Field Report on Israel's Attacks on Gaza

**Violations of international human rights and international humanitarian law
committed by the Israeli occupation forces in the reporting period:**

14 November 2012 –21 November 2012

Introduction

In this detailed field report Al Mezan Centre for Human Rights (Al Mezan) reports on military attacks carried out in the Gaza Strip in the period 14 November 2012 – 21 November 2012. The attacks listed were researched and verified by Al Mezan's team of fieldworkers who are based in each of Gaza's five districts. The attacks are listed in chronological order.

Hostilities commenced with the Israeli occupation forces (IOF) shot dead a 13-year-old boy as he was playing football in the town of Khuza'a in Khan Younis district on 8 November 2012, during an incursion into Gaza that lasted for two days.¹ In another IOF attack, at approximately 5 pm on Saturday 10 November 2012, the IOF fired artillery shells at a water reservoir, also in the town of Khuza'a eastern Khan Younis. The reservoir was about 800 meters from the separation fence between Gaza Strip and Israel. The shelling injured 11 Palestinian civilians, including four women and two children.

On 10 November 2012, Palestinian fighters fired an anti-tank rocket at an Israeli military jeep, reportedly injuring four Israeli soldiers. The IOF responded immediately by firing artillery shells on a crowd of Palestinian civilians in a wake tent in the east of Gaza City. When the people in the area, including several children who were playing football in a nearby field, went to help the wounded, the IOF fired an artillery shell into the crowd, killing and injuring dozens.² Hostilities escalated since then and the IOF and by 11 November, the IOF had killed Seven Palestinians; three Children; and Injured 54, including 12 Children.³ On 12 November 2012, a truce was informally announced, but not confirmed.

At approximately 15:50 on 14 November 2012, an Israeli airstrike targeted a car in which Ahmed Al-Jaa'bari, 52, leader of Hamas' military wing was travelling, killing him and his companion, Mohammed Al-Hams. The IOF launched dozens of air and artillery attacks on Gaza during the hours following this attack, killing another five people including: one infant, 11 months; a girl, 3; and a woman, 19.

When a ceasefire was negotiated and agreed on, on 21 November 2012, the Israeli attacks on Gaza have had already devastated it. Al Mezan's monitoring indicates that between 14 November 2012 and 21 November 2012, at least 162 Palestinians have been killed in IOF attacks. Of those, 37 were children and 13 were women. Another 1,039 people were injured, including 315 children and 191 women. At least 963 houses have also been damaged or destroyed, including 92 completely. Of those 92 houses, 52 were directly attacked; including 35 were direct roof-knocking attacks. Another 179 houses sustained serious damages. Moreover, IOF attacks caused varying damages to 10 health centres, 35 schools, 2 universities, 15 NGO offices, 30 mosques, 14 media offices, 92 industrial and commercial facilities, 1 UNRWA food distribution Centre, 8 ministry buildings, 14 police/security stations, 5 banks, 34 vehicles, 3 youth clubs, 3 cemeteries, and 2 bridges.⁴

Al Mezan stresses that its initial findings, detailed below, provide compelling evidence that IOF attacks on the Gaza Strip included attacks on civilian targets and other attacks which failed to observe the relevant principles of international law. It is also important to note that the IOF's attacks were carried out in the context of Israel's closure and naval blockade of the Gaza Strip, which have now been in place for more than five years. The closure and blockade have seriously undermined the provision of essential

services in Gaza, especially in the health, water and sanitation sectors. As the new destruction to homes occurred, tens of thousands of Gazans remain displaced as a result of the destruction of property by the IOF and Israel's ban on the bringing of construction materials into the Gaza Strip.

This report details the IOF attacks on the Gaza Strip by district between the period 14 and 21 November 2012. The report aims to provide the media, diplomatic missions and humanitarian organizations with information that will enable interventions aimed at preventing further human rights violations or assisting the affected populations in the Gaza Strip.

1. North Gaza District

1.1. Wednesday 14 November 2012

At approximately 5:00pm on Wednesday 14 November 2012, the following attacks were launched simultaneously:

An Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm located east of Abu Obieda Al Jarrah Secondary School for boys in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the sound of the explosion was very loud and the people living in the area, especially the women and children, were terrified. The windowpanes of a number of nearby houses were smashed in the attack.

An Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area north of Al 'Attattra Clinic in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor. The window panes of a number of nearby houses were damaged and the people in the area reported being very afraid.

An Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area located in As-Sekka Street north west of Zemmo crossroads in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injury as minor. The window panes of a number of nearby houses were damaged.

An Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area south of a cement factory in the east of Ezbet Abed Rabbo area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the people in the area reported being terrified. The window panes of a number of nearby houses were damaged.

An Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area south of the Security and Protection Police Building west of Ash-Sheikh Zaed area in the east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described as the injuries as minor. The window panes of a number of nearby houses were damaged.

An Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area north of Shaimaa' Secondary School for Girls in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area particularly the children reported being terrified.

An Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Tal Ad-Dahab area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area reported being terrified.

At approximately 5:10pm on the same day, an Israeli jet aircraft fired a missile at an open area in Al Qassaseen street west of Jabaliya police station in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the people in the area were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 5:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet aircraft fired a missile at a farm west of Beit Lahiya Cemetery. The missile fell near the house of Ref'at Mohammed Yousif Jabber, 41. As a result, seven persons were injured and the house was severely damaged. Al Mezan has identified the names of the injured persons as follows:

- Ref'at Mohammed Jabber, 41;
- His wife Maha Zakaria Yousif Jabber, 38;

- Their children Muna, 18; Susan, 18; Leena, 4;
- Their relatives Susan Zakaria Jabber, 45; and
- Ahmed Jihad Jabber, 22.

The windowpanes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 5:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a motorcycle that was travelling on Beit Lahiya Street opposite the Gaza Electricity Distribution Company building in North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were killed. Al Mezan has identified them as follows:

- Issam Mahmoud Ahmed Abu Al Me'za, 20; and
- Mohammed Hani Ibrahim Kasseh, 18.

The two victims were from Beit Lahiya. Two persons were also injured in the attack. Medical sources at Al 'Awda Hospital described the injury of one of them as critical; he was subsequently transferred to Shifa Hospital in Gaza City. The windowpanes of three nearby houses were damaged in the attack.

At approximately 6:25 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of As-Salatten area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The windowpanes of a number of nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 6:25 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in As-Sekka street east of Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of a number of nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 6:50 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Court Street in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of four nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 6:50 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Al Jamal family. It is located east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 7:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Ibad Ar-Rahman area west of Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injury as minor. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 6:50 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the An-Najjar family in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, a woman and a child were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 10:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an agricultural store belonging to the Jabber family east of a rehabilitation centre near Abu Obieda Al Jarrah Secondary School for Boys in Beit Lahiya. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan described his injury as minor.

At approximately 11:55 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at an open area in As-Salatten area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:55 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm in Mas'oud street in Jabliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:55 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm in Ahmed Yaseen street in Ibad Ar-Rahman area in Jabliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

1.2. Thursday 15 November 2012

At around midnight on Thursday 15 November 2012, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Al Jamal family east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Beer An-Na'ja area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near some sewage pools in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but in the area people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in the Al Hawaer area west of Al Fakhoura School in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of a number of nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 12:40 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles at a farm belonging to the Al Jamal family and located east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 12:55 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Al Qassaseen street west of Jabaliya Services Club in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:05 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm belonging to the Al Jamal family and located on Court Street in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of four nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 1:35 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles in the vicinity of the building of the former Civil Administration east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 2:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Al Qassaseen street west of the Jabaliya Services Club in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 3:40 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a building that used to be used by the former Civil Administration, located east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 4:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at an open area west of the Police Investigation Department building (locally known as As-Safeeina) in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 4:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at an open area west of the Police Investigation Department building in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Al Barrawi family in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:40 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Felfel family and located west of Ash-Sheikh Zaed City in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:50 am on the same day, the IOF fired three artillery shells at the agricultural area near the Islamic cemetery east of Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Beer An-Na'ja area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm located east of Abu Obieda Al Jarrah Secondary School for Boys in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the sound of the explosion was extremely loud and people in the area, especially children, were terrified.

At approximately 8:10 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades, the military wing of the Hamas movement, east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the sound of the explosion was extremely loud and people in the area particularly children were terrified.

At approximately 8:20 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades, located east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the sound of the explosion was extremely loud and people in the area particularly the children were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 8:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades, located east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the sound of the explosion was huge and people in the area particularly children were terrified.

At approximately 9:10 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles in the vicinity of the building of the former Civil Administration, east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 9:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile in the vicinity of the building of the former Civil Administration, east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 10:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm located to the east of Abu Obieda Al Jarrah Secondary School for Boys in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but the sound of the explosion was extremely loud and people in the area particularly the children were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 10:05 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm in Fad'ous area north of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, Iyas Abu Hmeeda, 22, sustained a minor injury.

At approximately 10:10 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles at a farm in Fad'ous area north of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 10:20 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Khuzundar petroleum station in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:30 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades, located east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, one person sustained a minor injury.

At approximately 10:30 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles in the vicinity of the building of the former Civil Administration east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:00 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles at a farm belonging to the Al Qeshawi family, and located south east of Ar-Rantesi security site in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, 'Aed Mahmoud Ali, 23, sustained a minor injury. The window panes of two nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 11:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in the Ash-Shemaa' area north of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, Odai Khalid Abu Rabee', 4, sustained a minor injury. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 11:15 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades in the east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Al 'Awda Hospital described his injury as minor.

At approximately 11:25 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm belonging to the Al Qeshawi family south east of Ar-Rantesi security site in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 11:25 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm belonging to the Dabour family, located in As-Sekka street in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, Zakaria Hasan Al Faram, and Naef Ibrahim Abu Namous (21 and 53 respectively) were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 11:35 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm belonging to the Al Qeshawi family south east of Ar-Rantesi security site in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, four persons were injured, including a ten-month-old infant. Medical sources at Shifa Hospital described the injuries of the infant as critical. The window panes of three nearby houses were damaged.

At approximately 11:40 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young Palestinian men in As-Sekka street near Hamouda petroleum station east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, Rani Mahmoud Abdel Rahman Hammad, and Khalid Abdel Rahman Abu An-Naser (29 and 27 respectively) were killed. Another person was injured. Medical sources at Al 'Awda Hospital described his injury as critical.

At approximately 12:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area north west of Al Quds Open University east of Beit Lahiya, in North Gaza district. As a result, five public facilities were partially damaged, including the university and Hamouda Institute.

At approximately 12:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at an open area near Al Hussein Mosque in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Qlebo area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, two passers-by were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor.

At approximately 1:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm near Al Qattatwa mosque near the six martyrs crossroads in Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. As a result the mosque and three nearby houses were partially damaged. People in the area particularly the children were terrified.

1.3. Friday 16 November 2012

At approximately 6:30 pm on Friday 16 November 2012, an Israeli jet plane fired three missiles at an open area north of Beit Lahiya Sports Club in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet aircraft fired a missile at a farm north of the 17 Security Force site in Ibad Ar-Rahman neighbourhood in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:15 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at a farm belonging to the Felfel family east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:25 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles at a farm east of Abu Tamam Secondary School for Girls east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:35 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Abu Dashaq area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile in the vicinity of the building of the former Civil Affairs department at the Ministry of Interior east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:55 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Al Jamal family east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:57 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Dabour family in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Dabour family in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in the Al Hawaber area west of Al Fakhoura area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Jabal Al Kashef area east of Civil Administration building east of Jabaliya refugee camp. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet aircraft fired a missile in the vicinity of the building of the former Civil Affairs department at the Ministry of Interior east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of the Ash-Shantti area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:00 pm on the same day, IOF fired three sporadic artillery shells fell in the Zemmo family land south of Beit Hanoun in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Hamad family in Beit Hanoun in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting a motorcycle that was travelling near an UNWRA water well in Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injuries as critical. The window panes of three nearby houses and a lorry were partially damaged.

1.4. Saturday 17 November 2012

At approximately 2:20 am on Saturday 17 November 2012, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Besan Recreational City west of Ahmed Ash-Shuqerei Secondary School for Boys east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, the Ahmed Ash-Shuqerei Secondary School for Boys, the Ezbet Abed Rabbo Primary School, and Ezbet Abed Rabbo Preparatory School were partially damaged.

At approximately 2:45 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an agricultural area near Baraka mosque in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 2:45 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an agricultural area east of Ezbet Abed Rabbo area east of Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 3:10 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at the Al Aklouk family farm located west of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 4:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm located east of Abu Obieda Al Jarrah Secondary School for Boys in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 4:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in the Shu'sha'a area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Al Karama towers in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in the As-Sekka street southeast of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:00 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired several missiles at the house of Suliman Abdel Raheem Hasan Salah, 59. The two-story house is located near Al Khulafaa Ar-Rashedeen mosque in Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. Twelve members of the same family, six of whom are children and four of whom are women, live in the house. The front side of the house was totally destroyed and the back side of the house was partially damaged. As a result, the owner of the house Suliman Salah and his son Mohammed, 13, were seriously injured. Medical sources at Al Awda Hospital described their injuries as critical. Fayza Ahmed Salah, 53, and her children Zakaria, 19, and Safaa, 23, were also injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as moderate. Civil defence teams had to rescue two of the women and two of the children who were trapped under the rubble. Four nearby houses were also severely damaged in the attack and six houses were partially damaged. Two vehicles were totally destroyed and in total, 33 persons were injured, including 13 children and seven women. After the attack, four family members were forced to leave their homes afraid of another attack.

