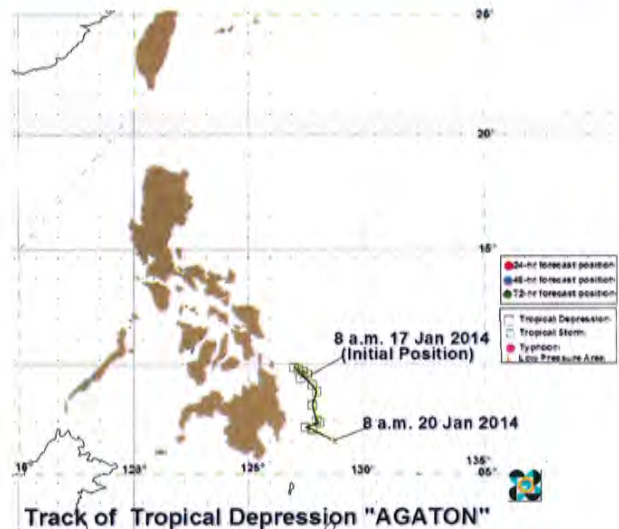

I. CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS: (Source: PAGASA)

17 January 2014

- The Low Pressure Area (LPA) in Southeast of Guiuan, Eastern Samar developed into a Tropical Depression and was named "Agaton" with maximum sustaining winds of 55 kph near the center. Tropical Depression "AGATON" maintained its strength as it continued to move towards the Surigao Provinces.



18 January 2014

- TD "AGATON" maintained its strength as it continued to move west slowly. At 4:00 PM, TD "AGATON" moved southeastward while maintaining its strength.

19 January 2014

- TD "AGATON" moved southwestward while maintaining its strength. At 10:00 AM, it slightly accelerated at 205 km Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur or 230 km East of Davao City. At 4:00 PM, it slowed down while maintaining its strength.

20 January 2014

- At 4:00 AM, TD "AGATON" moved east southeast slowly while maintaining its strength. At 10:00 AM, it weakened into a Low Pressure Area at 400 km East Southeast of Davao City or 455 km East of General Santos City.

II. EFFECTS

A. INCIDENTS MONITORED (TAB A)

- A total of **twenty-four (24) incidents** were reported; sixteen (16) landslide incidents, six (6) floodings/flashflood incidents and two (2) maritime incidents in Regions VIII, IX, X, XI, CARAGA and ARMM

B. CASUALTIES (TAB B)

- A total of **seventy (70) persons were reported dead, eighty-six (86) are injured and nine (9) are still missing** in Regions IX, X, XI and CARAGA

C. AFFECTED POPULATION (TAB C)

- A total of **244,344 families/1,148,621 persons** were affected in **1,002** barangays in **118** municipalities in **16** provinces of Regions X, XI, XII, CARAGA and ARMM

- Out of the total affected, **2,441 families / 11,621 persons** were displaced and served inside **58** evacuation centers (**Source: DSWD-DROMIC**)

D. STATUS OF LIFELINES

- As of 31 January 2014, , one (1) road in Southern Leyte and one (1) bridge in Davao Oriental is still unpassable

E. STATUS OF MAJOR RIVERS AND DAMS

- Irrigation Dams in Aragon and Brgy Taytayan in Cateel, Davao Oriental were damaged due to flooding

F. DAMAGED HOUSES (TAB D)

- A total of **3,482 houses** were damaged (**1,585 totally/1,897 partially**).

G. COST OF DAMAGES (TAB E)

- The total cost of damages amounted to **PhP566,714,173.23**, with **PhP273,623,750.00** for infrastructure and **PhP293,090,423.23** for agriculture in Regions X, XI and CARAGA.

H. COST OF ASSISTANCE

- **PhP82,823,136.81** worth of relief goods were provided to the affected families from the combined resources of **DSWD (PhP43,174,197.21)**, **LGUs (PhP35,486,090.55)**, **NGOs/Other GOs (PhP2,059,685.00)** and **DOH (PhP2,103,164.05)** in Regions V, X, XI, XII and CARAGA.

