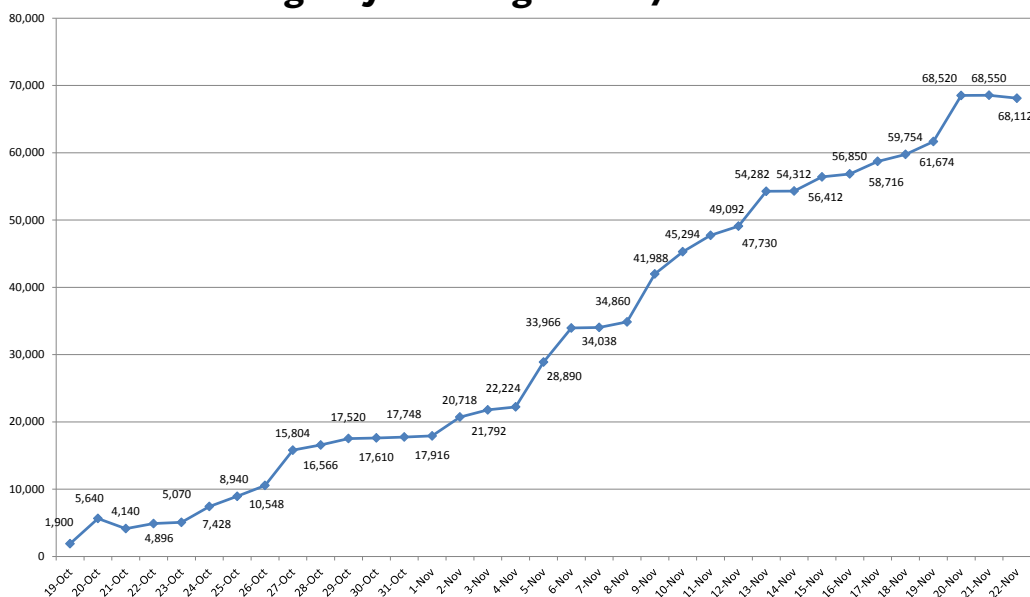


Total number of individuals currently displaced: 68,112*

Number of displaced individuals identified by Emergency Tracking since 17 October



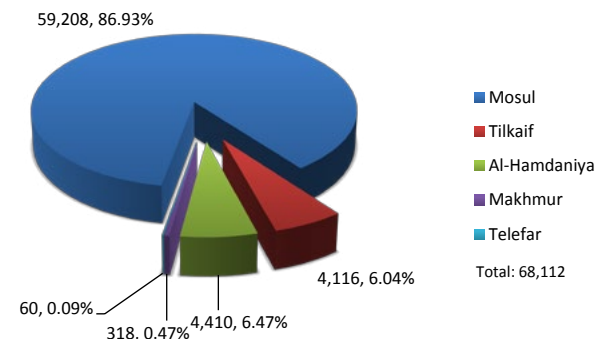
Notes from November 21:

- Approximately 350 families from Merkaz Mosul sub-district arrived to Khazer M1;
- Approximately 8 families from Muhalabiya sub-district arrived to Qayara Jadah camp;
- Qayara Jadah camp reported an overall decrease. This is due partly to further data validation, partly to return movements to Al Shura, Hamam al-Aleel and Namroud sub-districts. The precise number of returnees is still being verified;
- Further data validation allowed for a more precise break down of the IDP population in Baybokht village. The total identified IDP population is 350 families. Of these, 130 are from Merkaz Mosul sub-district while 220 families are from Baawiza (Markaz Tilkaif). The reported decrease of families from Merkaz Mosul should not be read as returns, but just as a result of further data verification.

*Emergency tracking numbers are **not** cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