At approximately 8:33 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Ahmed Yaseen Street in Ibad Ar-Rahhman area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:05 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm north of the President Guards site in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, three persons were injured, including a child and a woman. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor.

At approximately 10:10 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles at a farm north of the Ministry of Interior building in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, the house of Atta Sa'ad was

damaged and two persons, including a pregnant woman, were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor.

At approximately 10:35 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Al Omda Cement Factory in Beit Hanoun in North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor. Two houses belonging to the Shabat family were damaged in the attack.

At approximately 10:55 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Talet At-Ta'leem (Education Hill) north of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result six persons were injured. Al Mezan has identified them as follows:
Eman Saber Ar-Rahel, 31; her children Saleh, 9; Ghadeer, 7; Abeer, 6; Mohammed, 2; and Ashraf, two months. After the attack, the family left their home.

At approximately 10:57 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near an Al Qassam training site in Qlebbo area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:06 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near an Al Qassam training site in Qlebbo area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:10 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in the As-Saiyafa area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:20 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Green Land Park near the Ash-Sheikh Zaed crossroads in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Annan area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:35 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile an open area near Al Khuzundar petroleum station in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:14 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at an open area west of As-Salateen area in Beit Lahiya, in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 2:10 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at the Abu Haleema family farm in Al Attattra area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, Myassar Salman Abu Haleema, 50, sustained a minor injury.

At approximately 2:15 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at Jabal Al Kashef area in Ezbet Abed Rabbo area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 3:23 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm north of the Ministry of Interior building in Jabaliya, in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 4:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in the As-Saiyafa area in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. As a result, a child sustained a minor injury.

At approximately 4:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Al Hatabiya Street in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:25 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Layalena Wedding Hall in Jablaiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Dabour family farm east of Tal Az-Za'tar in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:28 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at an open area near Az-Zahra Park in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

1.5. Sunday 18 November 2012

At approximately 1:03 am on Sunday 18 November 2012, Israeli drones fired two missiles at the house of Darwesh Hasan Abu Jalalla, 65, in North Gaza district. As a result, the house was partially damaged. According to Al Mezan's field investigations, the IOF phoned the house owner and informed him that it would attack the house at 1:00 am. After the attack, the house owner, his family, and the neighbours were forced to leave their homes. The IOF did not attack the house until the end of the escalation. It's worth noting that the IOF used the 'roof-knock' attack that was used many times during Operation Cast Lead.

At approximately 1:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at a training site for the Al Qassam Brigades east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injuries as minor. Ten adjacent flats were damaged and people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area northeast of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city near Al We'am Charitable Society east of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. As a result, one person was injured. The four-story building of the society was partially damaged.

At approximately 1:50 am on the same day, Israeli drones fired three missiles at the house of the family of Saeed Abu Al-Foul, which consists of four floors and is located in Beit Lahiya town in North Gaza district. Missiles also hit a number of neighbouring houses, which compelled the residents of these houses to evacuate them straightaway, in fear of a heavier IOF bombardment. Only ten minutes after this attack, IOF aircrafts fired three heavy missiles at the Abu Al-Foul house, destroying it completely and seriously damaging six houses in the vicinity. Another 20 houses, six stores, and a mosque were also partially damaged in the attack. Al Mezan's monitoring indicates that 21 people were injured in this attack including 8 children and two women. The Abu Al-Foul family house was inhabited by six families; a total of 22 persons including 10 children and 6 women.

At approximately 2:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Mas'oud family farm east of Al Basheer mosque in Tal Az-Za'tar in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. The missile fell near the house of Ibrahim Ahmed Is'efan, 54. As a result, Tamer Salama Is'efan, 3; and his sister Jumana, 2, were killed. Their father Salama Ibrahim Is'efan, 28, was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injuries as minor. The Is'efan family house was severely damaged and three nearby houses were partially damaged.

At approximately 2:00 am on the same day, Israeli naval vessels patrolling the Gaza sea off the coast of Beit Lahiya and Jabaliya in North Gaza district fired about 40 shells. The shells fell in an open area. The shelling lasted for about 30 minutes. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 2:45 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Ahmed Yassen mosque in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza District. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:50 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired eight heavy missiles that fell in the areas of Fad'ous, Al Jowani, Ash-Shemaa', and Al Kaseeh, and by a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades located near the sewage pools in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. The bombardment lasted until about 3:20 am on the same day. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 3:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Az-Za'neen family in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 3:45 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired approximately 25 missiles at the Qlebbo area near Al We'am Charitable Society, the Felefl family farm, Al Kaseeh farm, Fada'ous, Al Jowani area, Ash-Shemaa' area, and Al Mansheiyia area in Beit Lahiya and near the Beit Hanoun Conjunction in North Gaza district. The firing lasted until 5:00 am on the same day. As a result of the firing, the electricity cut off in the eastern parts of Beit Lahiya, Jabaliya refugee camp, and Tal Az-Za'tar. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:05 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area east of tower number 12; residential building, in Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:30 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fire about 20 missiles at Qlebbo area in the eastern part of Tal Az-Za'tar, Fada'ous and Al Mansheiyia areas, and west of the Al Karama towers area in North Gaza district. The firing lasted until 6:10 am on the same day. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:20 am on the same day, Israeli drones fired two missiles at the house of Ismail Yousif Ghannam in Tal Ad-Dahab area in Beit Lahya, North Gaza district. Missiles also hit some of the neighbouring houses which forced the residents of these houses to evacuate them quickly in fear of a heavier IOF bombardment. Only few minutes after this attack, IOF aircrafts attacked the Ghannam house again, destroying it completely and partially damaging three houses in its vicinity. At approximately 3:20 pm on the same day, IOF drones attacked the remnants of the house once again. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:10 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at Jabaliya police station in Jabaliya refugee camp, North Gaza district. As a result, 20 houses, seven public facilities (including an

UNRWA distribution centre, an UNRWA clinic, two NGO buildings, and three factional offices), and a vehicle were partially damaged.

At approximately 7:40 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in the vicinity of the Civil Administration building in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area north of the General Security crossroads in the west of Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:40 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Presidential Guards site west of Jabaliya, in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Dabour family in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:35 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young Palestinian men who were near UNRWA Preparatory Boys School in Jabaliya refugee camp. As a result, four persons were injured. Medical sources at Al Awda Hospital described the injury of one of them as critical.

At approximately 9:40 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm near Al Qerem crossroads in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, one person sustained a minor injury.

At approximately 10:40 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm west of Al Karama towers west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:50 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area north Al Karama towers west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Beer An-Na'ja area west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:50 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Qlebbo area east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:55 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a yellow Mitsubishi car as it was passing in front of As-Salama Charitable Society near Ash-Sheikh Zaed city crossroads east of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. As a result, four persons who were in the car were injured. Medical sources at Al Awda Hospital described the injuries of one of them as critical. The car was completely destroyed and the charitable society building was partially damaged.

At approximately 1:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm near the Presidential Guards site west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm near Fada'ous area in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm west of Al Fakhoura area in Jabaliya, north Gaza district. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injuries as minor.

At approximately 1:35 pm on the same day, the IOF fired four artillery shells at the eastern parts of Qlebbo area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 2:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Ash-Shemaa' area in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 4:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a small lorry used to sell desalinated water as it was travelling in Jumezat Abu Ghaneema area in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. As a result, driver Suhail 'Ashour Hamada, 42, and his son 'Ashour, 10, were killed. According to medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital the bodies were torn to pieces in the attack. According to Al Mezan's field investigations, the lorry was totally destroyed.

At approximately 5:35 pm on the same day, the IOF fired six artillery shells that fell in areas near the border north of Um Annaser Bedouin village and An-Nada towers in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:50 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at Omar farm in Ash-Shemaa area north of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:15 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Al Jouwani area north of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:25 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young men who were in Hamdoush area north of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm west of At-Twam area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Shifa Hospital described his injuries as minor.

At approximately 7:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Montana wedding hall in At-Twam area west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to Mohammed Faraj Abed Rabbo in Al Jurun area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, Mahmoud Sami Abed Rabbo, 13, was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injuries as minor. Three nearby houses were partially damaged.

At approximately 7:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area east of the Al Qassam military training site in Qlebbo area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile in the vicinity of the sewage pools east of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:15 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in the old Gaza Street in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Felfel family farm east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:40 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of the Police Investigations Department building west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:21 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area southwest of Al Ghoul area west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:25 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area south of Al Karama Hospital west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, the hospital was partially damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:36 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Hijazi Clinic in At-Twam area west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, the clinic and a medical service vehicle were partially damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Dabour family farm east of Tal Az-Za'atar area in Jabaliya, in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. Electricity was cut off over the eastern parts of Jabaliya and Beit Lahiya for about 30 minutes.

At approximately 9:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Berka mosque in Beit Lahiya, in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Tal Ad-Dahab area in Beit Lahiya, in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:53 pm on Sunday 18 November 2012, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Khuzundar petroleum station west of Jablaiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:57 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Khuzundar petroleum station west of Jablaiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:55 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at the house of Jalal Mohammed Saleh Nase, 36, near Abu Sharekh crossroads in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, Jalal sustained critical injury and his son Hussein, 6, was killed. According to Al Mezan's field investigations, the father and his son were on the top roof of the house repairing water net. At approximately 3:00 am on Monday 19 November 2012, medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital announced the death of Jalal. The house was partially damaged.

At approximately 10:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at a farm in Al Israa' neighbourhood west of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm west of Al Karama neighbourhood in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Al Qassam military training site east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed east of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:55 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired two missiles at an open area in the As-Salateen neighbourhood west of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Palestinian naval police site near Al Furosiya spa west of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

1.6. Monday 19 November 2012

At approximately 1:17 am on Monday 19 November 2012, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the house of Fouad Mahmoud Al Askari near Al Awda Hospital in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. The five-story house had been attacked by four roof-knocking rockets. The residents of the house and their neighbours evacuate their homes quickly fearing for their life from heavier IOF bombardment. As a result, the house was completely destroyed, eight adjacent houses were severely damaged, and 10 adjacent houses were partially damaged. 15 persons were injured, including four children and two women. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injury between light and moderate. Four shops were completely damaged. The Askari's family house was inhabited by six families with 40 persons; including 30 children.

At approximately 1:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Al Qassam military training site east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed east of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Dabour family in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:25 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired a missile at a farm in Mas'oud street in Jabliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm south of the 17 Security Force site in At-Twam area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 2:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet aircraft fired a missile at a farm southwest of the 17 Security Force site in At-Twam area in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at the house of Mohammed Ahmed Abdel Hadi Hamad, which is located near the sewage pump in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. The three-story house had been attacked before by three roof-knocking rockets. The residents of the house and their neighbors evacuate their homes quickly fearing for their life from heavier IOF bombardment. As a result of the attack, the house was completely destroyed, three adjacent houses were severely damaged, and five adjacent houses were partially damaged. . The Hamad's family house was inhabited by six families with 50 persons; including 30 children and six women. Medical crew stated to Al Mezan that the IOF drone attacked the house while they were rescuing people.

At approximately 5:50 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting farmer Abdel Rahman Mohammed Al Attar, 51, as he was in front of his house near As-Salateen water well in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. As a result, Abdel Rahaman Al Attar was killed. According to Al Mezan's field investigations, Al Attar used to go to the market to sell potato using his donkey-driven cart.

At approximately 7:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Az-Zawia street south of the Palestinian Red Crescent Society building east of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified. The building of the society was partially damaged.

At approximately 10:05 am on the same day, an Israeli jet fired a missile at a farm located in Al Hattabiya street in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at playground of Beit Hanoun Youth Sport Club, in North Gaza district. The club and Omar Bin Abdel Aziz mosque were partially damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 11:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to Az-Za'aneen family in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:55 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to Mesleh Faraj Abed Rabbo north of Abu Al Kheer mosque in Jabalia, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:05 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the house of Juma'a Ismail Hussein An-Najjar which is located in the old Gaza street in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. The two-story house had been attacked before by IOF drones by roof-knocking rockets. The residents of the house and their neighbors evacuate their homes quickly fearing for their life from heavier IOF bombardment. As a result, the house was completely destroyed, two adjacent houses were severely damaged, and five adjacent houses were partially damaged. Seven persons were injured, including two children and two women.

At approximately 12:10 am on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles at an open area west of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:20 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to Az-Za'aneen family in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm near Beit Hanoun municipality building in Beit Hanoun, in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Hijazi Clinic in At-Twam area west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. The clinic building and an adjacent mosque were severely damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 2:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a vehicle that was travelling on the coastal road near Taha mosque in Jabaliya, in North Gaza district. As a result, three persons were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan and Al Awda Hospitala described their injuries between moderate and critical.