III. ACTIONS TAKEN

EMERGENCY PREPAREDENESS AND RESPONSE:

NDRRMC Operations Center

- NDRRMOC remained under **BLUE ALERT STATUS**
- Disseminated NDRRMC Advisories on Weather Advisory to all regions affected through SMS and facsimile, uploaded the same at the NDRRMC Website, Facebook, and Twitter accounts for further dissemination to their respective local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Continuous monitoring in on going

PAGASA

- Continuously disseminates Weather Bulletins and advisories and constantly monitors the situation

AFP

- PS20 vessel from Naval Forces Eastern Military conducted relief operations to affected areas
- Two (2) UH-1H HELIS from TOG 11 conducted SAR operations in 701 Bde Hqs.
- Troops of 75IB with PNP provided manpower assistance to the evacuees of Brgy. San Gabriel and Binongan in Veruela, Agusan del Sur and two (2) squads of Alpha Coy, 75IB provided manpower assistance to the evacuees of Brgy. Tapaz and Brgy. Poblacion, Sta. Josefa, Agusan del Sur
- One (1) section of 75IB with one (1) M35 truck provided manpower assistance to the evacuees of Brgy. Tabon, Bislig City, Surigao del Sur
- On 07:00 AM, 14 January, troops from A/661IB assisted evacuation from Purok 3, 6, 7, 8 of Brgy. Magsaysay, Nabunturan, Compostela Valley to Magsaysay Elementary School
- On 7:00 PM, 11 January, one section of 28IB conducted Disaster Response and Rescue Operation (DRRO) and evacuated 10 families from So Banganga, Brgy. Corporacion, 6 families from Brgy. Tagugpo, 75 families from Brgy. Site, Poblacion and 52 families from Brgy. Macango, Lupon, Davao Oriental to Brgy. Gyms.
- 36th IB installed Radio Base at the Surigao del Sur PDRRM Office to augment help in communication and rescue

DILG

- DILG CARAGA activated their disaster monitoring system and assists in dissemination of weather updates. Coordinates with their Field Offices and advised the LGUs to take precautionary measures

PCG

- Placed on heightened Alert to respond in any emergency situation that might occur and to ensure the strict implementation of HPCG Memorandum Circular 02-13
- PCG personnel assisted BFAR Patrol Boat MCS-3005 and Navy Ship PS-20 in transporting relief goods from Mati City to Lambajon Pier, Baganga and Davao Oriental
- PCG Surigao City Station has cancelled all sea travels in all ports of Surigao del Norte and Dinagat Islands and advised the public not to venture into the sea to avoid any untoward incident
- PCG Southeastern Mindanao transported 146 passengers (military & civilian) and 157 tons of relief goods to Lambajon Pier, Baganga, Davao Oriental

PNP

- **PRO XIII** activated their Regional Disaster Operation Center under the Regional Police Community Relations Division and the Regional Operation and Plans Division. Their Provincial, City and Municipality counter-part have also activated their respective Disaster Operation and Monitoring Centers in coordination with their respective LDRRMCs under the advice that SAR teams and equipments are prepositioned for immediate response for any eventualities; deployed their personnel to augment during pre-emptive evacuation, forced evacuation, onset evacuation and Search and Rescue in high risk areas in the region.
 - PNP personnel from 13th Regional Public Safety Battalion augment help in rescue operation in Brgy. Buhangin and traffic flow at Magsaysay Bridge, Brgy. Baan, Butuan City
 - PNP personnel from 133rd Regional Public Safety Coy provided security and traffic control at Simulao Bridge, Bunawan Brooks, Agusan del Sur
 - PNP Butuan City assisted in the packing and distribution of relief goods, mass feeding and security in evacuation centers.

DSWD

- Prepositioned **Php47.87 million** worth of emergency relief resources consisting of standby funds (**P P5.79 million**), **61,982** family food packs (**P16.53 million**) and other food and NFIs (**P26.6 million**) readily available for augmentation.

