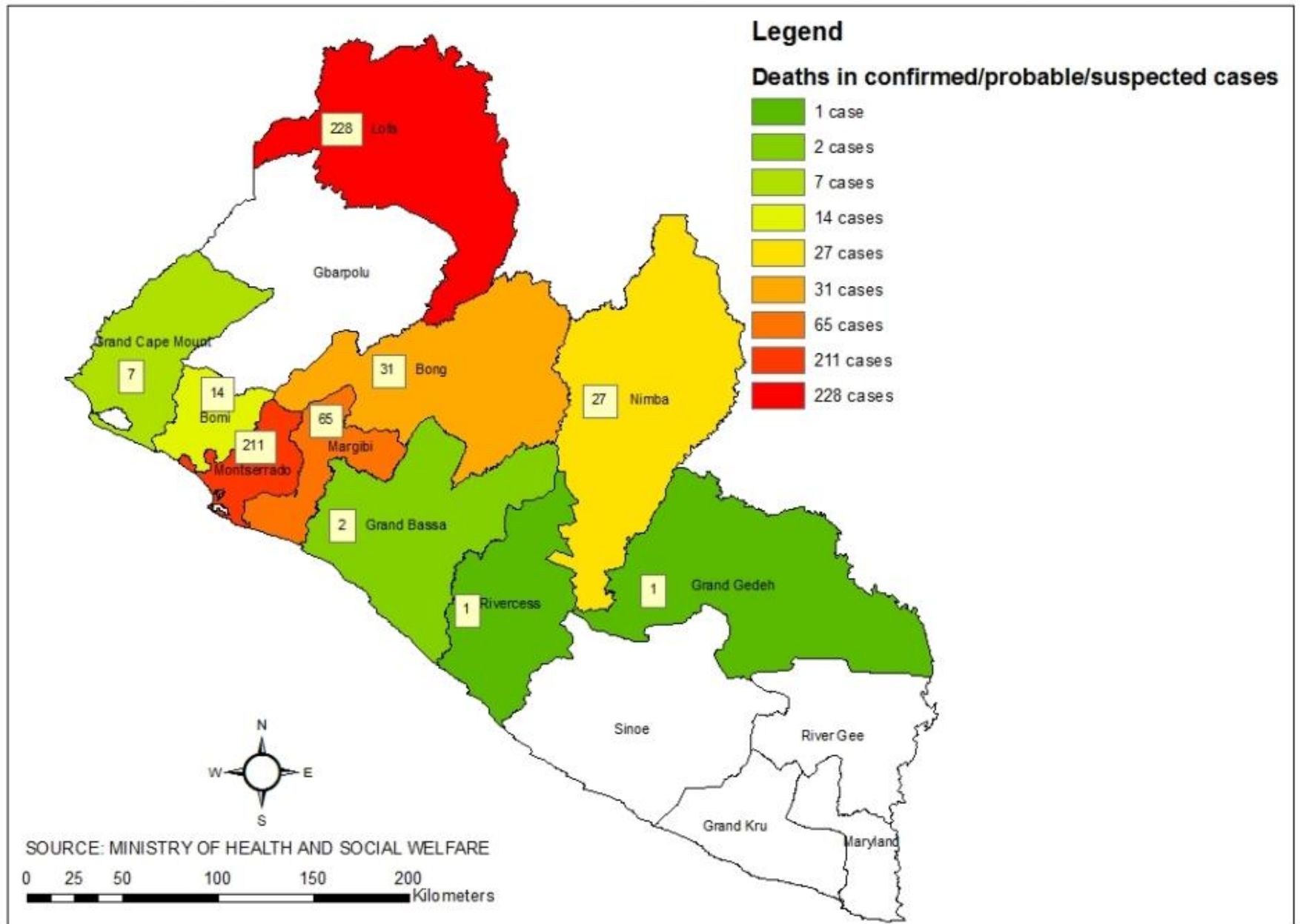

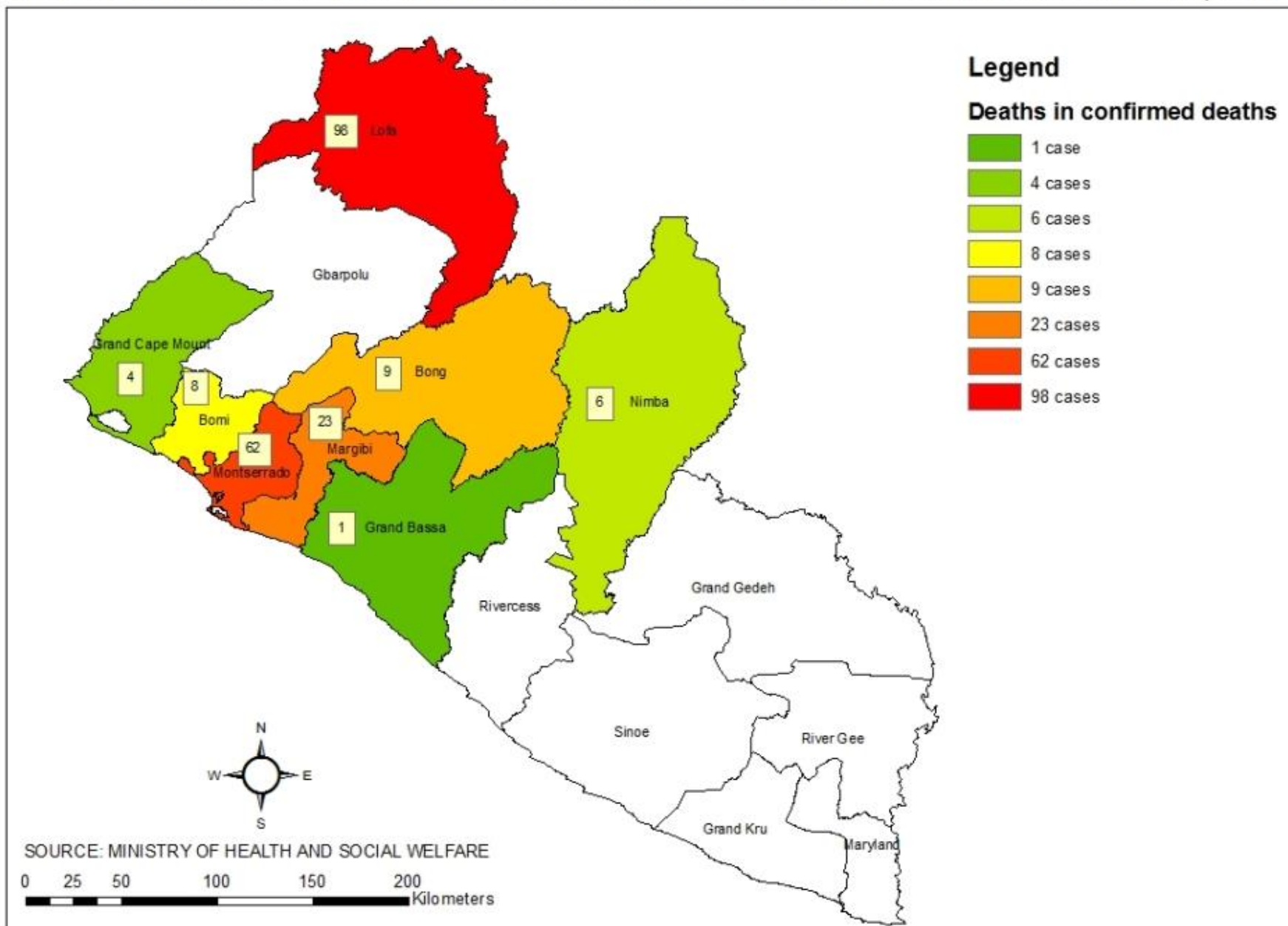

