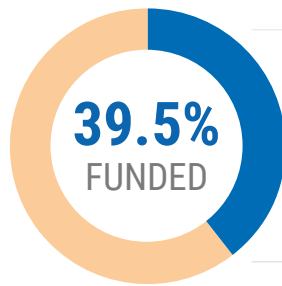

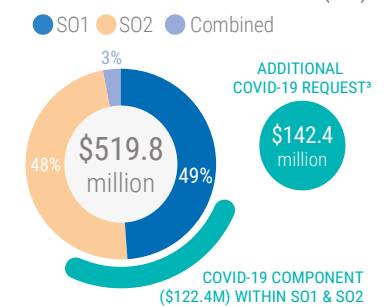

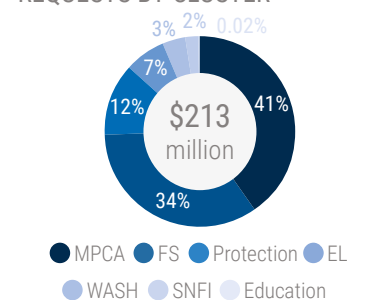

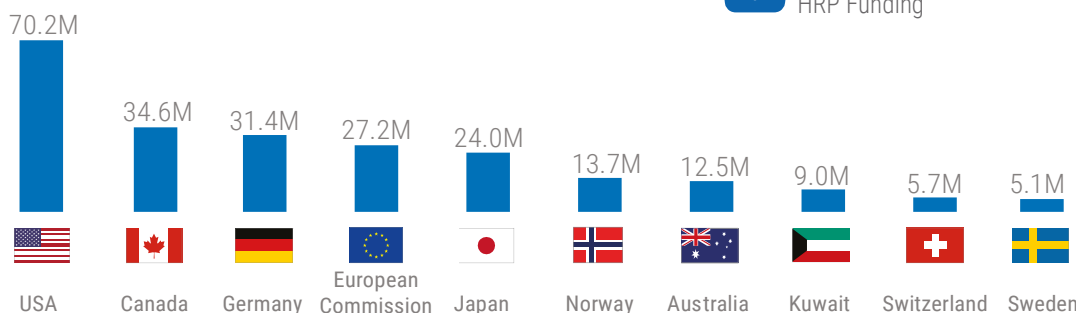

### BREAKDOWN OF CASH FUNDING REQUESTS BY CLUSTER<sup>5</sup>

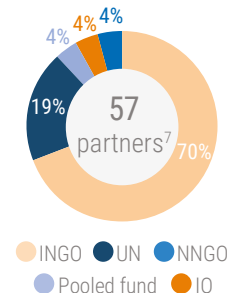


### BY DONOR (US\$) (TOP TEN DONORS)