PRC

- Deployed personnel to conduct monitoring and to augment in relief distribution in affected areas in Compostela Valley, Lanao del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Davao del Norte, Agusan del Norte, Davao Oriental and Surigao del Norte
- Assessment was conducted in the Municipality of Jabonga, Agusan del Norte where evacuees already stayed for about 4 days in the evacuation center and rising of evacuated families was being reported
- Coordination with the LGUs is closely maintained
- Locally purchased relief goods for 200 families in Butuan City, Agusan del Norte
 - **Compostela Valley Chapter** provided hot meals to Brgy. Bankerohan Norte and Brgy. Tapia, Montevista
 - **Davao Oriental – Mati Chapter** assisted and provided meals, sleeping mats and blankets to 16 families that were evacuated at Mtiao Brgy Hall, Muni of Mati due to flooding.
 - **Agusan del Norte-Butuan City Chapter** continued the relief distribution of food items at Municipality of Jabonga, Agusan del Norte catering 273 families/1,042 individuals
 - **Agusan del Sur Chapter** team assessed the landslide area in Sibagat; deployed 2 teams for relief distribution on 21 January 2014 at Municipality of Bunawan to 500 families and in Municipality of San Francisco, Brgy. Buenasuerte to 250 families; distributed food packs in Brgy. Tagbayagan, Rosario with 345 families/ 1470 individuals and Brgy. Desamparado, Talacogon with 288 families/ 1364 individuals; government provided food packs to the affected families in the evacuation centers; conducted continuous assessment and data collation in coordination with the LGU; mobilized volunteers and staff for packing of goods and relief distribution
 - **Surigao del Norte Chapter** distributed food items to 624 families at Surigao City and Surigao del Norte; deployed 2 teams on 21 January 2014 for relief distribution in Claver, Higakit and Surigao City to 660 families

- **Iligan City Chapter** provided hotmeals to 128 individuals; first-aid treatment provided to 12 persons

NFA

- NFA CARAGA activated their provincial Operations Center to ensure ready assistance of rice if needed. They also have released rice to affected LGUs with the total of 625 bags since 12 January 2014

MGB

- Conduct ocular inspection of the reported landslide incident at Brgy. Marayag Proper, Lupon

DOH

- **DOH HEMS** augmented 30,000 pcs of Aquatabs to CHD XI last January 15, 2014; advised respective CHDs to confirm health consequences (i.e. deaths and injuries); continuous coordination to all regions affected; continuous monitoring of the weather disturbance; informed RHEMS coordinator regarding to the monitored event
- **CHD VIII** continues to monitor the event
- **CHD X** continues to monitor the event; coordinated with DOH representatives and verify reports; provided medicines per request of affected areas
- **CHD XI** is on Code White Alert; augmented drugs and medicines in Monkayo and Compostela Valley worth PhP17,000 each and cadaver bags to PHO Compostela Valley (25 pcs) and Mati City Health Office (10 pcs); CHD XI-DOH Representative conducted Rapid Health Assessment and CHD XI emergency team responders are on standby mode; continuous coordination with PHO, MHO, OCD XI, RESU and EPI program managers
- **CHD CARAGA** is on Code White Alert; OpCen is monitoring 24/7 basis; on-call/Stand-by of response teams; continuous monitoring of the event; coordinated with all PHO/CHO, PHTL, PDRRMO, CRDDMO, OCD regarding the status of flooding, evacuation and needs; delivered assorted medicines to all affected areas; prepositioned necessary drugs, medicine and medical supplies to CHD OpCen worth PhP300,959.24 and to Provincial Health Team Offices worth PhP281,768.22 and for immediate delivery to affected areas

REGIONAL PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE:

- **RDRRMC V, VII, IX, X, XI and CARAGA** disseminated weather advisory for Low Pressure Area (LPA); Continuously monitoring AOR for possible flashfloods and landslides, continuous weather update dissemination; Coordinates to all P/M/C DRRMCs for any updates in their respective Area of Responsibility

