

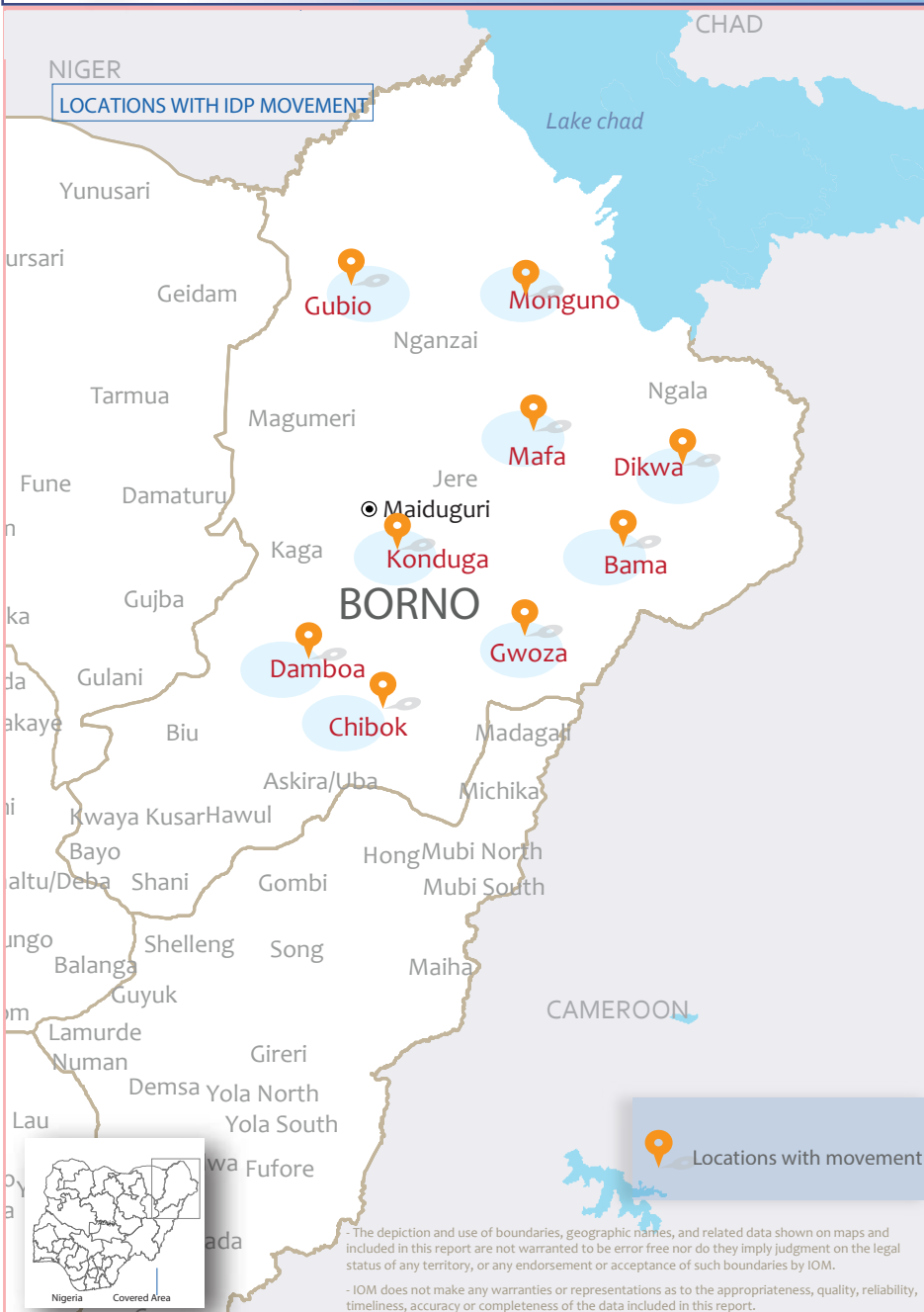


# DISPLACEMENT TRACKING MATRIX - Nigeria

<b>PULKA</b> LGA: Gwoza	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: military activity	Inflow of IDPs from neighboring villages due to ongoing military activity in nearby Ngoshi village in Gwoza LGA . Shelters are needed.	Estimate 3,000 persons
<b>BAMA Town</b> LGA: Bama	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: Newly accessible areas	A total of 67 People returned to Nigeria from cameroon on January 29 (19 IDPs) & February 2 (48 IDPs) respectively.	Estimate 67 persons
<b>MONGUNO Town</b> LGA: Monguno	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: military activity	Ongoing military offensive in Marte has opened up villages previously inaccessible causing daily influx of IDPs towards Monguno from Marte.	Estimate 8,000 persons
<b>GUBIO Town</b> LGA: Gubio	Type of movement: Anticipated returns Trigger: Newly accessible areas	The military announced last week that people could start returning to Ngetra, Kingowa, Feto, Zowo and Ardimin Wards. Returns are anticipated.	Estimate Returns are anticipated
<b>KONDUGA Town</b> LGA: Konduga	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: military activity	Galtimari area of Konduga has received about 1,200 individuals from Kawuri Village from the 27th of January till date. There has also been new arrivals at Fannamari from Kawuri 121 HH (627) INDS.	Estimate 1,827 persons
<b>DIKWA Town</b> LGA: Dikwa	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: Newly accessible areas	Temporary relocation of persons from Mallam Maja, Fufiye and Boboshe Wards to Dikwa town as those wards have become accessible and currently going through military clean up.	Estimate 2,000 persons
<b>MAFA Town</b> LGA: Mafa	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: Newly accessible areas	An estimated 800 IDPs returned to Mafa Town from Tamsu Ngamdua during the period of January 30 to February 10.	Estimate 800 persons
<b>CHIBOK Town</b> LGA: Chibok	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: Attack	Suspected Boko Haram attacks in Kautiwwa, Kalmari, Kamsulari and Kaya caused over 300 individuals to move to Chibok Town. The military has also advised other neighboring villages to do likewise.	Estimate 300 persons
<b>GWOZA Town</b> LGA: Gwoza	Type of movement: Arrivals Trigger: Newly accessible areas	A total of 99 persons returned from Izge village to Gwoza on February 4 (25 persons), a further 74 persons returned on February 7. The military took them to the screening point after which members of the community were asked to come and identify them.	Estimate 99 persons