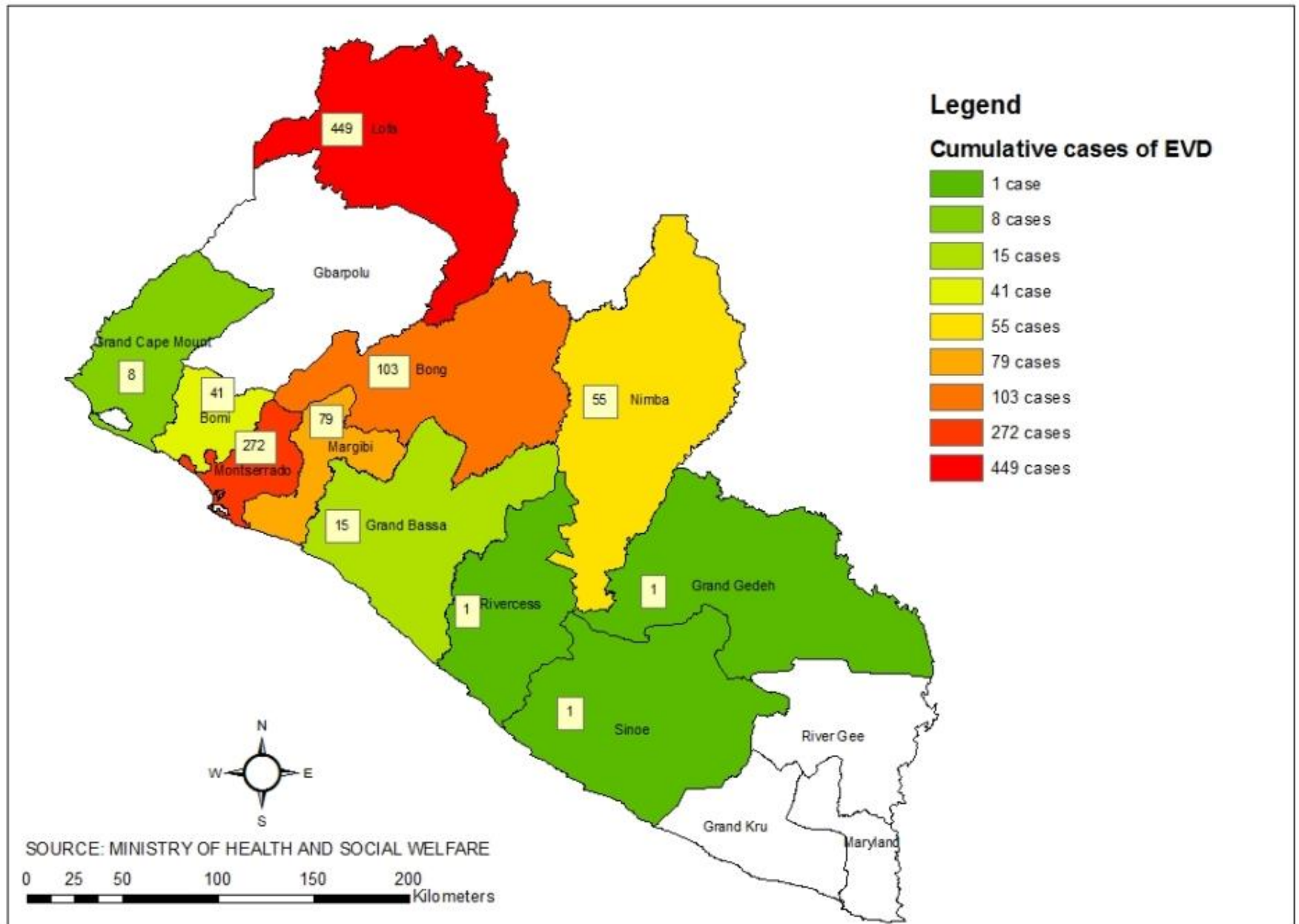