Region V

OCD V

- On Blue Alert status
- Advised RDRRMC Response Agencies to place on standby alert all DRTs and submit status report and actions taken
- Continuous coordination with PCDDBCL re status of different ports in the region

PDRRMC Albay

- Advised the LDRRMCs to:
 1. Closely monitor the forecast events for its daily update and development from PAGASA and PDRRMC Albay through the local DRRMCs and local radio stations.
 2. Activate and convene the LDRRMC to discuss the matter and come up with a local scenario for advance planning on appropriate counter measures.
 3. Review their local risk reduction plan on flood, wind, landslide, lahar and coastal flooding as well as the corresponding vulnerable population for disaster avoidance.
 4. Start reviewing the list of vulnerable population by sitio or purok and come up with the list as your basis in evacuation planning.

5. Come up with a listing of safe evacuation centers using government and private facilities including safe private houses for an effective evacuation planning.
- Advised the residents to keep on monitoring the daily weather updates from PAGASA; maintain coordination with the local authorities and cooperate with the local authorities in case of emergency advisory issuance

PDRRMCs Sorsogon/Camarines Sur/Camarines Norte/Catanduanes and Masbate

- Continuously monitors their respective AOR and disseminates weather advisories
- Alerted all concerned response agencies and groups

Region IX

PDRRMC Zamboanga del Norte

- Conducted search, rescue and retrieval operations

MDRRMC Mahayag

- Conducted search and rescue operations

MDRRMC Salug

- Provided financial assistance to the victims of uprooted tree

Region X

- LGU conducted clearing operations at the road section in Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte
- BDC, PDRRMC, MDRRMC, DSWD, RHU and KERT of Kapatagan, Lanao del Norte assisted in the pre-emptive evacuation of threatened families
- CDRRMC Valencia personnel facilitated the pre-emptive evacuation of threatened families in Brgy. Catumbalon, Valencia City
- CDRRMC Gingoog City's Engineer's Office, Agriculture's Office and Veterinary Office conducted field assessment to affected areas
- Habitat for Humanity donated 1,000 packs of foods and bottled water

Region XI

- Continuous monitoring of AOR and coordination with P/M/C/DRRMCs

PDRRMC Davao Del Norte

- Davao del Norte PDRRM OpCen conducted continuous monitoring of the water level of major rivers in the province
- Activated Incident Command System
- Created Strike Team to conduct situation assessment on the flooded areas
- PDRRMC Rescue Groups continuously assisting the local DRRMCs in the conduct of evacuation and rescue operations
- MSWDOs prepared and distributed food relief assistance to the affected families
- LDRRMCs and PDRRMC continuously monitoring water level of major tributary rivers particularly Libuganon River, Saug River, Tuganay River, Nanaga River

MDRRMC Asuncion

- **Asuncion MDRRM OpCen and Rescue group** conducted pre-emptive evacuation at Barangays Sagayen and Canatan of Asuncion, Davao del Norte

MDRRMC New Corella

- Conducted rescue operations to the affected families
- **RDR** Rescuers and volunteers conducted rescue operations for the affected families in Limbaan, New Corella

MDRRMC Kapalong

- Activated Incident Command System and created evacuation committee; activated KARES, PNP, 60th IB AFP and BFP for the conduct of rescue operations for any untoward incidents

- Provided portable toilets, temporary breast feeding center and dressing room for women

CDRRMC Tagum City

- Conducted forced evacuation to the affected families
- Activated Incident Command System and Opcen placed under Red Alert status
- Coordinated with barangay DRRMCs particularly those barangays at identified high risk in flooding and landslide incidents
- Coordinated with different CSOs for augmentation in the conduct of rescue operations
- Prepositioned light and heavy equipment ready for deployment for any untoward incident
- Activated different response committees in the conduct of emergency rescue & response efforts to the affected families