At approximately 2:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting a gray Hyundai car that was travelling opposite Khalid Bin Al Waleed mosque in the As-Saftawi street in Jabliya, North Gaza district. As a result, driver Husam Fayiz Abdel Jawwad, 32, was killed. A white Honda car was coincidentally travelling beside the attacked car. As a result, its driver Dr. Fadel Mohammed Jouda, 57, and pharmacist Ya'qoub Mohammed Ahmed Mhessien, 35, were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injury as moderate. The Jouda's car, three houses, and a shop were severely damaged.

At approximately 2:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Al Karama area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 3:20 pm on the same day, IOF fired about 20 artillery shells at the border areas north of Beit Hanoun, Um An-Naser village, and Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. The firing lasted at about 4:30 pm on the same day. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 4:55 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near the house of Saleh Fad'ous in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. The house was partially damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 5:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in At-Twam area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 5:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Beer An-Na'ja area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 5:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Al Israa' neighborhood in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 5:00 pm on the same day, IOF fired about 12 artillery shells that fell in border area north of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 6:55 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young Palestinian men who were in Beit Hanoun cemetery in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 7:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircraft fired two missiles at the house of Fouad Khalil Hijazi which is located north of Abu Hussein Schools in Jabaliya refugee camp, North Gaza district. As a result, the house owner Fouad Khalil Hijazi, 46, and his sons Mohammed, 4, and Suhaib, 2, were killed. 21 persons were injured, including seven children and four women. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described the injury of three of them as critical including Amna Mohammed Ali Hijazi, 43, and her son Mustafa, 20. The house was completely destroyed and four adjacent houses were partially damaged. According to Al Mezan's field investigations, at approximately 9:20 pm on the same day, civil defense crew found the dead bodies of the father and his two children.

At approximately 10:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Al Hatabiya street in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 10:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades, east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 10:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile near Abu Huthaifa An-Nu'man mosque in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 10:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in the Court street in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 10:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Layalena Wedding Hall in Jablaiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 10:45 pm on the same day, Israeli jet planes fired three missiles at the building of North Gaza Governorate near At-Ta'leem crossroads east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, the building was completely destroyed, five adjacent public facilities and five houses were partially damaged. Al Mezan has identified the public facilities as follows: stores for Ministry of Social Affairs, building of Islamic Sharea' court, Ministry of Education, Al Quds Open University, and Ash-Sheikh Zaed police station.

At approximately 11:10 pm on the same day, IOF fired about 35 artillery shells that fell in areas near the border north of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. The firing lasted about midnight. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

1.7. Tuesday 20 November 2012

At around midnight on Tuesday 20 November 2012, IOF fired about 35 artillery shells that fell in areas near the border north of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. The firing lasted at about 1:00 am on Tuesday 20 November 2012. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 2:50 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a military training site for the Al Qassam Brigades, east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 3:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Al Attattra area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 3:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Qassam training site in Qlebbo area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 3:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Jabal Al Kashef area east of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 5:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Jabal Al Kashef area east of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 5:20 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in the vicinity of Civil Administration building in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 5:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the house of Mohammed Mahmoud As-Sultan near Al Eman mosque in As-Salatten area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. The house had been attacked before by two roof-knocking rockets ten minutes before the attack. This forced the residents of the house to evacuate it quickly fearing for their life from heavier IOF bombardment. As a result, the house was completely destroyed, five adjacent houses were severely damaged, and another five houses were partially damaged. Four persons were injured, the owner of the house, his wife, and their two children. Medical sources at Al Awda Hospital described their injury as minor.

At approximately 6:10 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in An-Na'aima street in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 6:15 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Al Banat street in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 7:00 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Felfel family farm east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 7:00 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting Belal Mhesin Khalil Al Barrawi, 21, as he was in Al Barrawi street in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, Al Barrawi was immediately killed.

At approximately 8:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Al Jamal family east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified. Window panes of three adjacent houses were damaged.

At approximately 8:35 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at Yahya Akram Ma'rouf, 20, while he was walking near Al Attatra water tower northwest of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, Ma'rouf was immediately killed.

At approximately 9:15 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at bird hunter Mohammed 'Awad, 40, and his son Yahya, 17, as they were in the Hamada family farm east of Al Waha resort north west of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. As a result, Yahya was immediately killed and his father sustained critical injury. According to Al Mezan's field investigations, the father and his son used to hunt birds in that area.

At approximately 9:15 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at the house of Hisham Ahmed Al Attar in Al Attatra area in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. The house had been attacked ten minutes before by two roof-knocking rockets. This forced the residents of the house and neighbors to evacuate it quickly fearing for their life from heavier IOF bombardment. As a result, the house was

completely damaged, three adjacent houses were severely damaged, and another five houses were partially damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 10:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Jabal Al Kashef area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 11:05 am on the same day, an Israeli helicopter fired a missile at the Ali family farm south of the Palestinian Red Crescent Society in Izbet Abed Rabbi in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, rami Mohammed Abed Rabbo, 28, was injured and the society building was partially damaged.

At approximately 11:30 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting Abdel Rahaman Mustafa Hamad, 31, as he was walking near Al Karama towers west of Jabaliya in North Gaza district. As a result, he was immediately killed. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital reported that his body was dismembered.

At approximately 1:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the house of Mustafa Yousif Al Mtawaq which is located in the old Gaza street in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. The three-story house had been attacked ten minutes before by two roof-knocking rockets. One of the rockets fell on his father's house. This forced the residents of the house and neighbors to evacuate it quickly fearing for their life from heavier IOF bombardment. As a result, the house and three adjacent houses were severely damaged and another five houses were partially damaged. One person was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injury as minor.

At approximately 1:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm near Al Huda and At-Tawheed mosque in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people were terrified.

At approximately 3:50 pm on the same day, IOF fired about 40 artillery shells that fell in farms and open areas in Al Banat street south of Beit Hanoun in North Gaza district. As a result, Ayman Rafeq Abu Rashed, 28, was killed. Five houses were damaged. The firing lasted at about 4:30 pm on the same day.

At approximately 4:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircraft fired leaflets on Al Ghboun area, north of Beit Lahiya, Al Attattra, As-Salateen, Al Israa neighborhood, Ash-Sheikh Zaed city, Um An-Naser Bedouin village, Beit Hanoun and Ezbet Beit Hanoun in North Gaza district. The leaflets warn residents of that areas and ordered them to evacuate their homes. The leaflets guided the residents of those area to ways and where to go. Families immediately started to evacuate their homes and walked in streets that the IOF determined for them. Most of the people went to UNRWA schools in An –Naser street in Gaza city.

The leaflets state "Military Notification: to residents to Ash-Shatee', Al Attattra, Biet Hanoun, and Beit Lahiya, the IOF does not attack you and does not want to harm any of you and your family. For your safety you are ordered to immediately evacuate your homes and move to the center of Gaza city through At-Twam, Al Falouja, Al Awda, As-Sekka, and Salah Ad-Din streets. You have to go to the center of Gaza city between the west of Salah Ad-Din street and north of Omar Al Mukhtar street, east of An-Naser street, south of Al Quds street. This is temporary and at the end everyone will go to his home."

Therefore, hundreds of residents of Al Attattra, As-Saalteen, Al Ghboun, Izbet Abed Rabbo, Beit Hanoun, and Ash-Sheikh Zaed city went to UNRWA schools. About 1,500 persons sheltered in three UNRWA schools.

At approximately 5:50 pm on the same day, IOF fired a missile that fell near the Ma'rouf family house near Al Baraka mosque in Al Ghboun north of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:20 pm on the same day, IOF fired about 60 artillery shells that fell on areas north of Beit Hanoun, Ezbet Beit Hanoun, An-Nada towers, Um An-Naser Bedouin village, and Beit Lahiya. One of the shells hit at around 7:40 pm on the same day a flat in An-Nada towers. As a result, one person was injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described his injury as moderate. Another shell fell at 7:55 pm on the same day at As-Sedeqeen mosque in Beit Lahiya. As a result one woman was traumatized. The firing continued until 8:30 pm on the same day.

At approximately 7:40 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Mat'haf restaurant west of Jablaiya, North Gaza district. Two adjacent houses were partially damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at Al Ghboun area in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:20 pm on the same day, Israeli naval vessels patrolling the Gaza sea off the coast of Beit Lahiya and Jabaliya in North Gaza fired about 20 shells at an open area close to the coast. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young Palestinian men who were near Al Omari mosque in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were injured. Medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital described their injury as moderate.

At approximately 9:37 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area north of Al Qassam military training site east of Ash-sheikh Zaed city, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:44 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near the customs crossroads in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. Six houses were damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in that area were terrified.

At approximately 9:50 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a farm north of Al Andalous tower east of Al Karama towers in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 10:25 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. Five adjacent houses were damaged due to the IOF frequent attack on the farm.

At approximately 10:35 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. Five adjacent houses were damaged due to the IOF frequent attack on the farm.

At approximately 11:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Halawa family near Qebaa' mosque in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm belonging to the Kelani family in Beit Hanoun, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:30 pm on the same, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Abu Ja'far Al Mansour School in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 11:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm near Al Andaloud tower west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

1.8. Wednesday 21 November 2012,

At around midnight on Wednesday 21 November 2012, isareli jet planes fired two missiles at the National Forces Security site east of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. Eight adjacent houses were damaged. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:45 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Al Karama towers west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:50 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at a farm in Al 'Attatra area west of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:10 am on the same day, IOF fired about 20 artillery shells that fell on Beit Hanaoun and Izbet Beit Hanoun, An-Nada towers, Um Annaser Bedouin village, east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city, and north of Beit Hanoun. The firing lasted at about 1:30 am on the same day. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:15 am on the same day, IOF fired two artillery shells that fell at Beit Hanoun Hospital. One shell hit the northern side of the hospital building and the second shell fell in the hospital yard. According to Al Mezan's field investigations, the shells did not explode. No casualties or injuries were reported but patients, medical crew and administration staff, and people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:25 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 1:30 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at the Ar-Radee' family farm in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:05 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Al Karama towers west of Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:15 am on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting Mustafa 'Awad Abu Hmeedan, 23, as he was near the Dabour family farm in As-Sekka street east of Tal Az-Za'tar in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, Abu Hmeedan was killed instantly.

At approximately 9:20 am on the same day, IOF fired about 20 artillery shells that fell north of An-Nada towers, north and east of Um Annaser Bedouin village, and north of Beit Hanoun. The firing lasted at about 10:50 am on the same day. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified. At approximately 10:00 am on the same day, a shell fell near the house of Nasser Abu Qleq in the Bedouin village. As a result, two persons were injured.

At approximately 11:55 am on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Mus'ab Bin Omaeir mosque in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 12:15 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting Mohammed 'Adnan Al Ashqar, 22, while he was near water desalination plant in Al Waha area northwest of Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. As a result, Al Ashqar was immediately killed.

At approximately 2:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting a family that was sitting in their farm near their home in Ahmed Yassen street in Ibad Ar-Rahman neighborhood west of Jablaiya, North Gaza district. As a result, Talal Sa'adi Al 'Asali, 48; his son Ayman, 19; and his granddaughter, Abeer, 12, were killed.

At approximately 4:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting a group of young Palestinian men from the Al Qattnani family and their neighbors who were in front of the Al Qattnani's house in Beer An-Na'ja area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, seven persons were injured. Medical sources described the injury of two of them as critical. At approximately 9:00 pm on the same day, medical sources at Kamal Odwan Hospital announced the death of Fadi Mousa Samir Al Qattnani, 28, from wounds that he had sustained in the attack.

At approximately 5:05 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young Palestinian men who were east of Al Basheer mosque in Tal Az-Za'atr in Jabaliya, north Gaza district. As a result, Ibrahim Mhessien Shehada, 22, was pronounced dead on arrival to Al Awda Hospital. Another person sustained critical injury.

At approximately 5:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young Palestinian men who were in a farm near Al Ihasan mosque in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 5:30 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile at a group of young Palestinian men who were near Al 'Amoudi crossroads in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. As a result, two persons were critically injured.

At approximately 5:50 pm on the same day, IOF fired about 25 artillery shells that fell on areas north of Beit Hanoun, Ezbet Beit Hanoun, An-Nada towers, Um An-Naser Bedouin village, east of Ash-Sheikh Zaed city, north of Beit Lahiya, and east of Tal Az-Za'tar and Jabaliya. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:10 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Khuzundar petroleum station in Jabaliya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 6:40 pm on the same day, an Israeli drone fired a missile targeting Na'em Abdel Hadi Kabaja, 48, as he was in front of his house near Omar Bin Al Khattab mosque in Ibad Ar-Rahman area in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, he sustained moderate injury.

At approximately 7:15 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area in Al Manshiya in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 7:28 pm on the same day, Israeli jet plane fired a missile targeting the building of the former Civil Administration east of Jabaliya refugee camp in North Gaza district. As a result, six persons sustained minor injury. Four adjacent houses were partially damaged.

At approximately 8:20 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area east of As-Sekka Street east of Tal Az-Za'tar in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. As a result, two persons sustained minor injury. Three adjacent houses were damaged.

