about 15 shops in Galamala resulting in heavy losses by the business people due to damaged stocks.

Migori County

Migori County has witnessed heavy rainfall over the last 3 days in Nyatike Sub-County. KRCS in collaboration with the county government has established 2 evacuation centres in Nyora and Kabuto areas in preparedness of floods that could result from the heavy rains.

Samburu County

In Samburu county, heavy rainfall resulted in flash floods that affected 13 households in the Sereolitie area. KRCS teams are currently carrying out an assessment in the affected areas.

Wajir County

Wajir County witnessed heavy rainfall since yesterday evening and into this morning. This resulted in flooding in Buna town (about 115 KMs from Wajir town). KRCS teams are carrying out assessments in the affected areas to determine the extent of damage.

Marsabit County

Heavy rainfall was seen in Marsabit and its environs from 0600hrs. Roads leading to Shurr from Marsabit have been rendered impassable with motorists, to and from Shurr location in North Horr Sub County, stuck along the way. KRCS is on the ground to assess the situation.

Today's Weather Forecast

Rainfall expected to continue over several parts of the Country. However, Heavy rainfall of over 50mm in 24hrs expected around parts of North Eastern, Coast and South Eastern counties especially areas around Samburu, Isiolo, Wajir, Marsabit, Garissa, Kitui and Tana River Counties.