CDRRMC Davao City

- Opcen placed under Red Alert status
- Continuously monitoring their AOR; monitors water level of their major river particularly Davao river; Disseminates weather updates to all Barangay DRRMCs thru telefax, radio message and SMS
- Conducted forced evacuation to the possible affected families
- Activated all rescue groups including 911 Emergency Response Team for the conduct of rescue operations to any untoward incident

PDRRMC Compostela Valley

- **Provincial DRRM Office** issued memorandum to all MDRRMCs to activate their respective Incident Command System
- **Philippine Army and Philippine National Police Response teams** were activated to assist LGUs
- **PSWDO and MSWDO** had already prepared food relief assistance for the affected families
- **PDRRMO** is continuously monitoring the weather condition and status of major rivers; continuously monitoring rainfall through installed Automatic Rain Gauges in AOR
- Compostela Valley emergency Response Team, together with ComVal PNP SARO and MOSART ALPHA conducted rescue operations in Nabunturan, Montevista, Monkayo and Compostela

PDRRMC Davao Oriental

- Continuously monitoring their AOR; disseminates weather updates to all LDRRMCs
- 67th IB PA instructed the residents to evacuate to other houses away from landslide area
- DPWH and 67th IB PA conducted clearing operations at the affected area

MDRRMC Cateel

- Conducted ocular inspection to the affected areas

MDRRMC Lupon

- On red alert status
- Conducted Rescue Operations and Evacuations to the affected families

MDRRMC New Bataan

- Issued EO No. 2 S. 2014 to conduct pre-emptive evacuation of families in identified high risk areas and activation of Incident Command System in municipal and barangay level
- Continuous monitoring of waterways
- Desilted Mayo River to mitigate flooding

CARAGA Region

PDRRMCs

- **Agusan del Norte and Dinagat Islands** continue sending advisories to all MDRRMCs and advised fishermen not to venture into the sea
- **Surigao del Sur and Agusan del Sur** are closely monitoring flood prone areas in their respective areas of responsibility; All other LDRRMCs are on heightened alert status

- **Surigao del Norte** conducted coordination meeting with MDRRMC Tubod and Mainit; prepositioned 100 food packs for each municipality; PDRRMO zone teams were also dispatched to inspect and evaluate situation in high risk areas; prepositioned vehicles and conducted pre-emptive evacuation; conducted relief operations
- PDRRMC Chair Gov. Glenda B. Ecleo declared the entire province under Imminent Danger and Heightened Alert due to rains brought about by the tropical depression; forced evacuation is imposed on all high risk area susceptible to landslide, flooding and storm surges
- **Surigao del Sur, CDRRMC Bislig and MDRRMC Carrascal** are on 24 hour monitoring operation and set response team on standby at their respective OPCEN for immediate response
- **Surigao del Sur** deployed 2 groups of Search and Emergency Response Team of Surigao Sur (SERTSS) in cooperation with 36th IB to Sitio Sampinit, Gamut in Tago and Brgy. Panaosawon in bayabas, Surigao del Sur for rescue operation earlier of 17 January 2014
- **Agusan del Norte** conducted ocular survey in flood and landslide prone barangays of Cabadbaran, Tubay, Jabonga and RTR; Agusan del Norte Emergency Response Team (ADNERT) assisted the Butuan City Search and Rescue in the conduct of rescue operations to Brgys. Mahogany, Baan and Buhangin. Evacuees are staying at Provincial Covered Court
- **Provincial Incident Management Team (PIMT) of Dinagat Islands** was activated and operational planning and briefing was conducted
- PSWDO in coordination with MDRRMOs facilitated the distribution of 53 bags of NFA rice and 1,239 family packs to affected families throughout the province

