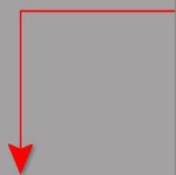
February 24th to March 2nd, 2013

A total of **1,977 people** crossed through the Erez Terminal

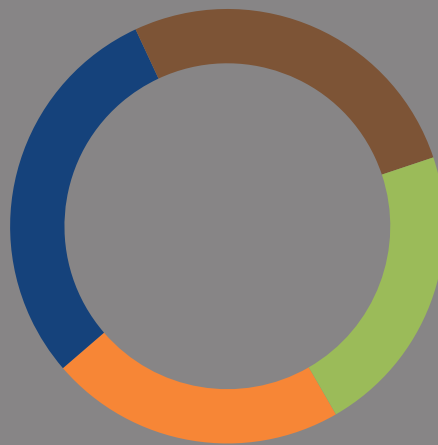
500 trucks carrying **15,244 tons** of goods entered Gaza
