

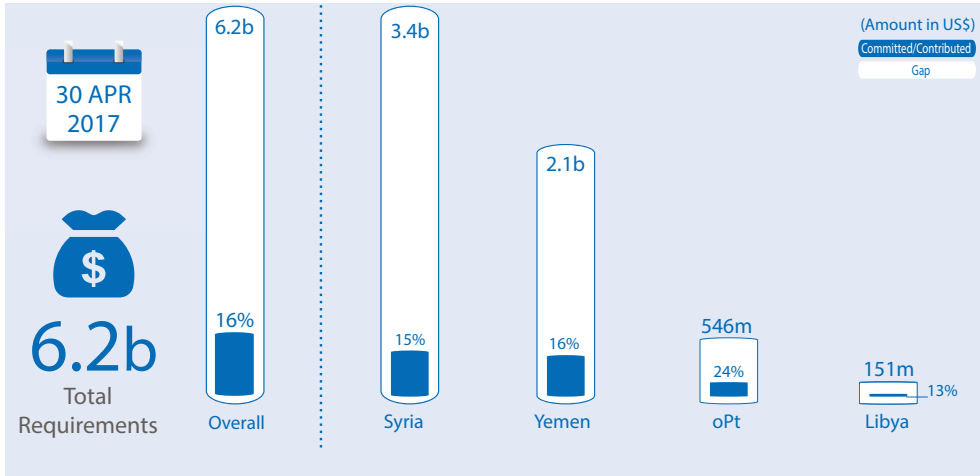
① In 2017, Humanitarian Response Plans (HRPs) in the MENA region requested US\$6.2 billion. The total amount received to date is \$1.0 billion (16%), which leaves a shortfall of \$5.2 billion (84%).

② The Syria Regional Refugee and Resilience Plan (3RP) requested US\$5.58 billion. The total amount received to date is \$1.65 billion (30%), which leaves a shortfall of \$3.92 billion (70%).

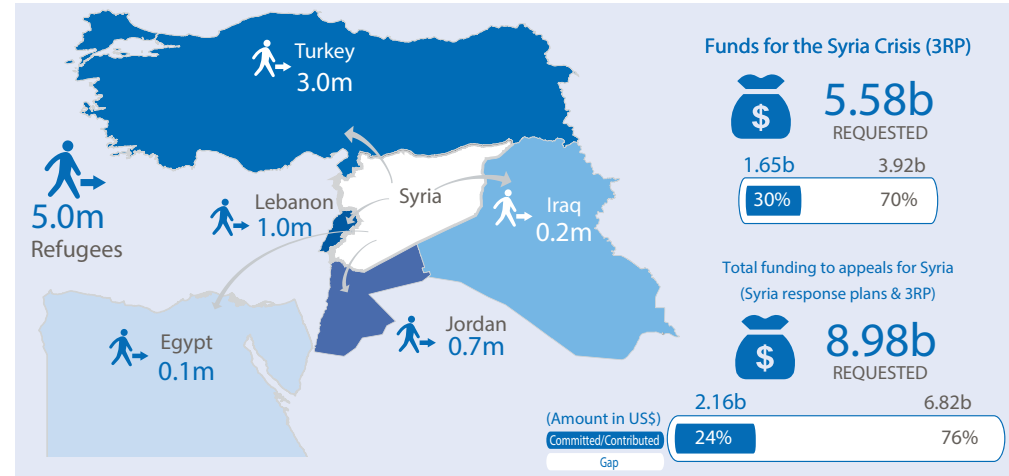
③ Six countries from the MENA region have contributed \$116.1 million in 2017 for humanitarian operations in 6 countries, Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF), United Nations Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (UNOCHA) and World Food Programme (WFP).

④ The CERF has received a donation of US\$3.7 million from four countries from the MENA region; Kuwait, Qatar, Turkey and United Arab Emirates; in 2017.