MDRRMCs

- **Sibagat** through search and rescue unit is closely monitoring the Wawa River
- **Esperanza** prepositioned rescue teams, equipments and facilities for possible evacuation
- **San Francisco** issued local advisory for the pre-emptive evacuation of those in high risk areas
- **Esperanza and Sibagat** prepositioned rescue teams, equipments and facilities for possible evacuation; Sibagat is closely monitoring the Wawa River
- **Trento** deployed response team composed of local Search and Rescue Agusan Sur (SARAS), BFP and PNP to Brgys. Kapatungan, Basa, Manat, Tudela and Sta. Maria; a family with a 9 year old paralyzed special child was saved in this operation; extended relief goods and medical services to evacuees
- **Tubod** conducted pre-emptive evacuation in Sitio Hubasan, Brgy. Cawilan, Purok 4 Brgy. Del Rosario and Purok 4 Brgy. Motorpool in coordination with 30IB PA, Greenstone Resources Corporation and Silangan Mindanao Mining Company; municipal employees of Tubod were on shifting schedule to man the Municipal OpCen
- **Hinatuan** Chair Candelario Viola has ordered mass evacuation to the residents living along coastlines and island barangays prioritizing the vulnerable groups to include women, PWDs, elderly and children; Charlie Coy of 75th IB augment help during the evacuation; Hinatuan Response Team rescued 2 capsized boats early morning of 17 January 2014, no casualties reported
- **Carrascal** is continuously conducting on-air wide dissemination on preparedness measures and weather bulletins; conducted ocular survey on the status of rivers, streams and landslide prone areas on 17 January 2014
- Carras Nickel Corporation (CNC) deployed 15 rescuers and 1 heavy equipment for transportation in the request of MDRRMC Carrascal for help in the evacuation of the affected communities
- **Jabonga** assisted in the evacuation and distributed relief goods and aqua purifier tablet/liquid to flood affected families
- **Buenavista** convened for an emergency meeting to prepare for possible effects of this weather disturbance and established Command Center to monitor the situation. Likewise, forced evacuation was implemented in coastal and other high risk areas in the municipality and deployed rescue teams to assist in evacuation
- **Kitcharao** issued local advisory for families near riverbanks to evacuate.

- **Las Nieves** conducted emergency meeting and mobilized Emergency Response Team to conduct monitoring of situation in high risk areas and assist in relief distribution.
- **Magallanes and Nasipit** prepositioned local rescue team for immediate response. Nasipit MDRRM Office together with MLGOO and PNP is on 24 hour monitoring operation.
- **RTR, Magallanes and Tubay** prepared relief goods for affected families and evacuees.
- **MDRRMC members of Santiago and Tubay** conducts regular patrol to their respective flood prone areas.
- **Lapaz** conducted a meeting and activated all BDRRMCs mobilizing SARAS; relief goods were prepositioned
- **Alegria** activated all BDRRMCs
- **Claver** conducted pre-emptive evacuation in Brgy. Magallanes with the help of mining company buses
- **Surigao City** prepositioned rescue vehicles in Brgys. San Juan and Taft; pre-emptive evacuations were conducted in Brgys. Bonotan, Pagasa and Washington
- **MDRRMC Bunawan** continues to extend relief goods from DSWD, GMA Kapuso Foundation, Inc. and Philsaga Mining Corporation to affected families. Likewise, the MDRRMC is on 24-hour monitoring operation. Consultative Meeting has been conducted by the MDRRMC, BDRRMC and partner agencies like PNP, AFP, DepEd and Agusan del Sur College of Agriculture personnel for presentation of damages caused by flood and typhoon Agaton as well as observations, assessment and recommendations per committees assignment for the enhancement/improvement of the Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) of Bunawan MDRRMC.

CDRRMCs

- **Butuan City** conducted emergency meeting for the discussion and approval of the Declaration of State of Calamity; raised Alert Level 2 and continues to monitor the water level in Agusan River; prepositioned rescue teams composed of PNP, AFP and local Emergency Response Unit in high risk areas for possible floodings; **Butuan City Search and Rescue Team** with the help of 401st and 402nd Brigade, Philippine Navy and PNP conducted rescue operations to Brgys. Mahogany, Mahay, Baan Riverside, Banza and Buhangin
- **Surigao** implemented forced evacuation to residents in Sitio Pagasa
- **Bayugan City** provided 311 food packs to the affected families in evacuation areas
