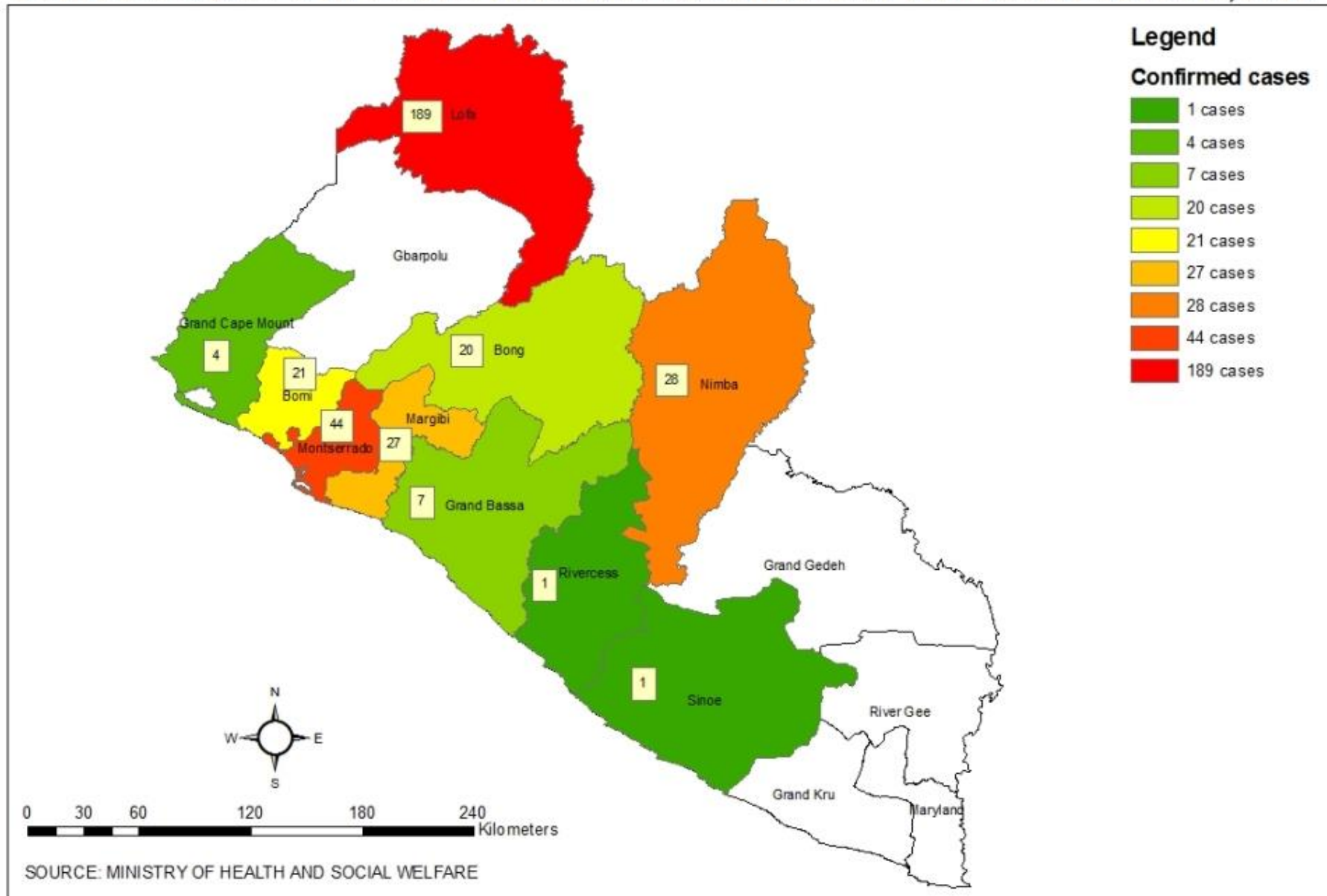

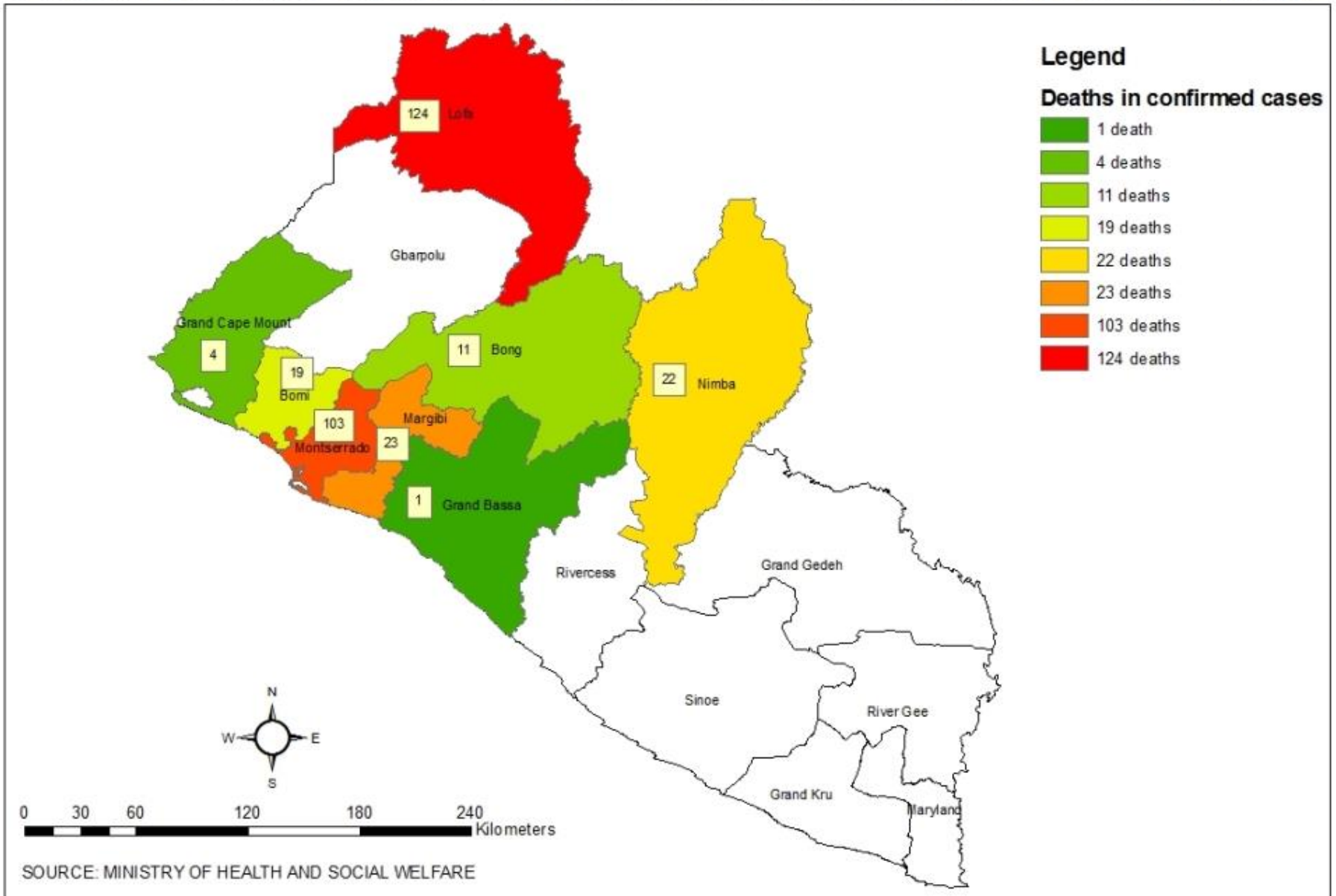