At approximately 8:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Layalena Wedding Hall in Jablaiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near an Al Qassam training site in Qlebbo area east of Beit Lahiya in North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:45 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area west of Al 'Attattra in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 8:59 pm on the same day, Israeli jet plane fired two missiles at an open area west of As-Salatten in Beit Lahiya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

At approximately 9:03 pm on the same day, an Israeli jet plane fired a missile at an open area near Al Haq mosque near Al Khuzundar petroleum station in Jabaliya, North Gaza district. No casualties or injuries were reported but people in the area were terrified.

2. Gaza City District

Note: Please that this section of the report does not cover all of the airstrikes carried out by the IOF in Gaza City due to the large number and that fact that many of them targeted open areas. This section of the report therefore focuses primarily on the attacks that resulted in deaths and injuries.

2.1. Wednesday 14 November 2012

At approximately 3:50 pm, on Wednesday 14 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts targeted a car (silver Kia) with one missile. The car was driving on a street near the Public Service Hospital in Al-Sabra neighbourhood, south of Gaza City. Ahmad Sa'eed Al-Ja'bari, Head of the Al-Qassam Military Brigades, 52, and a resident of Ash-Sheja'ya neighbourhood, was killed in the attack; his bodyguard, Mohammed Hamid Al-Hams, 28, a resident of Gaza City was also killed.

At approximately, 3:50 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts bombed another civilian car which was driving by Al-Amal Hotel, west of Gaza City. The attack did not result in any deaths or injuries.

At approximately 4:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted with one missile a civilian car, which was driving on Ahmed Yasin Street in Al-Sabra neighbourhood, south of Gaza City. The targeted persons survived the attack. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:55 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes, targeting a house which belongs to Yousef Salah Arafat, 30. The house is located in the southeast of Gaza city, in Az-Zaytoon neighbourhood, next to an orchard which belongs to the Abu Daf family. The attack completely destroyed the 150-square-meter house belonging to Yousef Salah Arafat and another house, 80 square meters in area, belonging to Jalal Saleh Arafat, 24. One child, Ronan Yousef Farahat, 3, was also killed in

the attack; her body was pulled from under the rubble one hour after the attack took place. Ronan's mother, Iman Jalal Arafat, 35, and Ronan's siblings, 8-year-old Maria, and 7-year-old Jalal were both wounded in the attack,

At approximately 4:55 pm, on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting a house belonging to Ali Nimr Al-Mashharawi, 54, located in Az-Zaytoon neighbourhood near Bilal Bin Rabah mosque. The 200 squaremeters house was completely destroyed in the air raid. Omar Jihad Al-Mashharawi, 11 months was killed in the attack in addition to Hiba Adil Al-Mashharawi, 19, who was also killed in the air strike. Both Ali Jihad Al-Mashharawi, 4, and Ahmad Al-Mashharawi, 18, were wounded.

At approximately 5:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting the Abu Jarad training camp, near Nizarim evacuated settlement in Az-Zaytoon neighbourhood, southeast of Gaza City. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately, 5:00 pm on the same day, Israel aircrafts launched three airstrikes targeting open fields east of Ash-Sheja'ya area, east of Gaza City. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:05 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched two airstrikes at open fields east of Ash-Sheja'ya neighbourhood, east of Gaza City. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately, 5:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting a jeep driving near Al-Jalaa crossroads in Ash-Sheikh Radwan neighbourhood, north of Gaza City. The jeep was damaged seriously in the air strike, and no casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:30 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched two airstrikes, targeting a house in Tel Al-Hawa area belonging to Rashid Abu Shbak, former Head of Preventive Security Forces. The two-story house was entirely destroyed in the attack, in addition to two other houses which were also completely destroyed; 30 other adjacent houses were partially damaged in the air strike, and four civilian cars were damaged. Moreover, 20 persons were injured in the attack, two of them sustained critical injuries.

At approximately 7:50 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting a civilian car driving on Al-Thalatheeny road in Al-Sabra neighbourhood, south of Gaza City. The persons inside the car survived the attack as the missile missed the target and hit the road. No injuries were reported.

At approximately, 7:50 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting a civilian car driving near Abullah Azzam mosque, in As-Sabra neighbourhood, south of Gaza City. The persons inside the car survived the attack with no reported injuries.

At approximately 10:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts fired a missile targeting the Tunis Camp which belongs to the Al-Qassam Brigades; it is located in the east of Ash-Sheja'ya area, east of Gaza City. Two schools were partially damaged in the attack. The schools are: Bisan Primary School for Girls and Tunis Secondary School for Boys.

At approximately, 11:30 pm on the same day, Israel aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting the Tunis Camp belonging to Al-Qassam Brigades for the second time which resulted in partial damage to two schools located near the camp.

2.2. Thursday 15 November 2012

At approximately 1:30 am, on Thursday 15 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting Al-Qassam Brigades' Badr Camp, west of An-Nasr neighbourhood, in the south of Gaza. No injuries or damage were reported.

At approximately 3:30 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field located to the east of Abu Mazen crossroads, opposite Mecca Tower. The airstrike caused partial damage to the surrounding houses. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:30 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, opposite the Palestinian Legislative Council (PLC) building. No injuries or damage were reported.

At approximately 9:40 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike towards an open field to the east of the Abu Mazen crossroads, opposite Mecca Tower in the west of Gaza City. The strike caused partial damage to the surrounding houses. No injuries were reported (this was the second time this piece of land was targeted).

At approximately 9:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, located behind Ala' Ed-din power station in As-Sabra neighbourhood, south of Gaza City. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 11:30 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes targeting a piece of land next to several houses belonging to the Tafish family from the Shaloof area, east of Az-Zaytoon neighborhood, east of Gaza City. One of the missiles hit one of the houses belonging to Khaled Tafish, 30. The house was completely destroyed in the attack. A 10-month infant, Hanin Khalid Tafish, was critically injured in the attack and died on the same day at 7:30 pm. Another five-story house, which also belonged to the Tafish family and a 1983 yellow Subaru car belonging to Sami Rafiq Tafish, were also completely destroyed.

At approximately 1:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at the Al-Qassam Brigades' Badr training site, to the west of Gaza City. Several of the surrounding houses and four schools were partially damaged in the attack.

At approximately 5:35 pm on the same day, Israel aircrafts launched one airstrike at the Civil Administration building in the south of Tal Al-Hawa area in the west of Gaza City. The headquarters were completely destroyed as a result of the attack.

At approximately 7:10 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at a road near a water pool, in Ash-Sheikh Radwan neighbourhood, north east of Gaza City. A number of people sustained minor injuries as a result of the attack.

At approximately 8:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field in As-Sabra area, south of Gaza City. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:30 pm, the same day, Israeli warships fired one shell at the power generator belonging to Prime Minister Ismail Haniyya, west of Gaza city. The generator was entirely destroyed along with a Nissan jeep. No injuries were reported.

2.3. Friday 16 November 2012

At approximately 8:00 am, on Friday, 16 November 2012, Shifa Hospital received the body of Kamal Mohammed Moqat, 23, a resident of Al-Sheikh Radwan area in the east of Gaza City. According to the

Forensics Department in the hospital, Moqat died of a heart attack possibly brought on by the shock of the military attacks.

At approximately 2:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at an open field near Hassan Al-Banna mosque, in Az-Zaytoon area in the east of Gaza City. Younis Kamil Tafish, 55, was killed as he was riding a motorcycle near the targeted place.

At approximately, 3:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at an open field near Al-Rayyis hill in the east of the At-Tuffah neighbourhood, east of Gaza City. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:30 pm on the same day, Israel aircrafts launched an airstrike targeting the Badr training site, which belongs to the Al-Qassam Brigades, located west of the Al-Maqqousi Buildings, west of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:30 pm, on Friday 16 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at an open field of land, near the Television Building in Tal Al HawaTal, west of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at an open field, east of Ash-Sheja'ya, east of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, east of Ash-Sheja'ya, east of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately, 6:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, east of Ash-Sheja'ya, east of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately, 6:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, east of Ash-Sheja'ya, east of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately, 6:45 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, east of Ash-Sheja'ya, east of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an air strike at an open field, east of At-Tuffah neighbourhood, east of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at an open field, west of An-Nasr area, west of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at an open field in Tel Al-Hawa area, west of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, west of An-Nasr area, west of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:35 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched five airstrikes targeting the Civil Affairs department at the Ministry of Interior for the second time in two days. The building was entirely destroyed as a result of the attack, and several surrounding buildings in addition to 6 schools (including 4 UNRWA schools) were partially damaged.

At approximately 10:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike targeting a group of people who were standing next to the Al-Qurmuzi mosque in Ash-Sheja'ya area in the east of Gaza City. One person, Ayman Rafeeq Esleem, 26, who is a member of the Al-Quds Brigades, was killed in the attack, and another sustained moderate injuries.

2.4. Saturday 17 November 2012

At approximately 3:30 am on Saturday 17 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts launched five airstrikes targeting the Administration offices at the Arafat Police Compound, west of Gaza City. The building was entirely destroyed as a result of the attack. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:10 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes targeting the HQ of the Palestine Cabinet in the west of Gaza City; the attack completely destroyed the headquarters. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:45 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched five airstrikes targeting the Palestine Stadium, west of Gaza City. The stadium was entirely destroyed in the airstrike, but no injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:00 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field near Port Said Street (locally known as Al-Nafaq St.), north of Gaza City. Two were injured in the attack.

At approximately 10:45 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, located near Al-Lababeedi Street, west of Gaza City. No damage or injuries were reported.

At approximately 12:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting Mohammed Ahmed Yasin, 22, who was, at the time, close to the Star drinks factory on Salahudin road in the east of Gaza City. Yasin was known as a member of the Al-Quds Brigades; he sustained critical injuries in the attack and died at approximately 1:30 pm.

At approximately 5:45 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting one civilian near to the Al-Maqqousi buildings in the west of An-Nasr neighbourhood, west of Gaza City. The targeted person sustained moderate injuries.

At approximately 4:40 am on the same day, Israeli drones launched three missiles targeting two neighbouring houses located on Ahmed Yassin Street in Az-Zaytoon neighbourhood, south of Gaza City. Five minutes later, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting one of the two houses (the first attack was therefore a 'roof-knocking' attack). The house belongs to Abdel Mu'tti Ramadan Al-Haddad, 41; it was destroyed completely in the attack. Two families comprising 19 people including 14 children lived in the house. The neighbouring house, belonging to Salem Mohammed El-Haddad, 75, was also severely damaged. Seven families comprising 40 people, including 27 children live in that house, which is six stories. One person, Khalil Atif Al-Haddad, 26, was injured in the right leg. Another house located opposite the targeted house, belonging to Ahmed Mohammed Al-Haddad, 70, was also completely destroyed in the attack. 14 persons, including 6 children, lived in that house. In addition, the main HQ of El-Haddad Company, which is a medical supplies storehouse, was destroyed as a result of the attack. The storehouse contained supplies worth approximately \$200,000.

At approximately 5:45 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike against one civilian near Al-Maqqousi Buildings, west of Gaza City. The targeted person sustained moderate wounds as a result of the attack and was admitted at Al-Shifa Hospital.

At approximately 12:30 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes targeting the Administration offices at the Arafat Police Compound, west of Gaza City. The building was completely destroyed as a result of the airstrike, but no injuries were reported. This is the second time this site had been targeted within a 24-hour period.

At approximately 1:35 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike targeting Al-Quds satellite channel which is located at Al-Shawwa and-Husary tower on Al-Wehda street, west of Gaza City. Five minutes later, IOF aircrafts targeted the same building with three missiles which resulted in it being completely destroyed. 7 persons, all producers and cameramen who work for the channel, were wounded. One person, Khader El-Zahhar, 20, was injured and had his leg amputated. Several neighbouring offices which belong to the Alwan radio station and Al-Manar channel, located in the same building were also damaged as a result of the airstrikes.

2.5. Sunday 18 November 2012

At approximately 6:00 am on Sunday, 18 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts launched two airstrikes targeting Al-Saraya (Gaza's central prison) in the middle of Gaza City. Several houses were damaged as a result of the airstrike. A two-storey house belonging to the National Security Force was entirely destroyed in the attack.

At approximately 6:15 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an elderly lady while she was feeding her pigeons in a chicken farm located behind her house in Ash-Sheja'ya area, east of Gaza City. The woman, Saidiyya Al-Aidy, 62, was killed immediately as a result of the strike.

At approximately 7:00 am on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at the Al-Aqsa TV channel's building located at Al-Shurouq building in Ar-Rimal district in the west of Gaza City. Several media offices were damaged as a result of the strike. These offices belong to different media agencies including, Palestine Agency for Media Production, Al-Mayadin TV, Press TV, Abu Dhabi channel's office, Sky News office, and Dubai TV's office. Six journalists and cameramen were wounded in the attack.

At approximately 7:10 am on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched five airstrikes targeting the main police station at Al-Tuffah neighbourhood east of Gaza City. Four houses populated by 40 persons, including 20 children were entirely destroyed in the airstrike. One woman, Nawal Faraj Abdulal, 53, was killed in the airstrike; her body was pulled from the debris three hours after the attack took place. 10 others were also injured, including 6 children. Tens of neighbouring houses were also partially damaged in the strikes. Al-Hurriyah Mechanic Company was also completely destroyed in the attacks.

