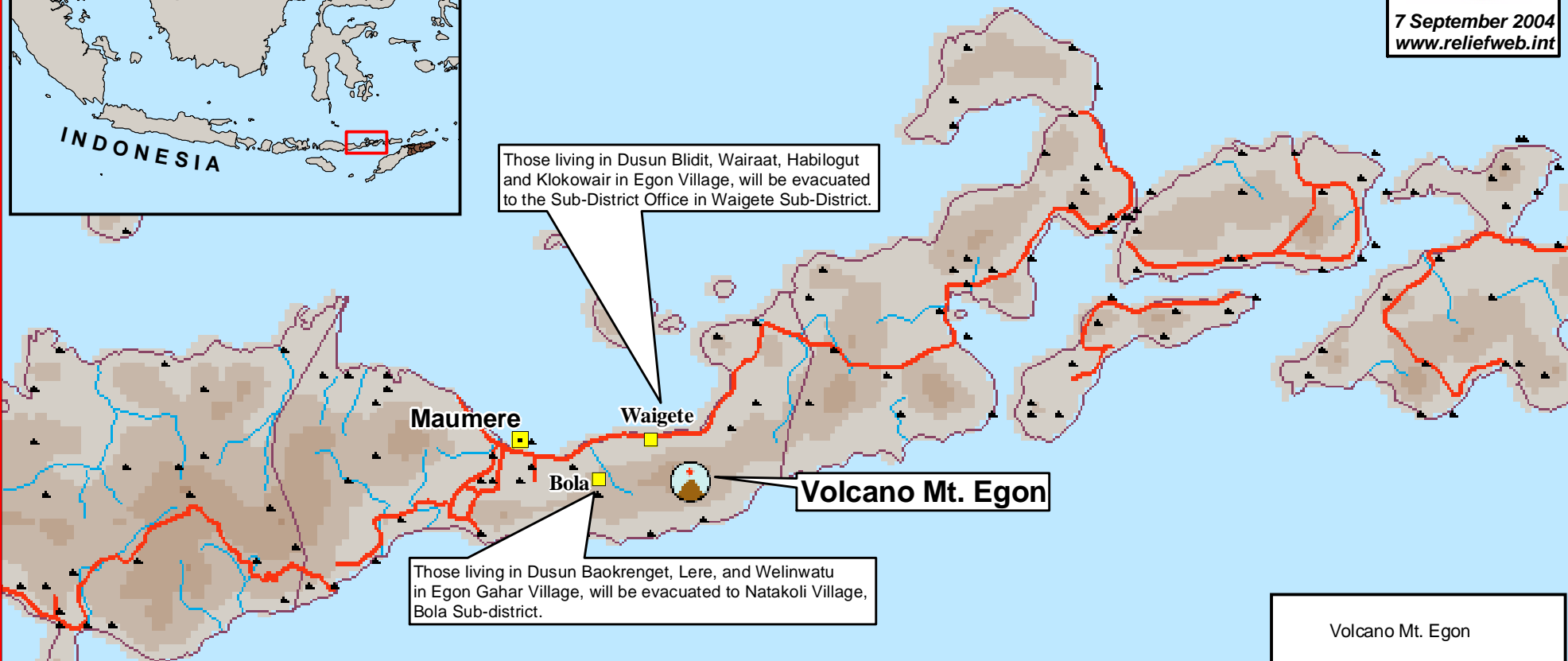

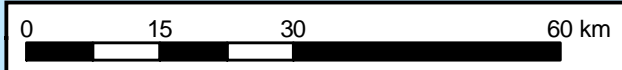


Those living in Dusun Blidit, Wairaat, Habilogut and Klokowair in Egon Village, will be evacuated to the Sub-District Office in Waigete Sub-District.

Those living in Dusun Baokrenget, Lere, and Welinwatu in Egon Gahar Village, will be evacuated to Natakoli Village, Bola Sub-district.

The total number of people to be evacuated is approximately 4,300. An additional 5,700 people would need to be evacuated if the situation deteriorates even further.