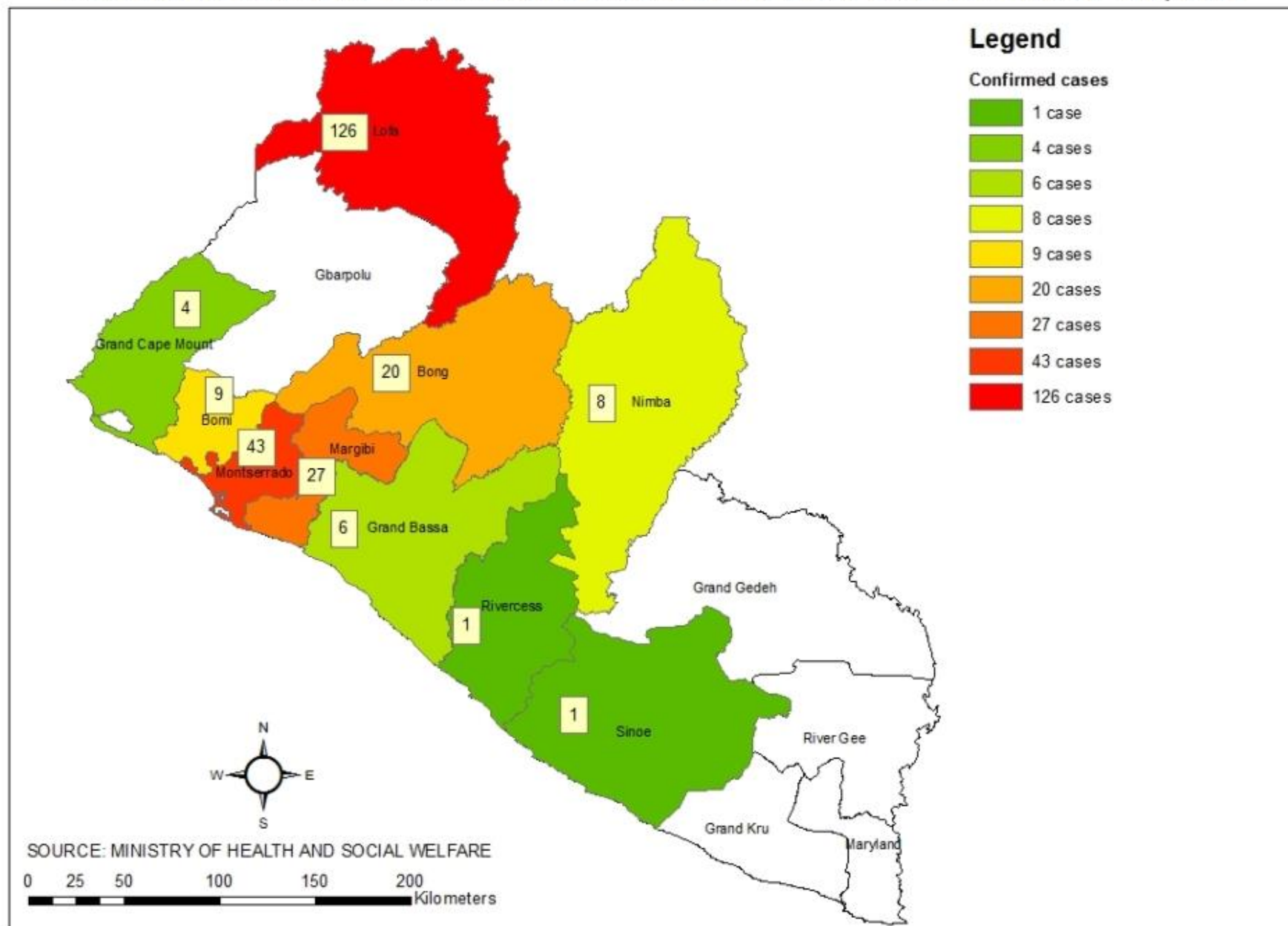
DEATHS IN CONFIRMED CASES OF EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE SINCE MAY 29th TO AUGUST 19th, 2014



