



Gaza Crossing - Weekly Report

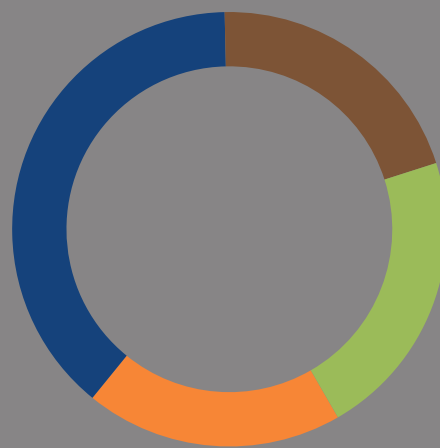
February 17th to February 23th, 2013

A total of **2,288 people** crossed through Erez Terminal

1,397 trucks carrying 42,700 tons of goods entered Gaza.

27 truckloads of goods were exported from Gaza.
