## **NDRRMC UPDATE**

### **Sitrep No. 3 re Landslide Incident in Pantukan, Compostela Valley**

#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

- On or about 3:00 AM today, January 5, 2012, a landslide incident occurred at hilly portion of Sitio Diat 1 to Diat 700, a Gold Panning Area, Barangay Napnapan, Pantukan, Compostela Valley Province due to continuous rain these past few days. Several shanties/light material houses located towards Diat 2 Gold Panning Area were wiped out

#### **CASUALTIES (Tab A)**

##### **DEAD**

- Twenty five (25) dead bodies have been recovered and retrieved while 16 persons were rescued alive. **Of the 25, only nine (9) are identified**

##### **INJURED**

- Sixteen (16) persons were reported injured who were brought to the Regional Hospital in Brgy. Apokon Tagum City for treatment. Out of the 16, only eight (8) are identified

##### **MISSING**

- The Municipal Officer of Pantukan reported that more or less 150 persons are still missing. As of reporting time, eight (8) are already identified

#### **II. ACTIONS TAKEN**

- RDRRMC/OCD Region XI team is now conducting damage and needs assessment in the area to assess the extent of damages and validate the actual number of casualties
- **PDRRMC Davao Oriental Rescue Team** is now assisting in the conduct of SAR and retrieval operations
- MDRRMC Pantukan initiated the conduct of Conference (still ongoing) and has declared the Municipality under a State of Calamity

- Rescue teams who responded to the landslide site for the conduct of search and rescue (SAR) operations are the following:

**DSWD**

- **DSWD- Field Office (FO) XI** is closely monitoring and coordinating with their local counterparts for any significant reports. Further, FO has available standby funds (P535,470.00), stockpile of relief commodities composed of 1,942 family food packs (P480,198.34), and food (P668,718.04) and non-food (P177,802.04) ready for augmentation to the local government units affected by any type of disasters.

**PNP**

- A team composed of personnel from Pantukan Police Station, RPSB XI and PPSC led by PNSP Joel Garcia proceeded to the site on board 2 PNP trucks and Mobile Car with SAR equipment to assist in the ongoing SAR operations
- Additional one (1) platoon from CVPPSC led by P/INSP Melvin Fernandez and PINSP Joel D. Garcia, under the overall supervision of PSSUPT Timoteo G. Pacleb, arrived at Pantukan

**AFP**

- AFP deployed one (1) platoon from 71<sup>st</sup> IB Intel Operatives, PA; one (1) troop of CAA/CAFGU; 5053rd SRSquadron, PAF; 100 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Brigade; 10<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division, PA; Tactical Operations Group XI, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Air Force Division with rescue Heli from Cagayan de Oro City to Davao City for the recovery and retrieval of more casualties.
- The 1001<sup>st</sup> Infantry Brigade recommended to the LGU to organize the MDRRMC for a coordinated response

**DOH**

- DOH-HEMS facilitated the provision of 150 cadaver bags as requested by CHD XI.
- CHD XI is now attending the medical needs of the injured victims and the management of the dead victims

**DILG**

- LGU Pantukan dispatched seven (7) trucks to the landslide site to assist in the conduct of SAR and retrieval operations
- MDRRMC Pantukan Incident Command Post (ICP) has been set up to organized a coordinated response.

**PRC**

- PRC Comval and Davao City Chapters are now assisting in the SAR and relief operations

**BFP**

- Bureau of Fire Protection COMVAL is also in the area providing services at the landslide area

**Other Volunteers**

- Small scale miners and APEX Miners also assisted in the SAR operations
