



Bolivia - Landslide

OCHA Situation Report No. 1

"preliminary data so far indicate that 2 persons lost their lives, some 30 people are missing and 30 houses have been destroyed."



1. The United Nations Resident Coordinator in La Paz reports that a landslide occurred on 31 March, in Chima, a gold mining settlement in the municipality of Tipuani, located 250 km from La Paz.
2. While initial figures indicated a large number people affected, more recent preliminary data so far indicate that 2 persons lost their lives, some 30 people are missing and 30 houses have been destroyed. Communications and power supply were cut off.