At approximately 11:30 am on the same day the Israeli Navy fired a shell at Ahmed Issam El-Nahhal, 25. He was a member of the Al-Qassam Brigades. The attack took place near Baghdad mosque in Shaati' Camp. The targeted person and a child, Tasnim Zuheir El-Nahhal, 10, were both killed in the attack. Five other passers-by were also injured.

At approximately 11:30 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike at the backyard of a house belonging to Suheila Tarazi, 62, Director of Al-Ahli Hospital in Gaza. The house was severely damaged in the airstrike.

At approximately 11:30 am on the same day Israeli drones launched one airstrike targeting a house belonging to Baha' Salim Abulatta, 36, located near the Friday Market in Al-Sheja'ya in the east of Gaza City. Five minutes later, Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes targeting a house which belongs to Rafiq Salem Hilles, 65, which is next to Abulatta's house. The airstrike completely destroyed the two-

storey house. Abulatta's house along with several houses in the area were severely damaged as a result of the attack.

At approximately 12:40 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at Gaza's port. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 1:45 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched two airstrikes targeting an apartment on the 12 floor of Al-Dana Building in An-Nasr Street, west of Gaza City. The apartment belongs to Ahmed Abu Nahl who bought it only four days before the attack. The apartment was entirely destroyed in the attack, and several neighbouring houses were partially damaged. Three persons sustained minor injuries as a result of the attack.

At approximately 2:35 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting a house which belongs to Jamal Mahmoud Yassin, 52, located opposite the Bank of Palestine in An-Nasr neighbourhood, west of Gaza City. Two families comprising 11 people including 6 children live in the four-storey house. The attack took place whilst all members of the two families were inside the house except for the owner of the house, which needs to be verified later. The airstrike resulted in the death of Samah Abdul Hamid Ad-Dalou, 27, and her two sons, Ibrahim Mohammed Ad-Dalou, 1 and Yousef Mohammed Ad-Dalou, 4. The wife of the owner of the house, Tahani Hassan Ad-Dalou, 52, his sister, Suheila Mahmoud Ad-Dalou, 73, and his daughter, Ranin, 22, were all killed as a result of the attack. Two other people who were at a neighbouring house were also killed in the attack: Abdullah Mohammed Al-Muzannar, 18, and Uminya Mattar Al-Muzannar, 75. Several others were wounded, including 2 children and 3 women. The victims listed for this attack are those whose bodies had been taken to Shifa Hospital in Gaza City. However, more bodies may be found under the rubble as the searches are on-going.

At approximately 4:00 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike against two fighters at the end of Al-Muntar, east of Ash-Sheja'ya, east of Gaza City. The targeted persons, Sami Imad Al-Ghafir, 24, and Mohammed Bakr Al-Aff, 22, were immediately killed in the attack.

2.6. Monday 19 November 2012

At approximately 10:00 am on Monday 19 November 2012, Israeli warplanes fired one airstrike at a civilian car which was driving near Alaa' Ad-Din petroleum station, south of Gaza City. As a result, one person, Mohammed Riyadh Shamalakh, 24, who was affiliated to the Al-Quds Brigades, the military wing of Islamic Jihad movement, was killed. Two others including a taxi driver were injured in the attack.

At approximately 4:20 pm on Monday 19 November 2012, Israeli warplanes launched two airstrikes at a media office belonging to the Islamic Jihad movement in Gaza. The office is located on the first floor of Al-Shurouq building in the middle of Al-Rimal neighborhood, west of Gaza City. As a result, one person, Ramiz Najib Deeb, 34, who was affiliated to the Islamic Jihad movement, was killed. The office was entirely destroyed in the attack, and several media offices belonging to local and international agencies were also damaged. Four other civilians sustained minor injuries including two cameramen: Mohammed Al-Ashqar from Al-Quds TV, and Ahmed Al-Ruzzi from Al-Arabiya TV.

At approximately 8:00 pm on Monday 19 November 2012, Israeli warplanes launched one airstrike at an open field in Ash-Sha'af area, east of At-Tuffah neighborhood, east of Gaza City.

Two persons were injured as a result of the attack including a pregnant woman. Their injuries were described as minor by medical sources at Shifa hospital.

At approximately 8:00 pm on the same day, Israeli drones launched three airstrikes targeting a house belonging to Hazem Al-Hallaq, 35, who is the brother of the released Palestinian prisoner, Raed Al-Hallaq. The house is located on Tunis Street in Tal Al HawaTal Al Hawa area, west of Gaza City. The two families which live in the two-storey building fled the house in fear of targeting it again by Israeli warplanes. No damaged was caused to the targeted house.

At approximately 10:00 pm on the same day, Israeli drones launched one airstrike at the Jordanian Hospital located on Tunis Street in Tal Al Hawa neighbourhood, west of Gaza City. as a result, the missile left a whole in the top roof of the Hospital. Tuesday 20 November 2012

2.7. Tuesday 20 November 2012

At approximately 12:45 am on Tuesday 20 November 2012, Israeli warplanes launched one airstrike at the Islamic National Bank located on Al-Wehda Street near the Governmental Departments' Compound known as Abu Khadra. The bank was entirely destroyed from the inside (furniture, offices, equipment) while neighboring houses were partially destroyed.

At approximately 3:05 am on the same day, Ayman Ahmed Al-Khouli, 41, received a phone call from a person at the Israeli army who warned him to evacuate the house along with his family within 5 minutes. Ayman was told to not take any of his belongings from the house; otherwise, he will be targeted. Within in five minutes, Ayman was able to evacuate the three-story house which resided by seven families consisting of 45 members, including 30 children. The house is located on Salah Ad-Din street near Doula crossing in Az--Zaytoon neighborhood, east of Gaza City. Five minutes after the phone call, an Israeli drone launched one airstrike at the house. 10 minutes afterwards, at approximately 3:20 am, Israel warplanes launched two airstrikes at the house hugely damaging it. At 6:00 am as Ayman and his brothers returned to the house after it was targeted, Israeli drones fired a new missile at the house as a result of which the house was completely destroyed.

At approximately 1:40 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched one airstrike at a group of people standing next to As-Salaam Mosque, east of Ash-Sheja'iya neighborhood, east of Gaza City. One person, Amin Mahmoud Al-Dadada, 29, who was a resident of Ash-Sheja'iya neighborhood, was killed in the attack. Three other persons were injured, two of them sustaining critical injuries.

At approximately 3:30 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched two airstrikes at two persons, each inside his car, while they were driving on Al-Fawayda Street near Al-Mostaqbal club in Tal Al HawaTal Al Hawa, west of Gaza City. As a result, five persons were killed and another person was injured. Al Mezan has identified their names as follows:

- Salah Nemr Doghmosh, 29;
- Subhi Nemr Doghmosh, 29;
- , Ahmed Jameel Doghmosh, 30;
- Mosa'ab Khader Doghmosh, 22, and
- Zaki Sa'eed Qadada, 42.

At approximately 3:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched one airstrike at the backyard of a house belonging to Rizq Al-Qilani Ashour on Kishko Street in Az-Zaytoon neighborhood, east of Gaza City. A group of children were playing together when the missile hit them. As result, one of the children, Mohammed Ibrahim Ashoor, 8, was killed. 6 other children were injured, two of them with critical injuries.

At approximately 4:00 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched one airstrike at a house belonging to Basil Murtada Al-Shawwa, 56. The house is located at Baghdad Street in Ash-Sheja'iyah neighborhood, east of Gaza City. As a result, one person, Yousra Basil Al-Shawwa, 18, who is the daughter of the owner of the house, was killed while her mother sustained moderate injuries. A few minutes later, Israeli warplanes launched another airstrike at a group of people who were beneath the targeted house. Three persons were killed as a result and one more was injured. Those who were killed are: Mahmoud Mohammed Az-Zuhary, 21, Saqer Khalil Bulbul, 56, and Tariq Awni Hujaila, 40.

At approximately 5:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplane launched one airstrike at a black Renault car. Inside the car were two persons, Hussam Mohammed Salama, 30; and Mahmoud Ali Al-Koumi, 29, who worked as cameramen at Al-Aqsa satellite TV. As a result, they were immediately killed

At approximately 9:00 pm on the same day, medical sources at Ash-Shifa Hospital announced that Oda Arafat Al-Shandi, 18, a resident of Ash-Shejaiya neighborhood, succumbed to wounds he sustained earlier on the same day, as a result of a strike which hit Al-Dadada area near As-Salam mosque.

At approximately 9:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli aircraft launched one airstrike at a chicken farm located behind a house belonging to Amer Eid Abu Manee' in An-Nasr neighborhood, west of Gaza City. The strike resulted in one critical injury. Partial damage was caused to the five-storey house which is resided by six families.

At approximately 9:30 pm on the same day , an Israeli aircraft launched one airstrike at a villa belonging to Azzam Abdel Karim Al-Shawwa, 45, who is director of Al-Quds Bank and lives in the West Bank. The empty house was entirely destroyed as a result of the strike.

At approximately 22:45 pm on the same day, Israeli aircraft launched two airstrikes at two apartments at Ni'ma Tower in Ar-Rimal neighborhood, west of Gaza City. The first apartment is a media office belonging to the Hellis family while the other is an office belonging to a person

from the As-Sourani family who is a researcher and historian. Partial damage was caused to neighboring Gaza Mall.

2.8. Wednesday 21 November 2012

At approximately 2:00 am on Wednesday 21 November 2012, Israeli warplanes launched eight airstrikes at the Governmental Departments' Compound (Abu Khadara), in Gaza City. The compound was entirely destroyed, and several neighboring buildings, including Cairo Amman Bank, were partially damaged as a result of the attack. Aljazeera and AP offices located at the eleventh floor of Al-Jalaa Tower were also partially damaged.

At approximately 2:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli aircraft launched one airstrike at an open field on Port Said Street in the middle of Gaza City. One child, Mahmoud Attiyya Abu Khousa, 13, was killed, and three others, including one child, were injured as a result of the attack.

At approximately 3:00 pm on the same day, an Israeli aircraft launched one airstrike at one of the apartments at Ni'maa Tower in Al-Rimal neighborhood in the middle of Gaza City. One child, Abudul Rahman Majdi Na'im, 5 years, was killed, and two members of the same family were injured as a result of the strike.

At approximately 8:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched one airstrike at one person who is a member of the resistance movement, Abdul Rahman 'Ayish, 32, at Al-Sheikh Radwan, north of Gaza City.

At approximately 2:00 am on the same day, medical sources at Ash-Shifa Hospital in Gaza City announced that Mohammed Mohammed Baker, 27, died as a result of injuries he sustained on 20 November 2012 in a strike which hit the Doghmosh family in Al-Sabra neighborhood, east of Gaza City.

3. Deir Al-Balah (Middle Gaza District)

3.1. Wednesday 14 November 2012

At approximately 5:45 pm on 14 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts launched one missile targeting an open field in An-Nuseirat refugee camp, in the middle of the Gaza Strip. The airstrike caused partial damage to an UNRWA school, An-Nuseirat secondary school for girls. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:15 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting an open field east of An-Nuseirat camp in the middle of the Gaza Strip. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:10 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting an uninhabited house west of An-Nuseirat refugee camp in the middle of the Gaza Strip. Mahmoud Abu Sawaween, 61, was killed in the airstrike, as he was passing-by the area near the house. Five other residents of the area were injured, including one woman, Jakleen Al-Hanajra, 23. Medical sources at Deir Al-Balah hospital described their injuries as moderate. Many houses were partially damaged in the attack.

At approximately 8:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting an open field, west of An-Nuseirat, in the middle of Gaza City. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:45 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting a site belonging to Al-Qassam Brigades in Deir Al-Balah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting an open field, west of An-Nuseirat refugee camp, in the middle of the Gaza Strip. Several civilian houses were damaged partially in the attack, but no injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:10 pm on the same day, the Israeli navy fired several missiles targeting residential areas, west of Az-Zawayda, in the middle of Gaza City. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:05 pm, on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, east of Al-Bureij refugee camp, in the middle of Gaza City. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched an airstrike targeting an open field, west of An-Nuseirat camp, in the middle of Gaza City. Auda Abu Mhadi, 47, was injured in the attack and admitted at Shuhada' Al-Aqsa Hospital. Medical sources described his injury as moderate. Several houses were partially damaged in the attack.

At approximately 11:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes targeting an open field east of Al-Bureij camp, in the middle of Gaza city. Sabah Mohammed Al-Qreenawi, 42, who had given birth 24 hours earlier, was injured in the attack; in addition to her child, Abeer Abdullah Al-Qreenawi, 16 was injured. Medical sources described their injuries as moderate. Several houses were damaged in the attack.

At approximately 11:15 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike targeting an open field on Salahddin street, northeast of An-Nuseirat refugee camp in the middle of Gaza City. No injuries were reported.

3.2. Thursday 15 November 2012

At approximately 12:35 am on Thursday 15 November, Israeli artillery positioned near the Israeli Kisosfim military base fired several shells at a playground in the village of Al-Salqa valley. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 12:55 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at a site belonging to the Al-Quds Brigades, located in the northeast of An-Nuseirat refugee camp. One child, Ra'fat Ibrhim Abu Shawish, 16, was injured in the attack.

