HHRD Flood Relief Response

HHRD Continuously providing medical, food, NFIs, shelter and drinking water to Sindh monsoon flood affectees.

Health—one mobile medical camp became functional in district Badin since yesterday. In one day camp, the OPD was observed 96 patients (32 male, 17 female, 47 children). HHRD will conduct 75 one-day mobile camps in five districts (15 camps in one district). Dr. Fozia, HHRD Health Program Coordinator reports “*this is the first medical camp in Badin district, where no other organization has started work in health sector so far. Here, HHRD mobile medical camp is the only source for flood victims to receive immediate medical assistance*”.

Food—HHRD will distribute 500 food packages in five districts (100 in each district) over the next two days.

Water— HHRD will manage the provision of Fiber Water Tanks and clean water through trucks.

NFIs— HHRD will distribute Non Food Items (NFIs) in UC Khoski, Tulka Tando Bhago, in District Badin.

Continuous Raining-Reports from Field—In seven districts including Banazirabad, Tando M. Khan, Tando Allah Yar, Badin, Mirpurkhas, Sangarh and Haiderabad, since yesterday till now (4pm), there is continuous raining, hindering relief activities.

HHRD addressing the double challenges of Floods

Relief for 2011 Flood affectees, Rehabilitation for 2010 flood affectees

HHRD relief interventions continue in five districts of Sindh Province. The organization started relief response by 20th August, 2011 in response of heavy rains and flooding in Sindh. So far, HHRD has expanded its relief response scope to five districts of hard affected districts (find name of districts in table below). So far, our relief interventions benefited nearly 13,000 survivors through distribution of food packages (37.3 MT), NFIs and cooked meals.

At the same time, HHRD is also implementing its unique & integrated program “Adopt a Village/union council” designed for rehabilitation of 2010 flood affectees. In this program, HHRD has adopted 11 union councils.