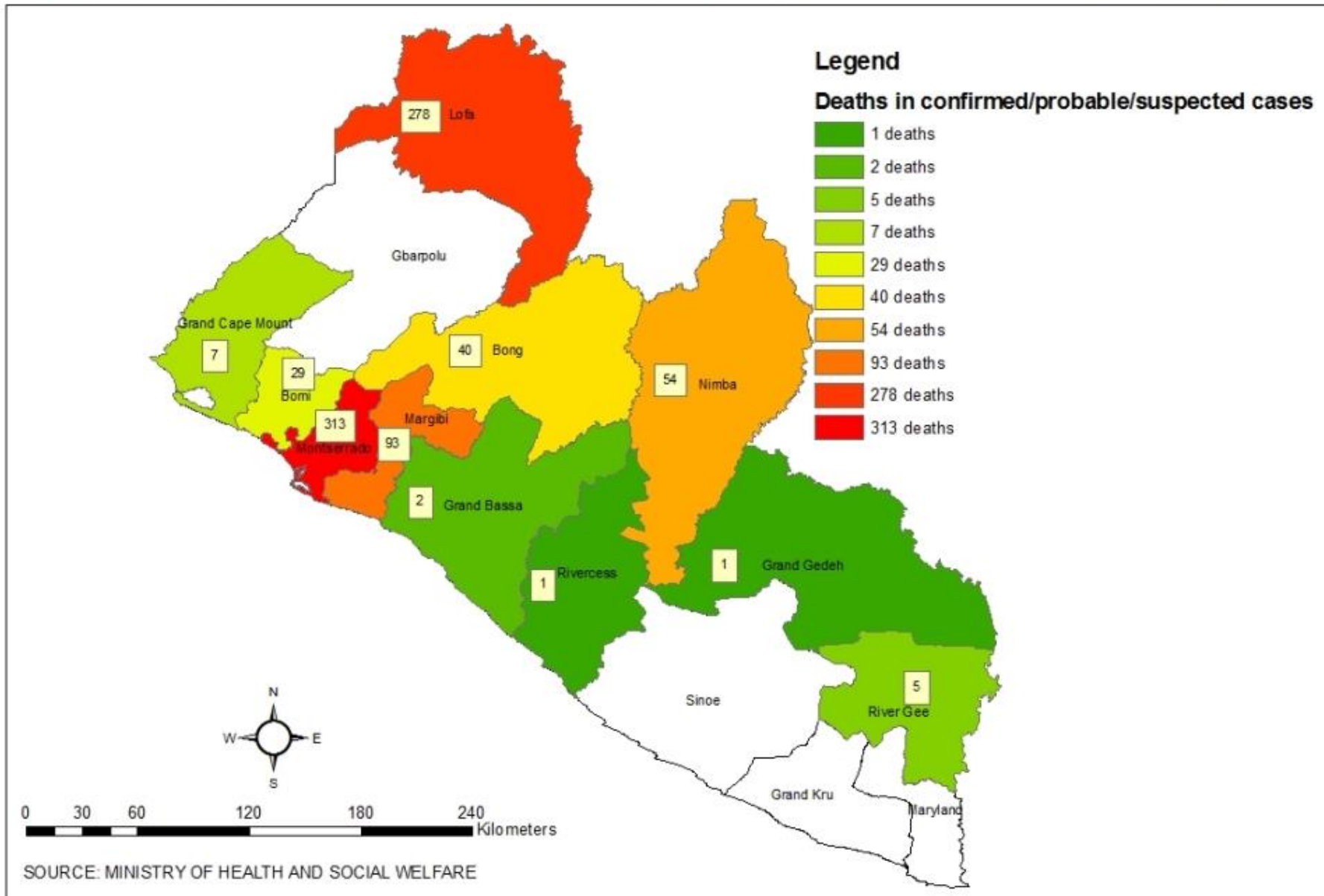
CONFIRMED CASES OF EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE SINCE MAY 29th TO AUGUST 26th, 2014