At approximately 3:40 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field, southeast of Al-Bureij refugee camp.

At approximately 7:30 pm on the same day, Israeli navy shelled the Palestinian navy headquarters south of Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 7:40 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts shelled a two-room building located on a piece of land in the Al-Sawarha neighbourhood, south of Al-Nuseirat. The two rooms were completely destroyed; in addition, the neighbouring An-Nuseirat Secondary School for Girl Refugees (C) sustained partial damage. Ali Abdul Aziz Al-Haj, 60, sustained several bruises in the attack.

At approximately 8:35 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field in Al-Maghazi refugee camp.

At approximately 8:40 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike against a militant site, west of Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 8:50 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field belonging to the Bashir family in Al-Hekr area, south of Deir Al-Balah. One child, Lama Hassan Al-Louh, 2, was injured in the attack, and numerous houses were partially damaged.

At approximately 9:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts bombed an open field located to the southeast of the Al-Saqqa valley.

At approximately 9:05 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts bombed Abu Rashid Valley, south of Al-Maghazi refugee camp.

At approximately 10:55 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts bombed a piece of land, east of Al-Bureij camp.

At approximately 11 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts bombarded a training site belonging to a Palestinian armed faction in the east of Deir Al-Balah town in the Middle Gaza district.

At approximately 11:00 pm, on Thursday 15 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts targeted a site belonging to Palestinian fighters, east of Deir Al-Balah.

3.3. Friday 16 November 2012

At approximately 1:35 am on Friday 16 November, Israeli aircrafts targeted a piece of land located in An-Nuseirat refugee camp which resulted in one injury: Hind Abu Mhadi, 20, was injured while she was inside her home.

At approximately 2:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a piece of land, north east of Maqboola area in Al-Burej.

At approximately 4:00 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Al-Bureij camp.

At approximately 5:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts bombed an open field in the village of Al-Mughraga.

At approximately 5:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a site belonging to Al-Qassam Brigades, on Salahuddin road, east of Al-Mughraga.

At approximately 5:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Al-Bureij camp.

At approximately 5:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted Abu Rashid Valley, south of Al-Mghazi.

At approximately 5:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 6:00 am, on Friday, 16 November 2012, Israeli warships fired several shells which hit a building belong to the Ministry of Agriculture located near the Naval site in Deir Al-Balah. It also caused damage to the Fishermen's Syndicate.

At approximately 1:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted the Naval Police Force site, west of Al-Nuseirat, near the bridge on the coastal road.

At approximately 2:15 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a Naval Police Force site on the Deir Al-Balah beach.

At approximately, 2:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted agricultural field, near the power station, northeast of An-Nuseirat refugee camp.

At approximately 2:20 pm on the same day, Israel aircrafts targeted agricultural lands, near Abu Rashid Valley, south of Al-Maghazi refugee camp.

At approximately 2:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted agricultural lands in Abu Mhadi area, west of Al-Nuseirat.

At approximately 4:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes at an open field in Al-Bureij camp, near Abdul Aziz Al-Rantisi mosque.

At approximately 5:10 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts air raided an agricultural land belonging to Ali Al-Mosaddar.

At approximately 5:10 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Deir Al-Balah, in Al-Aklook area. One woman, Maha Abu Seif, 25, was injured as a result of the attack.

At approximately, 5:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Al-Bureij refugee camp, behind Abu Hujayyir gas station.

At approximately 5:20 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Al-Sawahra area, south of Nuseirat.

At approximately, 7:15 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted the east of Al-Bureij refugee camp.

At approximately 8:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a group of young people who were in an open field, east of Al-Maghazi refugee camp which resulted in four deaths and one injury. The dead persons are: Ahmad Mohammed Abu Jalal, 43, Amjad Mohammed Abu Jalal, 33, Ziyad Farjan Abu Jalal, 23, Hassan Alhmeila', 27. They were taken to Shuhada Al-Aqsa Hospital.

At approximately 9:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted Khalid Khalil Al-Shaer, 25, who was driving a motorcycle near Al-Maghazi refugee camp, nort east of Deir Al-Balah town, which resulted in his death and two other injuries.

At approximately 9:35 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Deir Al-Balah City.

3.4. Saturday 17 November 2012

At approximately, 1:47 am on Saturday 17 November Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field, west of Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 1:47 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field, west of Al-Nuseirat.

At approximately 1:50 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted the northeast of An-Nuseirat refugee camp.

At approximately, 2:28 am on the same day, Israel aircraft targeted an open field, west of An-Nuseirat refugee camp.

At approximately 2:35 am on the same day, Israeli aircrafts bombed Al-Rahman mosque, at Al-Bureij refugee camp. The Israeli jet dropped a bomb on a house belonging to Sha'ban Mohammed Al-Ashqar, 57, which is next to the mosque. Israeli aircrafts then bombed the mosque, destroying it completely and partially damaging several houses next to it. A soap factory belonging to Farhan Awwad Abu Midyan, 58, in addition to two schools were also partially damaged. 11 people were wounded as a result of the attack, including one paramedic.

At approximately 3:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field in Deir Al-Balah, near the Salahaddin Street. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:00 pm on the same day Israeli aircrafts targeted an open field near the Gaza Valley. One woman, Nima Al-Sawarka, 40, was wounded in the attack.

At approximately 5:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched three airstrikes targeting two houses belonging to Hassan Hammad, 46, and Jamal Rabah, 52. Another shell targeted an open field, in As-Salam neighbourhood in Deir Al-Balah. Israeli aircrafts then targeted Hammad's house a second time, razing it to the ground. One woman, Mirvat Rabah, 52, was injured, along with a child, Khalid El-Buheisi, 16 years. El-Buheisi's injury was described as serious. Many houses were damaged as a result of the strikes.

At approximately 8:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a group of young people in Al-Maghazi who were all killed in the strike. Their names are: Ali Al-Mana'ma, 24, Usama Abdul Jawwad, 27, and Ashraf Darwish, 22.

At approximately 11:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted an uninhabited house, east of Al-Bureij refugee camp. The house was entirely destroyed in the attack, and several neighbouring houses were partially damaged.

3.5. Sunday 18 November 2012

At approximately 7:50 pm on Sunday 18 November 2012, Israeli aircrafts targeted a group of people near the Village of Al-Saqqa Valley. One person, Ali Hassan Bin Said, 25, was killed and three others were injured in the attack.

At approximately 8:00 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a group of young people at the village of Gaza Valley. One person, Mohammed Sabri Al-Uwidat, 31, was killed, and two others were injured as a result of the attack.

At approximately, 8:30 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a group of people near a family Diwan (Extended Family Council) which belongs to Ahmed Salem Bin Said, 60. Hani Abdul Majid Bari'm, 31, and 6 others were injured, the injuries of two of them were described as critical.

At approximately 8:50 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts launched one airstrike at an open field in Deir Al-Balah. Four people were injured as a result of the attack.

At approximately 10:40 pm on the same day, Israeli aircrafts targeted a young man in Abu Ereif area in Deir Al-Balah. The targeted person, Tamer Khalid El-Humri, 26, was immediately killed in the attack.

3.6. Monday 19 November 2012

At approximately 1:25 am Monday 19 November 2012 am Israeli aircrafts bombed an open field in Al-Barak neighbourhood, south of Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 2:45 am on the same day Israeli warships positioned opposite An-Nuseirat Beach fired several artillery shells at the Palestinian Navy site. The shelling continued until 5:00am in the morning.

At approximately 3:00 am on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched airstrikes at an open field, east of Al-Bureij camp.

At approximately 4:45 am on the same day Israeli aircrafts launched airstrikes at a training site belonging to Al-Qassam Brigades, north of An-Nuseirat camp.

At approximately 8:00 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck Abo-Rsheed valley in Al-Maghazi refugee camp.

At approximately 8:15 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck Mohamed Abu Khosa's house northeast Al-Burayj refugee camp; the house is located 700 meters far from the eastern borders. As a result, one-year-and-half year old Eyad Abu Khosa was killed and his brother Sohayb, 6, was critically injured. The attack also resulted in the injury of Sara Abu Khosa, 5.

At approximately 8:30 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck blacksmith workshop in An-Nusairat refugee camp

At approximately 8:35 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field northeast Al-Burayj refugee camp

At approximately 10:40 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field in Abu Zekri neighbourhood

At approximately 10:40 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field in Deir Al-Balah

At approximately 10:46 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field in Abu Zekri neighbourhood west of Al-Nusairat

At approximately 10:50 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field in Abu Mohade neighbourhood west of Al-Nusairat

At approximately 11:20 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field in Abu Mohade neighbourhood west of Al-Nusairat

At approximately 12:30 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field in Deir Al-Balah

At approximately 13:10 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field east of Deir Al-Balah

At approximately 2:10 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts targeted an assembly of civilians in Al-Burayj refugee camp. As a result, 4 civilians were injured, among them 2 children.

At approximately 3:40 pm on the same day Israeli warplanes fired several airstrikes at the Hijji family land in Al-Maghazi refugee camp. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:50 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes shelled in Al-Mughraqa village. As a result, one person, Amin Ramadan Al-Milahi, 24, was killed.

At approximately, 4:05 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes fired airstrikes at an open field in Al-Mughraqa village.

At approximately 4:40 pmon the same day, Israeli warplanes fired airstrikes at an open field in the middle of Al-Nusseirat refugee camp. As a result, one person, Mohammed Zidan Tobeil, 25, was killed while his mother, Zarifa Mahmoud Tobeil, 57, was injured. Partial damage was caused to the house too.

At approximately 6:20 pm on the same day , Israeli warplanes targeted two young persons, Ibrahim Mahmoud Al-Hawajiri, 25; and Arkan Harbi Abu Kmeil, 24. As a result they were immediately killed in the attack.

At approximately 6:50 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched three air raids at a house belonging to Izziddin Hamdan, 63, destroying it completely. A neighboring house belonging to Nihad Sulaiman Al-Nabaheen, 33, was also destroyed.

At approximately 9:00 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched airstrikes at an open field in the north of Al-Bureij camp.

At approximately 7:40 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted a group of people in the middle of Al-Nusseirat refugee camp. As a result, one child, Osama Walid Shuhada, 17, and another person, Khalil Ibrahim Shuhada, 55, were killed in the attack. Four others were injured including one woman, Wasfiyya Mohammed Shuhada, 54.

At approximately 10:20 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes shelled targeting an open field at the Gaza Valley village.

3.7. Tuesday 20 November 2012

At approximately 12:10 am on Tuesday 20 November 2012, Israeli warships fired several missiles at the western side of An-Nusseirat refugee camp.

At approximately 2:00 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at an open field near Ein Jalout buildings in An-Nusseirat refugee camp.

At approximately 3:35 am on thw same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at the Eastern Graveyard in Al-Bureij refugee camp.

At approximately 4:00 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at an open field west of An-Nusseirat.

At approximately 4:05 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at an open field, northwest of An-Nusseirat.

At approximately 7:30 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched several airstrikes at an open field near Shuhada' Al-Aqsa Hospital in Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 7:40 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at an open field east of As-Salqa valley.

At approximately 8:00 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at an open field, south of Deir Al-Balah near Al-Matahin.

At approximately 8:10 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at the Al-Rayyis family land near Al-Shuhada roundabout, south of An-Nuseirat.

At approximately 9:00 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike targeting one person, Rizq Sulaiman Az-Zahhar, 30, as a result of which he was immediately killed while his son, Ahmed, 2 years, was injured in the attack.

At approximately 9:50 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched three airstrikes at an orchard belong to the Abu Meddin family in Al-Maghazi area.

At approximately 10:00 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at Abu 'Iyyada area, northwest of Al-Bureij refugee camp. One injury was reported.

At approximately 10:20 am on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike near Al-Shuhada square, the Al-Rayyis family land, north of An-Nusseirat.

At approximately 12:00 pm on the same day, Israel warplanes launched an airstrike targeting a house belonging to Ghazi Abu Tama'a, in As-Salam neighborhood in Deir Al-Balah. A roof-knocking missile was fired at the building first. One injury was reported.

At approximately 12:00 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at a group of people near Palestine Technical College. As a result, one person, Mohammed Abed Rabbo Bader, 24, was killed, and another was injurd.

At approximately 1:00 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes shelled an open field, south of Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 1:09 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes an open field near the Abu Jibba petroleum station in the Gaza Valley village. One injury was reported.

At approximately 1:15 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted an open field, east of Al-Bureij refugee camp.

At approximately 1:17 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted a land belonging to Abu Mizyed family in Al-Maghazi area.

At approximately 1:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted an agricultural land belonging to the Abu Kabreet family, south of Al-Maghazi refugee camp.

At approximately 2:05 pm on the same day, Israeli artillery fired missiles at several areas in the Gaza Valley village, east of Gaza Valley.

At 2:37 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at an open field in Al-Maghazi refugee camp.

At approximately 2:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched several airstrikes at the the Quwaider family field in An-Nuseirat refugee camp.

At approximately, 6:15 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted the Abu Mezyid family field in Al-Maghazi area.

