The **Global Humanitarian Overview** published on 4 December 2018 announced funding requirements of \$21.9 billion for 21 Humanitarian Response Plans (HRP) and the Venezuela Regional Refugee and Migrant Response Plan. By the end of October 2019, requirements had reached \$26.5 billion.

As at the end of October, **148.7 million people are estimated to be in need in 58 countries**. The plans aim to collectively provide aid to 109 million people.

Funding for the requirements in the GHO reached \$14.11 billion as at end October, as compared to the \$10.65 billion reported as at end September. **The global coverage stands at 53.4%**. Seven of the response plans included in the GHO are funded above 70%: Afghanistan, Ethiopia, Iraq, Madagascar, Myanmar, Somalia and Yemen.

Total humanitarian funding reached \$20.90 billion, an increase of approximately \$4.76 billion since last month.

Launch of the Global Humanitarian Overview 2020

The **Global Humanitarian Overview 2020** will be launched at five simultaneous events on 4 December 2019 in **Geneva** (hosted by OCHA), **Berlin** (co-hosted by the German Federal Foreign Office and OCHA), **Brussels** (co-hosted by the European Commission

and OCHA), **London** (co-hosted by the Department for International Development and OCHA) and **Washington D.C.** (co-hosted by the World Bank and OCHA).

News from the pooled funds

The **Central Emergency Response Fund (CERF)** allocated \$38.5 million in October, of which \$17.0 million through the Rapid Response window and \$21.5 million through the Underfunded Emergency window. CERF has allocated more than \$492.8 million since the beginning of the year.

Ten **Country-based Pooled Funds (CBPFs)** allocated a total of \$77.0 million this month. The highest allocations are for Iraq (\$24.0 million), Syria (\$16.9 million), Sudan (\$8.0 million) and Syria cross-border (\$6.9 million). The total amount allocated in 2019 stands at \$660.0 million.

¹ In the context of response plans covered by the GHO, the figure for people to receive aid is always a subset of the figure for the number of people in need, as it is the result of collective response analysis taking into consideration humanitarian access, response capacity of partners, and responses planned/anticipated by humanitarian actors outside of the appeal.

² These 58 countries comprise the HRP countries, countries covered by the Syria 3RP, regional refugee response plans for Burundi, DRC, Nigeria, South Sudan, sixteen countries covered by the Venezuela Regional Refugee and Migrant Response Plan, as well as countries with appeals denoted as other.

³ Global humanitarian funding includes support to organisations and activities in UN-coordinated plans, as well as reported funding for the Red Cross / Red Crescent Movement, in-kind assistance, bilateral funding and others.