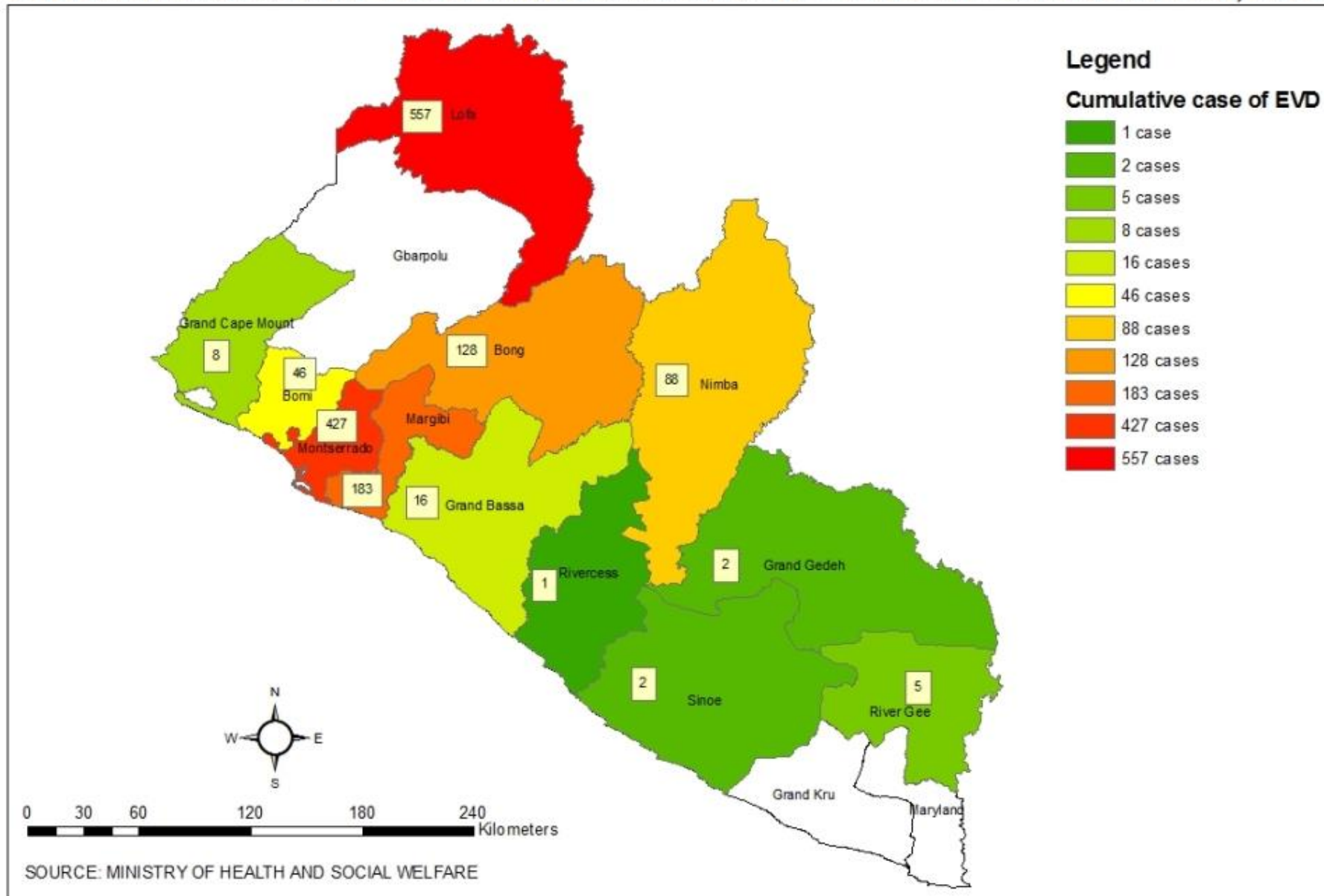
DEATHS IN CONFIRMED CASES OF EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE SINCE MAY 29th TO AUGUST 26th, 2014