At approximately 6:44 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike on Al-Birka Street, near Al-Bukhari mosque in Deir Al-Balah. As a result, two persons, Mohammed Mousa Abu Eisha, 24, and Hassan Yousef Al-Ostaz, 22, were killed. Abu Eisha used to work as a program manager at Al-Quds Educational Channel.

At approximately 6:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike at a field belonging to the Abu 'Iyada family in Al-Bureij refugee camp.

At approximately 6:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted an open field located behind Al-Awda factory in Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 6:45 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted an open field located behind Ar-Rahman mosque in Al-Bureij refugee camp.

At approximately 7:00 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted a house belonging to Mohammed Ibrahim Abu Qasmiyya, 66, nar Al-Banna Bakery in Deir Al-Balah.

At approximately 7:00 pm on the same day, Israeli artillery fired several shells at houses neighboring to Hamza mosque, north of Gaza Valley village. Several houses were partially damaged.

At approximately 7:15 pm on the same day, Israeli artillery shelled the western area of An-Nuseirat refugee continuously for two hours.

At approximately 8:00 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched an airstrike targeting two persons walking down a street at Abu Sitta neighborhood, in Az-Zawayda village. As a result, two persons, Salem 'Ayish Abu Sitta, 22, and Mohammed Ahmed Abu Sitta, 21, were killed.

At approximately 8:10 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched several airstrikes targeting evacuated settlement of Nizarim.

At approximately 8:30 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched several airstrikes targeting Al-Mufti field in Al-Nuseirat refugee camp.

At approximately 8:30 pm on the same day, Israeli artillery fired several shells towards Gaza Valley village.

At approximately 8:50 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted a house belonging to Mu'awiya Sufian Sa'ad, 36, in Al-Nuseirat after it had warned him.

At approximately 11:15 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes launched several airstrikes at Abu Midyan field in Al-Maghazi area.

At approximately 11:15 pm on the same day, Israeli warplanes targeted the Abu Mhadi family field in Al-Nuseira refugee camp.

3.8. Wednesday 21 November 2012

At approximately 1:00 am on Wednesday 21 November 2012, IOF warplanes struck the bridge connecting between Al-Mghraqa village and An- Nusairat refugee camp. The attack resulted in the bridge demolition.

At approximately 5:55 am on the same day, IOF warplanes struck the coastal bridge which is connecting the Middle district with Gaza district, in the northwest of Al- An- Nusairat refugee camp. The attack resulted in the bridge demolition.

At approximately 6:00 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into a house belongs to Al-Hadede family west of Al- Al- Nusairat refugee camp. The attack resulted in the house demolition.

At approximately 6:30 am on the same day, IOF warplanes struck house belongs to Mohammed Al-Shaf'e, 37, in Al-Burayj refugee camp. The attack resulted in the house demolition.

At approximately 8:20 am on the same day, IOF warplanes struck Akrm Abu Khaled's house in Al- Az-Zawayda village. The attack resulted in the house demolition.

At approximately 10:52 am on the same day, IOF warplanes struck house of Issam Al-Da'lees nearby Abu Sorar round-about in An-Nusairat refugee camp. The Israeli warplanes at approximately 11:20 attacked again the house leading to its complete demolition, Issam, 45, is a personal consultant to Ismail Haniya the Gaza prime minister.

At approximately 2:15 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes struck an olive field west of Abu Jaber neighborhood in An-Nausairat refugee camp. The attack resulted in killing Mobark Abu Ghola,24.

At approximately 2:15 pm on the same day, IOF artillery batteries shelled the south area of Gaza valley village.

At approximately 4:20 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile nearby An-Nausairat cemetery, the attack resulted in killing a young child Rehham An-Nbaheen,3, and to an injury of her mother Smah A,-Nbaheen,35.

At approximately 4:40 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes struck house belongs to the Abu Kmail family nearby Al-Eman mosque in Al-Moghraqa village. The attack resulted in killing of 5 civilians and injury of a six civilians. The killed persons are: Rami Obeed,30; Mohamed Abu Etawe,36; Sa'ade Abu Kmail,26; Nidal Hassan,32; and Maher Abu Kmail,23.

At approximately 7:30 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes struck an assembly of civilians, the attack resulted in killing Mohammed Abu Maghseeb;15 and injury of Mohamed Arada;27.

At approximately 20:30 on the same day, IOF warplanes struck a house belongs to the Mbrook family in An-Nausairat refugee camp, 5 civilians were injured as a result.

4. Khan Younis District

At approximately 5:35 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an open field in Al-Fokhary neighbourhood in the southeast of Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:15 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles at a number of greenhouses in the west of Khan Younis. As a result, the greenhouses were destroyed.

At approximately 8:00 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles at a training site belonging to the Al-Qassam Brigades. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:40 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field in Al-Seka neighbourhood, No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:50 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles into an open field in Abu-Riyadh neighbourhood, east of Khuza'a area. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 12:25 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles into an open field in Al-Qrara area in the west of Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 12:10 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field in Al-Qrara area in the northeast of Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 13:15 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched a missile at a number of greenhouses in the south of Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 14:50 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck an agricultural field in the east of Khan Younis. As a result, Ahmed Abu 'Iliyan, 11, and Suliman Abu I'liyan, 61, were critically injured.

At approximately 18:20 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles into an open field in the north east of Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 21:03 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launch at least one missile at an open field in the centre of Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 23:10 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field northeast Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 23:55 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts struck agriculture fields in Abbssan Al-Kabera town, east of Khan Younis. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:28 pm, IOF aircrafts struck a shop belongs to Anwr AbuMettleq east of Khan Younis. As a result, the shop was burnt and extremely damaged.

At approximately 6:45 pm, an IOF aircraft fired a missile into an open field east of Khan Younis. One injury was reported.

At approximately 7:45 pm, an IOF aircraft fired one missile into an open field in Ab'asan Al-Kbeera east of Khan Younis. One injury was reported.

At approximately 7:50 pm, IOF aircrafts struck an open field nearby European Gaza hospital. No casualties or injuries were reported but patients and people in the area were terrified. .

At approximately 8:00 pm, IOF drone fired one missile into Mohammed Berm's one-story house in Romyda area in Bani Suheila town east of Khan Younis. 10 minutes later, IOF aircraft fired one missile into the house leading to its complete destruction.

At approximately 9:53 pm, IOF drones fired one missile into Salah Slama's one-story house in Al-Amal neighbourhood in Khan Younis. Slaah is known as a leader in the Al-Qssam Brigade. On the same day at approximately 9:45 pm, IOF F16 aircrafts fired one missile into the house leading to its complete destruction, neighbouring houses sustained damages and two passersby were lightly injured.

As a result, the station was completely demolished, adjacent houses and the building hosting Khan Younis municipality sustained partial damages and six civilians among them two children were injured.

At approximately 12:45 pm on the same day, IOF drones fired one missile targeting an assembly of civilians in Abu Tair neighborhood in Abasan al-kabera in the east of Khan Younis. As a result, Ibraheem Abu Naser, 80, and his granddaughter Ameera,15, were killed, a third civilian Mohammed Ibraheem Abu Naser was injured. According to Al Mezan documentation and monitoring, the family was targeted while they were harvesting olives in their farm in Abasan al-kabera.

At approximately 1:25 pm on the same day, IOF artillery batteries fired with dozens of shillings agriculture fields west of Al-Qrara and in Az-Zanah area northeast Bani-Suheila town, east of Khan Younis. The shelling lasted sporadically till 4:00 pm. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:25 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into an open field in west of the western line, northwest of Khan Younis. No casualties or injures were reported.

At approximately 8:10 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes struck an open field in Abasan al-kabera in the east of Khan Younis. No casualties or injures were reported.

At approximately 8:55 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired two missiles into an apartment in the 4th floor of a residential building owned by Salm Shorab in Shorb neighborhood in Khan Younis. The air assault resulted in the almost complete destruction of the apartment, the opposite apartment sustained partial damages.

5. Rafah District

On 14 November at approximately 8:10 pm, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field in Al-Shoka neighbourhood, east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:20 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles into an open field in An-Nassser neighbourhood north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:30 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles into an open field in An-Nassser neighbourhood north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:00 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field west of Rafah. as a result, Lubna Qatroos, 5, and Eman Abu Sha'er, 28, were injured.

At approximately 10:30 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles at the building hosting the Internal Security Apparatus north of Rafah. The attack resulted in damages to the nearby health center of UNRWA, no casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 11:00 pm on the same day, IOF, stationed in watchtowers inside the eastern separation fence, opened fire surrounding Gaza airport east of Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 11:15 pm on the same day, IOF, positioned inside the eastern separation fence, shelled the neighbouring Gaza airport, east of Rafah. No injuries were reported.

5.2. Thursday 15 November 2012

At approximately 7:00 am on Thursday 15 November 2012, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field in Al-Tenour neighbourhood. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:20 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched two missiles into an open field nearby Dar Al-Fadeela in the Taha Hussein Street in Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:00 am on the same day, IOF artillery batteries, stationed in the eastern border fence, shelled the adjacent area to Gaza airport southeast of Al-Shoka village in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:00 am on the same day, IOF artillery batteries, stationed in the eastern separation fence, shelled the area near Sofa crossing northeast Al-Shoka village in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:05 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:15 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:30 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts launched one missile into an open field west of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:00 pm on the same day, IOF artillery batteries shelled the area nearby Sofa crossing northeast of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:15 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field nearby the health centre which belongs to UNRWA, north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:00 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired three missiles at the square of Rafah crossing. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:00 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired three missiles into the square of Rafah crossing. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:20 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired three missiles into an open field east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:30 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field nearby Dar Al-Fadeela in the Taha Hussein street in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:38 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field belongs to Irmilat family in Al-Jneena neighbourhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 5:45 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field in Abu Halawa area in Al-Shoka village. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:50 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:05 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:35 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field nearby Dar Al-Fdeela in the Taha Hussein street in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:35 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:10 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired three missiles into an open field in As-Salam neighbourhood south of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:12 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired 3 missiles an open field nearby Al-Aqad neighbourhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:13 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired three missiles into an open field nearby Hozyfa mosque in western Rafah. Five persons from Fojer family were injured, among them three children and one woman.

At approximately 9:24 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into Zu'rub hill, south of western Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:28 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field in Al-Hashash neighbourhood northwest Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:36 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field in Al-Hashash neighbourhood northwest Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

5.3. Friday 16 November 2012

At approximately 00:10 am on Friday 16 November 2012, IOF aircrafts fired one missile at an open field located at the back of the Directorate of Education in the north west of Al-Shabora neighbourhood in Rafah. As a result , Mohammed Abu Matar, 18 was moderately injured.

At approximately 00:45 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field near Rafah Crossing. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 00:45 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field in Nasr village in the north east of Al-Shabora neighbourhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 1:00 am on the same day, IOF drones fired two missiles into Mohamed Abu Shammalla's house in the Imam Ali Street in western Rafah. There was no-one in the house at the time. The attack damaged the house, but no injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:00 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field near Gaza airport in the south east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:10 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field in Al-Mosabeh neighbourhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:05 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles into an open field near Ibn Taymiya mosque in Al-Mosabeh neighbourhood. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:19 am on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired three missiles into an open field in Nasr village in the north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:25 am on the same day, IOF drones fired one missile into an open field near Hozyfa mosque in western Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:10 am on the same day, IOF fired artillery shells at the neighbouring area of Gaza airport, southeast of Al-Shoka village in Rafah. As a result, Hatem Abu Moor, 25 was moderately injured.

At approximately 2:15 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired 3 missiles into an open field in Nasr village. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:25 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into Abu Jibreel site, an Al-Qssam Brigades training site, east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:25 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field in Nasr village, north of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:30 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field of Al-Shoka village, east of Rafah crossing. As a result, Emad Nasr, 11 was moderately injured.

At approximately 2:30 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into a tunnel east of the Imam Ali mosque south of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:20 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired 3 missiles into Mohammed Abu Shmmala's house in the Imam Ali Street in western Rafah, the house was empty. The attack resulted in 6 injuries among them a child.

At approximately 3:41 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into Mohammed Abu Shammallah's house in The Imam Ali street in western Rafah. The attack destroyed the house.

At approximately 4:20 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles at the Abu Jibreel site, an Al-Qassam Brigades training site, east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:20 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into an open field nearby Khalil Al-Rahman mosque, northeast Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:05 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field north of Awny Dheer Street in Al-Jneena neighbourhood. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:05 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field in As-Salamneighbourhood south of Rafah. As a result, two persons were moderately injured among them a child.

At approximately 6:11 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into the area nearby the tunnels between the Palestinian-Egyptian borders. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:55 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field nearby Al-Mo'mneen mosque in Al-Jneeh neighbourhood. No casualties or injuries were reported.

5.4. Saturday 17 November 2012

At approximately 8:20 pm on Saturday 17 November 2012, IOF drones fired one missile at a car that has been driven in a bystreet of Abu Bakr street in Al-Shabora neighbourhood, the missile mistaken its target that resulted in injury of 3 civilians among them a child.