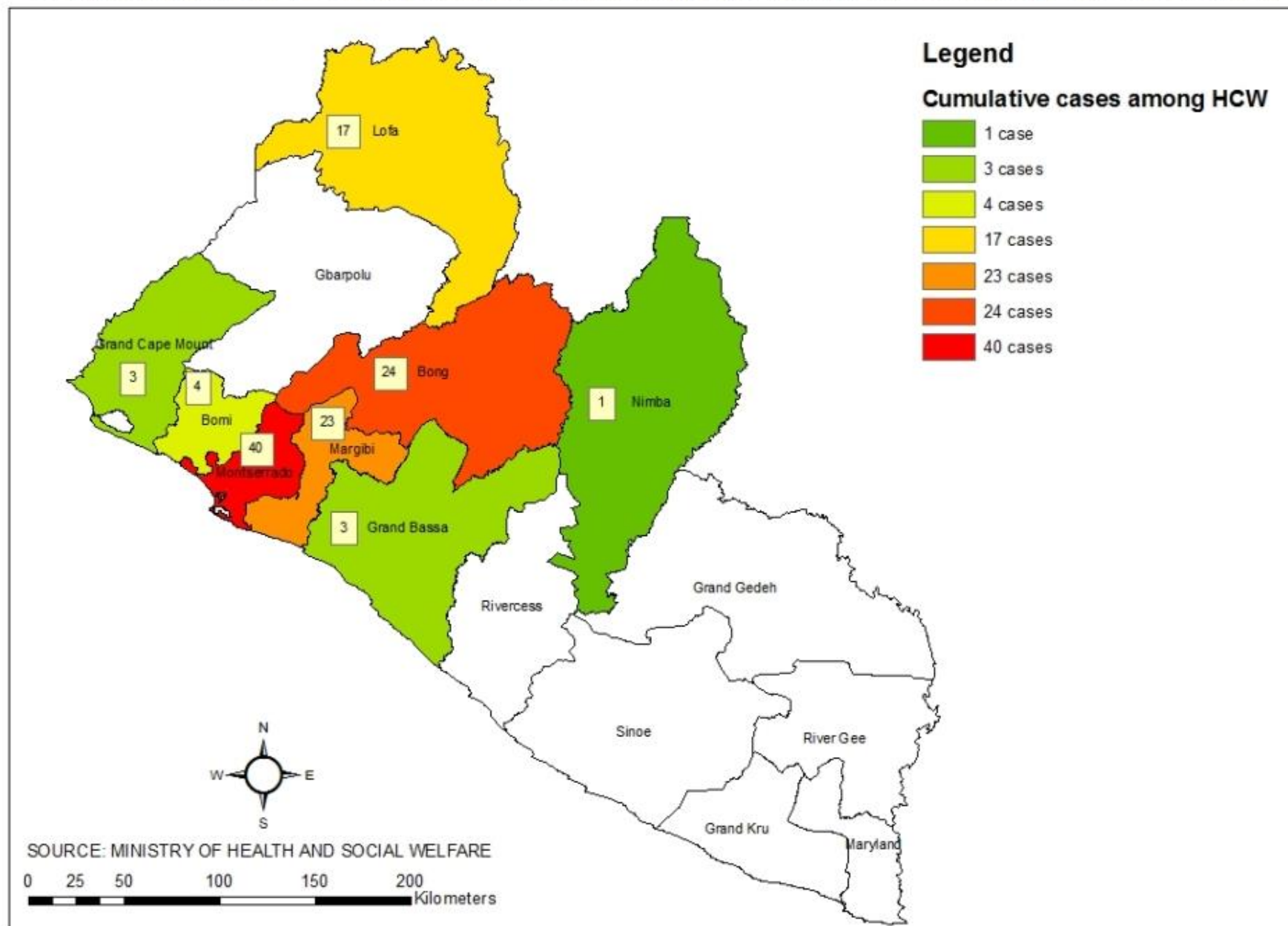
CUMULATIVE CASES OF EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE SINCE MAY 29th TO AUGUST 19th, 2014