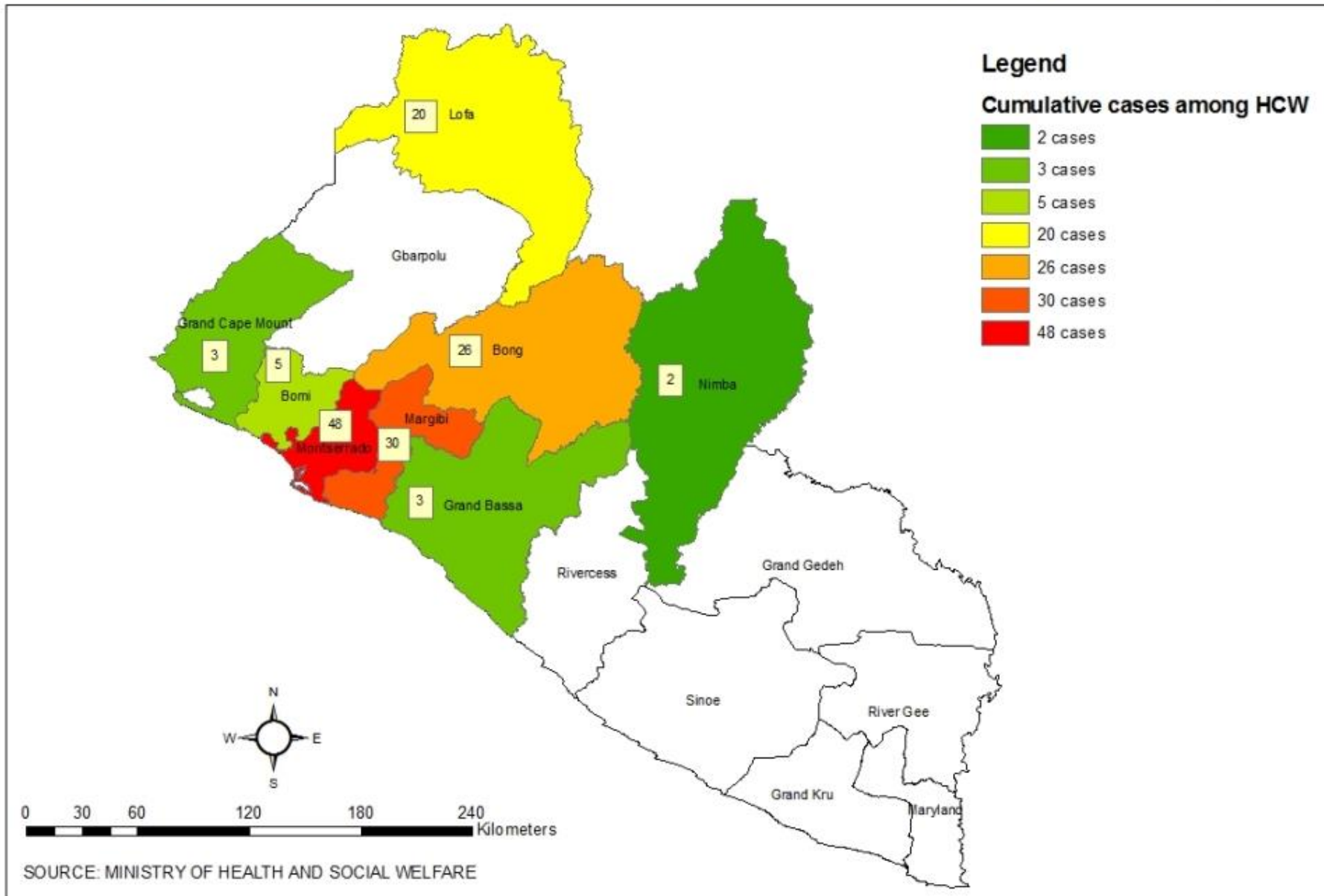

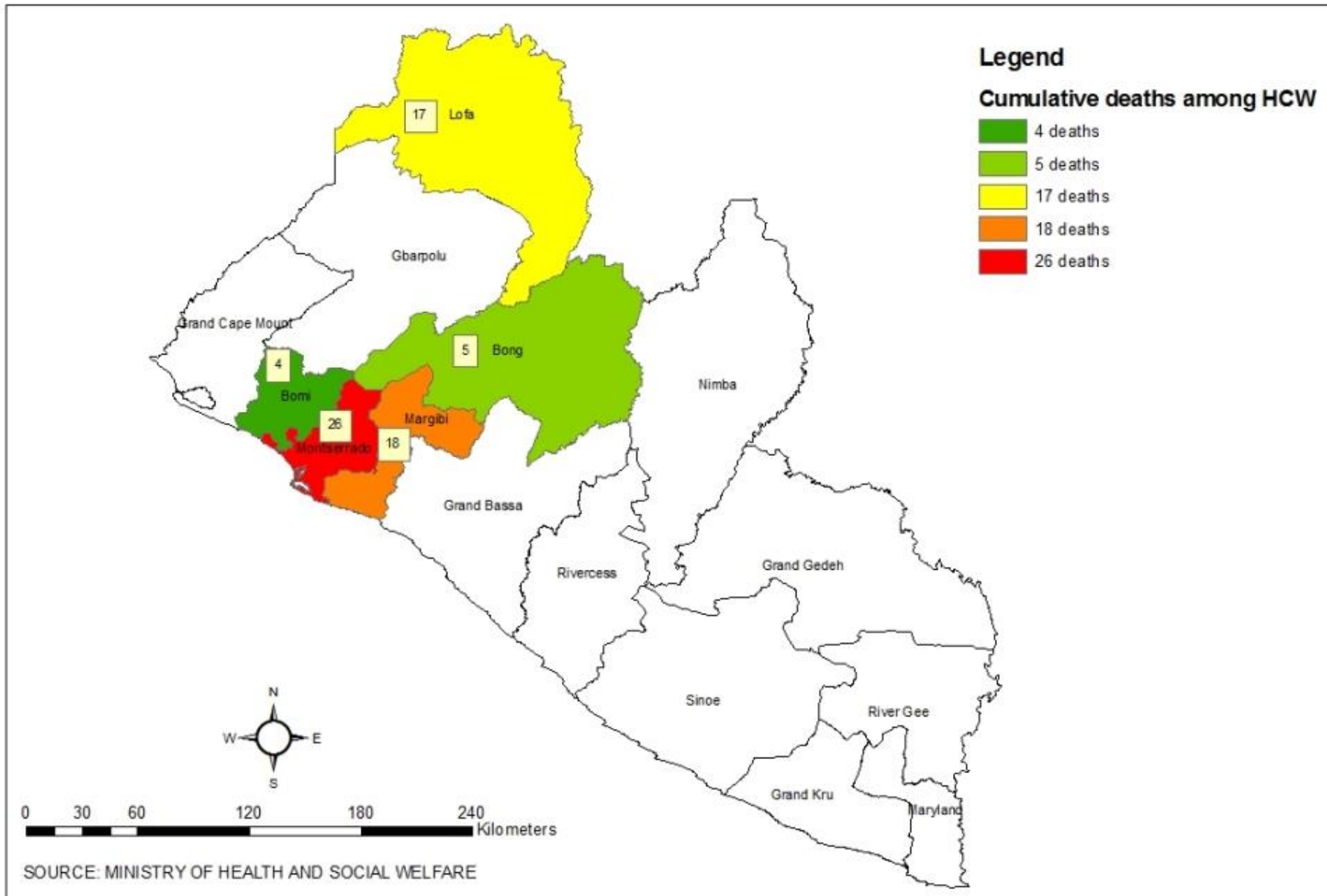
CUMULATIVE CASES OF EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE SINCE MAY 29th TO AUGUST 26th, 2014