At approximately 9:05 pm on the same day, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field nearby Al-Mo'mneen mosque in Al-Jneeh neighbourhood. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:10 am, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into Jameel Nahal's one-story house in Adas area. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:10 am - 4:30 am, Israeli aircrafts fired 25 missiles targeting a number of different areas on the border fence in the south of Rafah. As a result, three persons were moderately injured.

At approximately 5:15 am, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into Mas'oud Al-Qadi's two-story house in Syamat area, northwest of Al-Shabora neighbourhood in Rafah. As a result, the house was completely destroyed.

At approximately 8:35 am, IOF drones fired one missile at a group of persons in Badr refugee camp north of Tel Al-Sultan neighbourhood west of Rafah. As a result, Mokhlis Odwan, 36 was killed and two others were injured including a child.

At approximately 9:05 am, IOF drones fired two missiles, targeting a group of civilians in Al-Zohoor neighbourhood in the north of Rafah. As a result, four civilians were killed: Ahmed Al-Atrash, 36, Mohammed Al-Lolahi, 24, Abdul-Rahman Al-Masri, 23 and Awad Al-Nahal; 25. One was moderately injured: Ismail Al-Nahal; 25.

At approximately 10:00 am, the IOF fired one missile into an open field in As-Salamneighbourhood in the south of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 11:20 am, IOF drones fired one missile at a motorcycle situated near Al-Farooq mosque in Al-Shabora neighbourhood in Rafah. The missile missed its target and injured 7 civilians including two children and one woman.

At approximately 11:20 am, IOF aircrafts fired two missiles into a chicken farm in Al-Hashash neighbourhood in the northwest of Rafah. The air assault resulted in the injury of 3 civilians: Mos'ab Doheer, 31, Mahmoud Shobeer, 40 and Ismail Zo'rob, 42; the air assault also damaged the nearby houses.

At approximately 16:20 pm, IOF drones fired one missile at a motorcycle that was being driven nearby the George Street in the east of Rafah. As a result, Osama Al-Qadi, 26 was killed and two others were moderately injured.

At approximately 20:10 pm, IOF drones fired one missile at a motorcycle situated by the Nasr neighbourhood crossroads. The attack critically injured Hassan Abu Sunjur, 18, and Mohammed Jouda, 26.

At approximately 21:23 pm, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field near Deir Yassin secondary school in Al-Jneena neighbourhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported

At approximately 21:30 pm, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field in Al-Hashash neighbourhood in the north west of Rafah. The attack resulted in 6 injuries among them 4 children.

At approximately 21:45 pm, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into Atiya Abu-Nkeera's two-story house in Al-Shabora neighbourhood in Rafah; Atiya is known to be a member in the Al-Qassam Brigades. The attack resulted in the injury of six civilians, including 2 children and a woman. The targeted house and another five nearby houses were totally destroyed. The house had been attacked by 4 drone missiles before it was destroyed, which is known as 'roof-knocking attack'.

5.5. Sunday 18 November 2012

At approximately 00:40 am on Sunday 18 November 2012, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into a training site of the Al-Qassam Brigades in the north west of Tel Al-Sultan neighbourhood. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:30 am, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field in Mosabeh neighbourhood in the north of Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:50 am, IOF aircrafts fired one missile at a training site belonging to the Popular Resistant Committees, located in the west of in Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:30 am, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into the two-story house of Deeb Abu-Nkeera; manager of charity social association in Al Shabora neighbourhood in Rafah. As a result, one elderly man was killed. The house was attacked two times by missiles fired by drones before it was totally destroyed. A carpentry workshop below the house was destroyed as well.

At approximately 6:55 am, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field near Omar Ibn Al-Khatib mosque in the Ads area in Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:38 am, IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles at the tunnels in the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:58 am IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles at the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:43 am, IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles into an open field in the east of Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:45 am, IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles into an open field in Al-Mawasi neighbourhood in the west of Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:00 am, IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles at the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:15 am, IOF aircrafts fired one missile into an open field nearby Omar Ibn Al-Khatib in Ads neighbourhood. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 10:25 am, IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles at the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 23:05 pm, IOF aircrafts fired one missile at the house of Mahmoud Al-Hashash in the northwest of Rafah. The IOF hit the house without any advanced alert. Mahmoud is a teacher. The attack injured three civilians including a child and several women. Their names are: Sabha Al-Hashash, 55, Zyad Al-Hashash 35, and Arwa Al-Hashash, 10. Sabha and her son Zyad were critically injured.

At approximately 23:10 pm IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles at the tunnels in the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 23:15 pm, IOF aircrafts fired 4 missiles into an open field near Al-Rebat mosque east of Rafah. No injuries were reported.

At approximately 23:05 pm, IOF drones fired one missile at a silver car (Hyundai Verna) in Ommar Bn-Alkhatib Street in Az-Zohor neighbourhood. As a result, Saif Sadek, 27, and Hossam Al-Zene, 30 were killed; and Mahmoud Shath, 21 was injured.

5.6. Monday 19 November 2012

At approximately 12:05 am on 19 November 2012, IOF warplanes fired one missile into an open field east of Tal Al-Sultan neighborhood in Rafah. As a result, Rajab Abu Ouda; 25 sustained moderate injuries.

At approximately 1:00 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into an open field in Immam Ali Street nearby Civil Defense department north of Tal Al-Sultan neighborhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:25 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired 4 missiles into an open field Immam Ali Street nearby Civil Defense department north of Tal Al-Sultan neighborhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:25 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into the naval police site located in the old fishermen port on Rafah coast. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:50 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile targeting the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian borders. No casualties or injuries were reported.

From approximately 6:55 am to 7:25 am on the same day, IOF f16 warplanes fired 27 missiles targeting the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian borders. During the air assaults, Nisam Abu Mohsen; 27, was moderately injured

At approximately 11:25 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into an open field in Nasr village in the north east of Al-Shabora neighborhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 1:25 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired 3 missiles targeting the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:30 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired two missiles targeting the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9 pm on the same day, IOF drones fired one missile into a house belongs to Ramze Al-Ra'ae in Bdr refugee camp in Tal Al-Sultan neighborhood in Rafah. As a result, Maha Al-Samhori; 47, was moderately injured and the house sustained serious damages.

At approximately 10 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into a tin-sheet house belongs to Twfeeq Al-Mnasra in Atatra area in Nasr village in the north east of Al-Shabora neighborhood in Rafah. The air assault resulted in the complete destruction of the house, the civil defense crews pulled 2 bodies from under debris, the first is for Ahmed Al-Mnasra;17, and the second body is for his brother Mohamed;19. 8 other civilians sustained moderate injuries: Twfeeq Al-Mnasra;50, Twfeeq's wife Amana Al-Mnasra;44, his mother Zainb Al-Mnasra;75, his sister Mariam Al-Mnasra;40, her son Skhr;12, and he daughters Sma;2, Fatma;8, Fedaa;10 and Zainb;15.

5.7. Tuesday 20 November 2012

At approximately 1:00 am on 20 November 2012, IOF warplanes fired one missile into two-story house belongs to Ahmed Al-Attar in Ybna refugee camp in Rafah, Ahmed is a leader at Al-Qssam brigades the military wing of Hamas. The air assault resulted in the complete destruction of the house, adjacent houses sustained partial damages. IOF drones had fired three missiles on Al-Attar house and two adjacent houses belong to Yousif Al-Bna and Awdallah Ka'dan, According to an affidavit from Awdallah Ka'dan, he received a phone call from an Israeli Intelligent officer telling him that he has one minute before his house being attacked, Awadallah left the house immediately with his family. No casualties or injuries were reported

At approximately 9:30 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into an open field in Al-Mwase area west of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into an open field east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:45 pm on the same day, IOF artillery batteries shelled the neighboring houses of Gaza airport. An elderly woman Sabha Abu Sneema, 75, sustained moderate injuries as a result.

At approximately 2:45 pm on the same day, IOF artillery batteries shelled the neighboring houses of Gaza airport in Al-Shoka village and the surrounding of Sofa crossing. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 4:15 pm on the same day, IOF drones fired one missile targeting a motorcycle ridden by Shawqe Abu Snema, 28, in Al-Shoka village in Rafah. As a result, he sustained critical injuries and his leg was amputated and splinters hit all of his body parts.

At approximately 9:15 pm on the same day, IOF gunboats, stationed on Rafah cost, shelled Palestinian houses in Al-Mawase neighborhood west of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 9:10 till 9:45 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes launched 8 missiles targeting the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 11:00 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired two missiles an open field at the back of Bahloul petroleum station in Ash-Shoka village east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 11:35 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile targeting the border line with Egypt nearby As-Salam neighborhood south of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

5.8. Wednesday 21 November 2012

At approximately 1:45 am on Wednesday 21 November 2012, IOF artillery batteries, positioned in the eastern separation fence, shelled the Palestinians houses nearby Al-Shoka village east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 1:50 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into Al-Krama compound east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 1:55 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into Al-Krama compound east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 2:35 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into Al-Krama compound east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 3:00 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into Abu Ataya training site which belongs to Poular Resistance Committees. No casualties or injuries were reported

At approximately 3:50 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile targeting the border line with Egypt in Al-Brazil neighborhood. No casualties or injuries were reported

At approximately 5:15 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile into the tunnels at the Palestinian-Egyptian border. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:20 am till 8:20 am on the same day, IOF warplanes fired 20 missiles targeting the tunnels at the Egyptian-Palestinian border. Iman Abd Al-Aal;women,38, was moderately injured.

At approximately 8:40 am till 9:20 am, IOF warplanes fired 20 missiles targeting the tunnels at the Egyptian-Palestinian border. . No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 6:30 pm on the same day, IOF drones fired one missile targeting house of Mohamed Abi Edwan;18 and Abd Allah Ibraheeml18 while they were walking nearby Al-Shoka health centre in Al-Matar street south of Al-Shoka village east of Rafah. As a result , both of them were killed.

At approximately 7:15pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired two missiles into an Tal-Zo'rb east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

In approximately 7:30 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired two missiles into the previous Israeli settlements east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 7:45 pm on the same day, IOF warplaned fired three missiles into a training site northwest of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:10 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired one missile targeting an assembly of civilians in Tbt-Alzra'a east of Rafah. 3 civilians sustained moderate injures as a result.

At approximately 8:25 pm on the same day , IOF artillery batteries ,stationed in the eastern separation fence, shelled the Palestinian houses in Al-Shoka village, east of Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:35 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired three missiles targeting the Palestinian-Egyptian border nearby As-Salamneighborhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:45 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired three missiles targeting the Palestinian-Egyptian border nearby As-Salamneighborhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

At approximately 8:50 pm on the same day, IOF warplanes fired three missiles targeting the Palestinian-Egyptian border nearby As-Salam neighborhood in Rafah. No casualties or injuries were reported.

Concluding Comments

The IOF attacks listed above indicate that the IOF continues to disregard basic principles of international law. Israeli attacks continue to target civilians and civilian objects, in a serious violation of international humanitarian law. Artillery attacks during this short period of hostilities directly targeted houses, as illustrated, among dozens of other cases, by the attacks on the houses of the Al-Mashharawi family, the

Arafat family and the Abu Shbak family. Direct attacks also took place with precision big bombs when families were in their house, such as the attack on the Ad-Dalu family.⁵

Notably, the IOF returned to using the extremely lethal ‘roof-knocking’ attacks; especially during the last four days of the reporting period. These attacks involve firing ‘warning’ missiles that pierce a roof of a house, or a group of houses, to prompt their residents to evacuate them. The main bombardment of the house follows with 3 to 10 minutes. In most of these attacks, civilians were killed and injured from the initial missiles. In many, civilians were also killed and/or wounded as they could not evacuate quickly enough. This type of attacks constitutes a serious violation of the prohibition on directing armed attacks on both civilians and civilian property during hostilities. It is not permissible to use warning methods such as missiles.

Al Mezan strongly condemns the Israeli attacks on the Gaza Strip. Al Mezan called for international community’s swift intervention to end the hostilities and, if not possible immediately, to ensure that civilians and protected and international law is fully respected. Al Mezan expressed its deep concern by the initial statements made by the Secretariat of United States, the European Union, and several European countries, which stressed Israel’s right to self-defence, but failed to assert the context of belligerent occupation, closure, continued IOF attacks on Gazan civilians, but also the obligation to respect international law under all circumstances.

In light of the serious violations of human rights and international law during this round of hostilities, Al Mezan highlights the urgency of investigating all the violations of international law and bringing the violators to justice. Al Mezan calls for the full implementation of the recommendations of the report UN Fact Finding Mission of 2009, which was drafted in the aftermath of Operation Cast Lead (2008/9), Failing to investigate and punish these violations will only lay the ground for similar, if not graver, violations in the future, which could lead to a serious threat to international peace and security.

International community is called on to exert pressure on Israel; the occupying Power, to bring its illegal closure of the Gaza Strip to an immediate end. Collective punishment of Gaza’s population is both illegal, immoral, and a continuous cause of violence. Gaza is part of the occupied Palestinian territory and must be opened to the rest of the territory in the West Bank.

Al Mezan also calls on international community to initiate a meaningful process to bring the conflict to an end. Building on previous experience, peace will not possibly be achieved if such a process is not fully in line with the rules of international law.