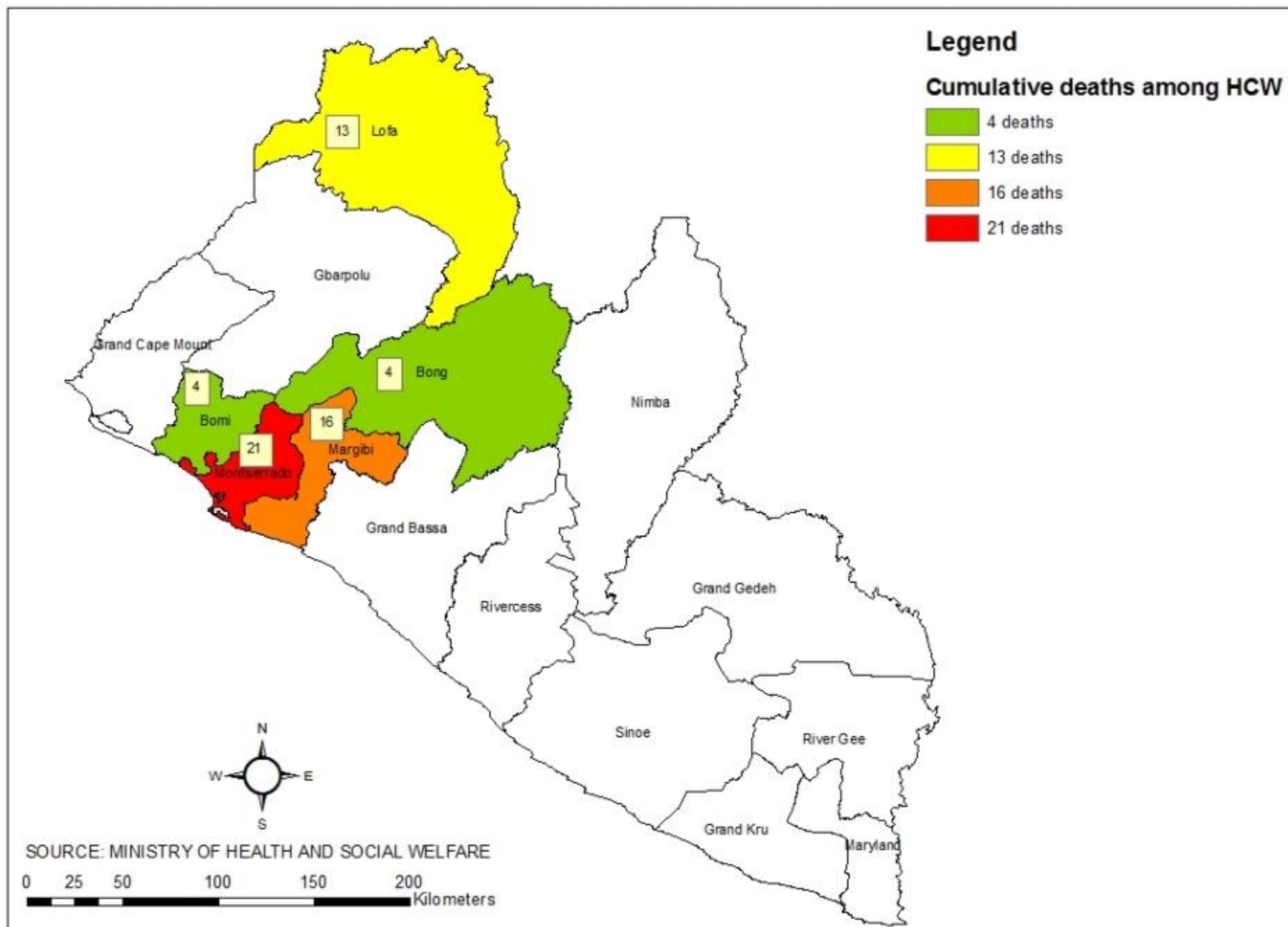
CONFIRMED CASES OF EBOLA VIRUS DISEASE SINCE MAY 29th TO AUGUST 19th, 2014