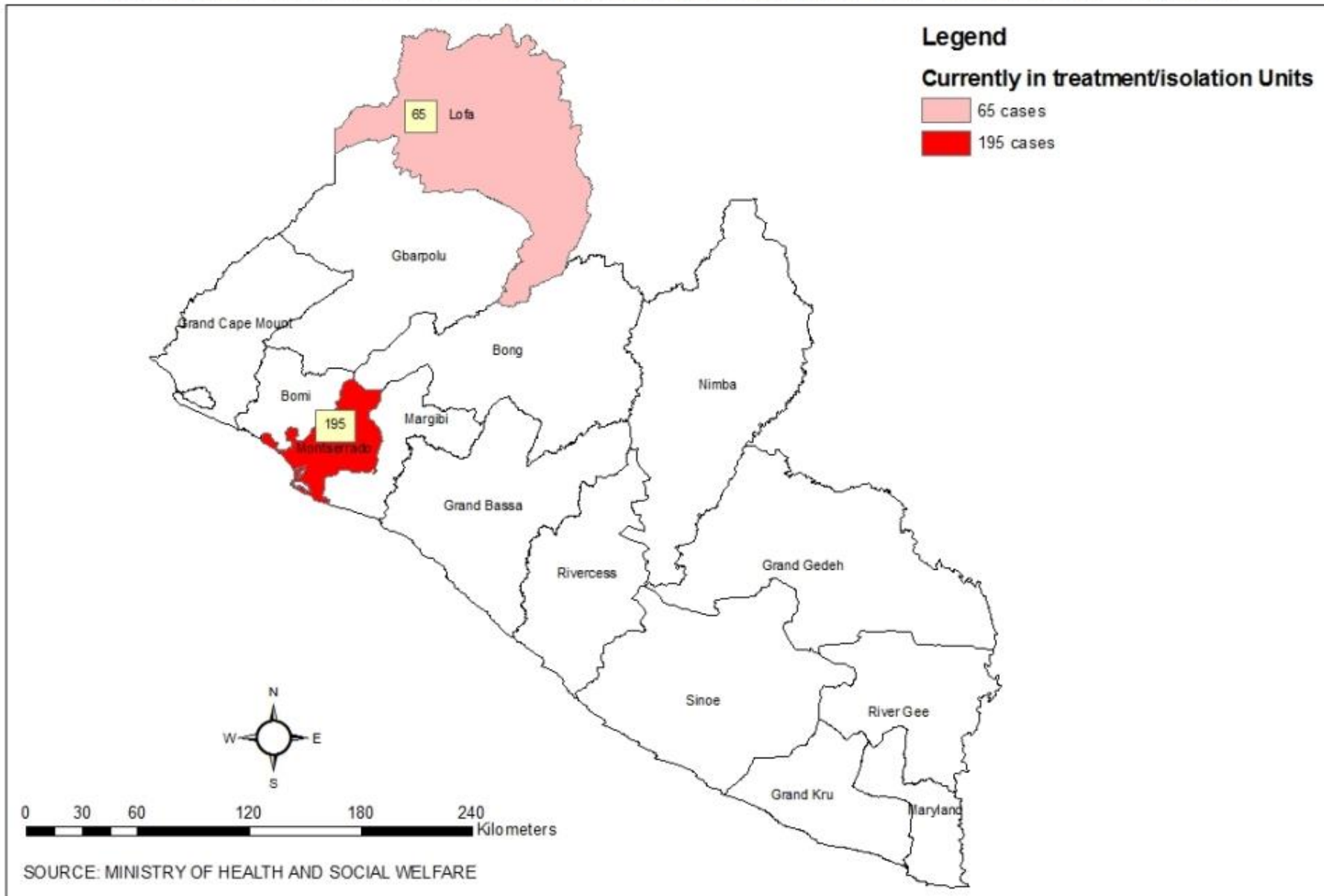

Highlight- Case Management

JFK ETU

- Center has far exceeded its capacity and can not admit any new patient for now
- Total admission as at this morning was 64 (32 males and 32 females)
- Total number of confirmed cases was 13 (from New Georgia and Gardnersville)
- Total number of new admission was 17
- No discharge
- 5 deaths reported within the last 24 hours
- There are 10 patients with negative lab results but are ill with other conditions

ELWA II

- Total admission as at this morning was 41
- Total number of confirmed cases was 18
- Total number of new admission was 2
- Total number of discharge was 6
- 1 death within the last 24 hours

Highlight- Case Management

Critical Issues:

- **JFK and ELWA III** have reached their full capacity and can not admit any new patient
- ELWA II currently has drugs and supplies for a very limited period, at most 5 days.
- There has been lack of water supply at the JFK ETU
- It has been reported that some samples are sent for laboratory investigation without the proper labeling.
- It has been observed that some patients are admitted to the ETUs without the Case Investigation Forms being filled.
- Some ill patients in the ETUs have had two consecutive negative lab results but there is no alternative treatment site to refer them

Highlight

Lofa County

- Total of 15 new probable cases (4 from Kolahun District and 11 from Voinjama District all probable and 0 probable cases from Foya)
- Total of 8 death (5 confirmed & 2 probable-FCMC, 1 community in death Vahun)
- 1 Newly reported death in Health Worker .
- Total of 4 Discharges; 2 survivors & 2 as “Not a case”

Lab Result:

- 26 results received from the lab (16 positive and 10 negatives)

Montserrado County

- 1360 contacts (78%) were seen by the four tracing teams.
- Of the 32 lost to follow-up today, 10 were all from one household. In another family, 11 contacts all ran to Rivercess.

Highlight

Nimba County

- 1 suspected Ebola case voluntarily presented himself at the G.W. Harley Hospital for management and specimen collected
- Psychosocial team is conducting support to quarantined families in Sanniquelle and its environs
- WFP food supply distribution to quarantined contacts families ongoing
- 5 EVD Laboratory result received
 - **3 Positive**
 - **2 Negative**
- Third survivor recorded since the outbreak
- 2 positive cases transferred to ETU in Monrovia

Highlight

Health Promotion

- MOHSW began a Weeklong TOT workshop for IRC for 18 “hotspots Communities in Montserrado County.
- MOHSW began a 2 day advocacy meeting with Zoes, chiefs and other opinion leaders in Bomi and Grand Cape Mount Counties.
- MOHSW along with UNICEF began training of 400 gCHVs in Montserrado County.
- Health Promotion Team conducted outreach activities in Dolo’s Town and West Point.
