I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**Profile of the Incident**

- Due to heavy rains, a landslide incident occurred at about 2:30 AM, 22 April 2011 in a small scale mining area at Panganason-B, Brgy. Kingking, Pantukan, Compostela Valley Province, resulting to the entrapment of several miners and damaging numerous houses

II. ACTION/S TAKEN:

- **As of 11:00AM of 24 April 2011, Incident briefing was conducted by Mayor JC Celso Sarenas of Pantukan to the Secretary of National Defense, Hon. Voltaire T. Gazmin and Secretary of Department of Interior and Local Government, Hon. Jesse M. Robredo, and attended by the following:**

The body recommended for the forced evacuation of more or less 30 Families living in the other side of the barangay within 48 hours and strict enforcement of not allowing small scale miners to operate.

- **A Press Conference followed after the Briefing.**
 - **Davao Firefighters and Rescue Services (DFRS) assisted in the retrieval operations.**
 - Dir Liza Mazo and Fe Kalimpo of OCD Region 11 had conducted Damage Analysis and Needs Assessment (DANA) for Compostela Valley with the MDRRMC of Pantukan
 - APEX Mining Team joined the rescue operations
 - Injured victims were brought to Pantukan Emergency Hospital and Davao Medical Center, Tagum City for medical treatment and attention
 - The 71st Infantry Batallion, MDRRMC Pantukan and Brgy. Kingking responders, and police personnel assigned in the area conducted search, rescue and retrieval operations
 - Established an Incident Command Post at the Municipal Hall of Pantukan, headed by Lt. Col. Camilo Ligayo of 71st Infranry Batallion, together with LGU, PNP and Philippine Army
 - Mobilized DRRO Troops:
 - 1 Bulldozer c/o Russel Mining
 - 1 Bulldozer, 1 Dumptruck and 1 backhoe from LGU
 - 1 SAR Helicopter from 505th SAR, PAF
 - K9 Trackers
 - 2 UH-1H from TOG 11, PAF, Davao
 - Response Capabilities at the Incident Command Post:
 - 1 Ambulance with medical team from 10ID PA
 - Rapelling equipment and 15 troops from 71ID and DART Rescue Group
 - 10 motorbikes from NADECOR
 - 3 Ambulances from MHO, Pantukan District Hospital and P/MDRRMC with rapelling equipment
 - RDRRMC – 11 held a press conference at around 10:00 AM, 22 April 2011 and were participated by LCE, LGU, PPD, Provincial Representatives, AFP, PNP and other provincial representatives
 - DSWD XI and DOH XI provided relief goods and medical supplies, treatment and attention to the victims and their families; DSWD-Field Office (FO) XI is coordinating with their local counterparts and closely monitoring the incident
 - DSWD-FO XI standby funds (Php310,851.26) and stockpiled relief commodities composed of family food packs 1,951 worth Php389,444.98 and food worth Php188,169.44 ready for augmentation to the local government units