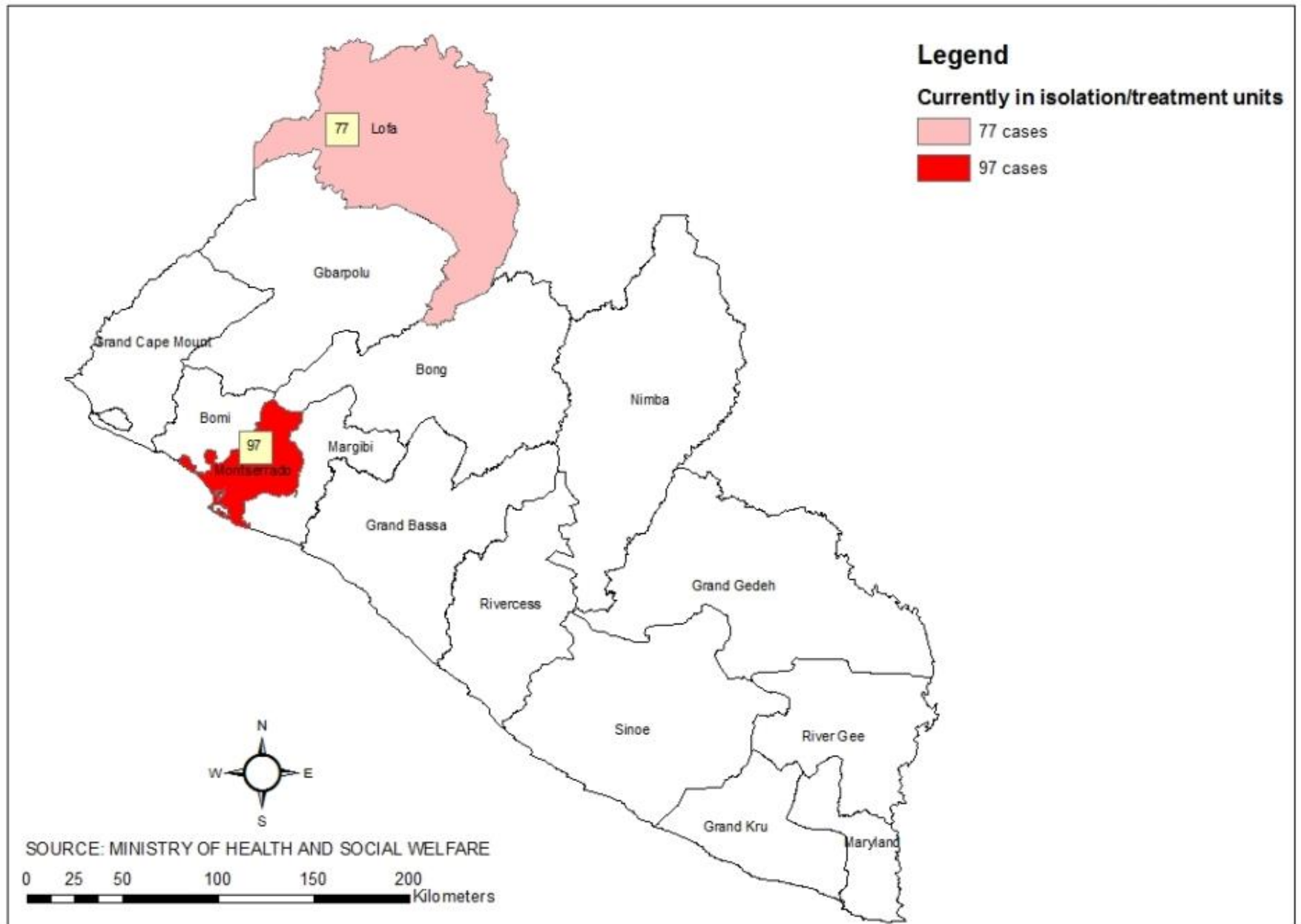

Highlights

Case Investigation

- A total of 20 cases were transferred to MSF ETU.
- 7 (1 suspected 6 probable) specimens collected in Nimba County and sent to lab for testing.
- Total number of bodies reported: **31**
 - No information from the burial team as to the number of bodies collected up to reporting time.

Health Promotion Highlights

- Conducted TOT workshop for 125 Pastors on Church Response to Ebola outbreak.
- Conducted Ebola Workshop for 20 members of the Soul Clinic Community Liberian Christian Network
- Ebola messages revised with support from partners (WHO, UNICEF, RBHS, UNMIL, and MSF).
- 400 gCHVs in Montserrado County were trained in collaboration in with the Montserrado County Health Team and partners.

Montserrat Highlights

- Coordinators have been identified for various tasks with TORs now being developed for these positions
- West Point continues to be an issue. As of this afternoon, 2 bodies were removed from the community with indications of more to be collected
- A decision was reached restrict family member bringing cooked food into the ETU at JFK for fear of people smuggling in medications
- County leadership continues to push for the establishment of community holding centers
- Still delays in getting timely laboratory results

Lofa Highlights

- Total new cases is 30 (7 from Kolahun District and 23 from Voinjama District all probable)
- 19 results received from the lab up to this reporting time (11 negative and 8 positive)
- The MOHSW with support from the CDC installed Ebola data server and router in Voinjama. This will enable multiple entry at county level with immediate transmittal to Monrovia
- The county Superintendent and the CHO along with WHO visited Kolahun to help structure the district response team

Nimba Highlights

- The County Superintendent headed the Task Force accompanied by the CHO and the WHO representative to Ganta to support to the local Task Force to facilitate among other things the mass burial of 9 probable Ebola related bodies
- The Team continued to Saclepea for another probable Ebola death
- There is a mass movement of people out of Ganta due to fear of Ebola and deaths associated with ebola
- All traditional herbalist activities in the county have been ordered suspended with violators threatened with arrest and prosecution
- The County authority has also ordered the closure of all FUNERAL homes
- No more black bagging in the County. Violators caught will be charged and prosecuted
- 7 probable cases specimens taken in Ganta and sent to National lab. (LIBR)
- **Issues & Constraints**
- **The Ebola burial team in Ganta is making high financial demand for burial**
- **No Vehicle for spraying team**
- **Lack of body bags in county**

Bong Highlights

- Two communities in Gbarnga have been quarantined due to increased Ebola cases and death
- Video Clubs are ordered closed by county authorities
- Zonal leaders are now helping in finding contacts lost to follow-up
- Movement of commercial motorcycles have been restricted from 7:00PM to 6:00AM
- Community still apprehensive of the contact tracing teams due to denial
- Limited manpower to contain the outbreak
- Lack of risk allowance for Ebola Emergency teams
- Health workers at the two (2) Hospitals have not returned to work
- Increase community deaths
- Limited logistics (vehicles)
- Community structures are not active for Ebola response

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
