I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**Profile of the Incident**

- Due to heavy rains, a landslide incident occurred at about 2:30 AM, 22 April 2011 in a small scale mining area at Panganason-B, Brgy. Kingking, Pantukan, Compostela Valley Province, resulting to the entrapment of several miners and damaging numerous houses

- **Eight (8) houses totally damaged (buried due to landslide)**

II. ACTION/S TAKEN:

- Injured victims were brought to Pantukan Emergency Hospital (5 persons) and Davao Medical Center, Tagum City (2 persons) for medical treatment and attention
 - **As reported earlier, the four (4) additional miners rescued safely already returned home due to barely minor bruises sustained**
 - Search, rescue and retrieval operations are still being conducted by 71st Infantry Battalion, MDRRMC Pantukan and Brgy. Kingking responders, and police personnel assigned in the area
 - **Incident Command Post has already been established at the Municipal Hall of Pantukan, headed by Lt. Col. Camilo Ligayo of 71st Infantry Battalion, together with LGU, PNP and Philippine Army**
 - **DRRO Troops mobilized:**
 - **1 Bulldozer c/o Russel Mining**
 - **1 Bulldozer, 1 Dumptruck and 1 backhoe from LGU**
 - **1 SAR Helicopter from 505th SAR, PAF**
 - **K9 Trackers**
 - **2 UH-1H from TOG 11, PAF, Davao**
 - **Press conference was held at 10:00 AM, 22 April 2011 participated by LCE, LGU, PPD, Provincial Representatives, AFP, and PNP**
 - DSWD XI and DOH XI already provided relief goods and medical supplies, treatment and attention to the victims and their families
