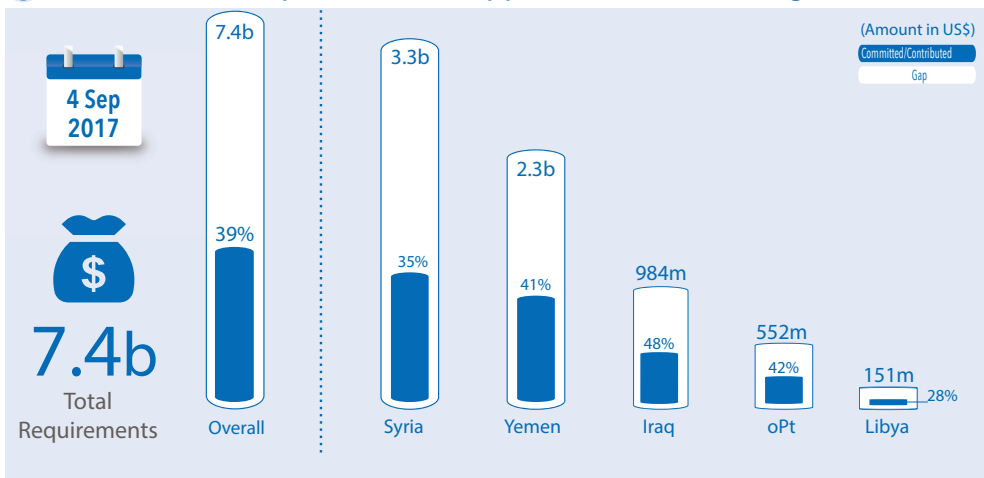


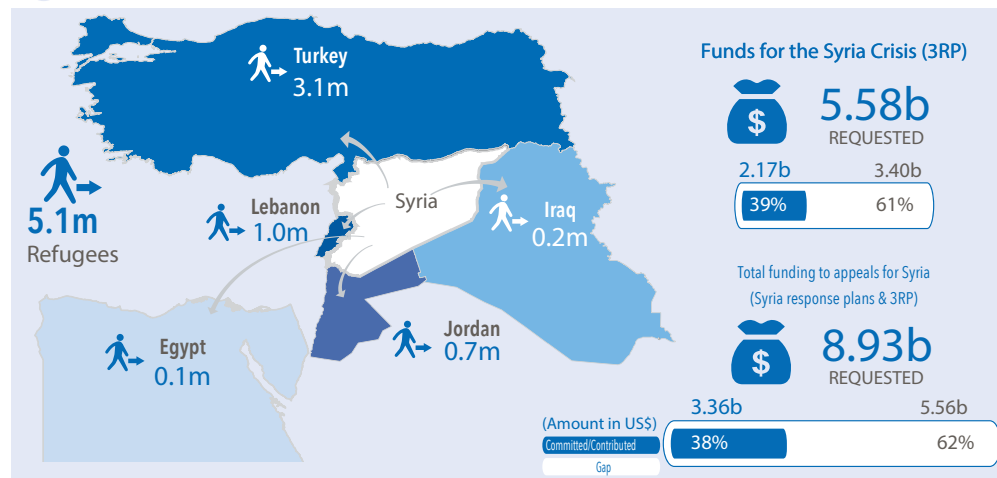
- ① In 2017, Humanitarian Response Plans (HRPs) in the MENA region requested US\$7.4 billion. The total amount received to date is \$2.9 billion (39%), which leaves a shortfall of \$4.5 billion (61%).
- ② The Syria Regional Refugee and Resilience Plan (3RP) requested US\$5.58 billion. The total amount received to date is \$2.17 billion (39%), which leaves a shortfall of \$3.40 billion (61%).

- ③ Six donor countries/entities in MENA region have contributed \$605.3 million and pledged another \$10.1 million in 2017 for humanitarian operations in 39 countries, Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF), United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UNOCHA) and World Food Programme (WFP).
- ④ The CERF has received a donation of US\$3.7 million from four countries from the MENA region; Kuwait, Qatar, Turkey and United Arab Emirates; in 2017.

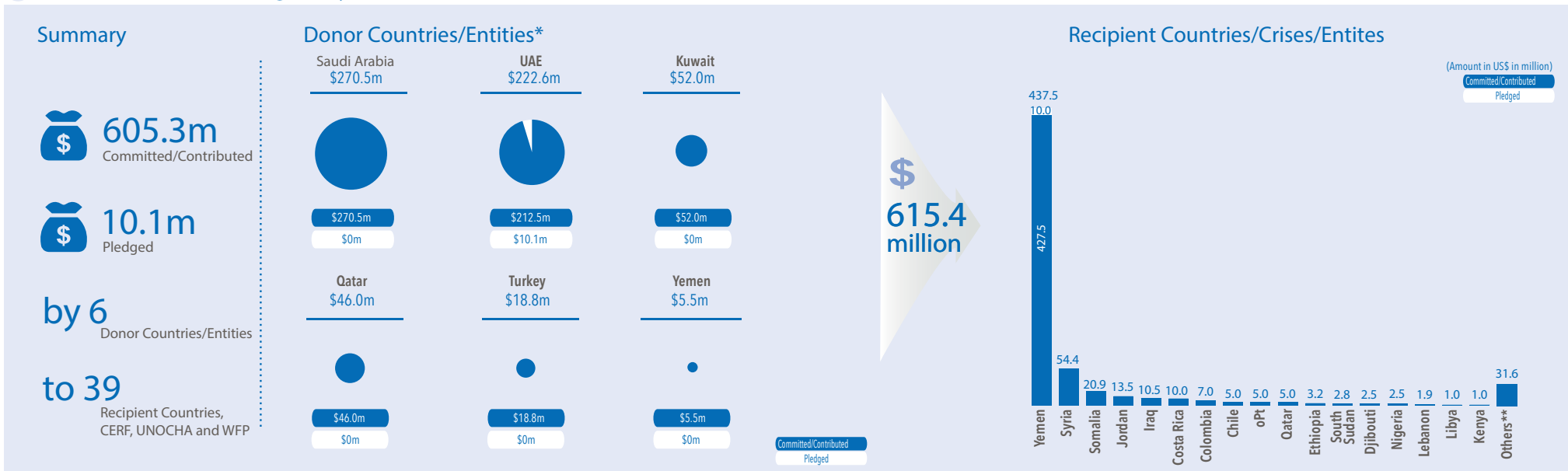
① Humanitarian Response Plans / Appeals in the MENA Region
