## TROPICAL CYCLONE WINSTON

### SITUATION REPORT 47 of 03/03/2016



The purpose of this report is to provide the update on the current operations undertaken after TC Winston.

This Situation Report is issued by the National Emergency Operation Centre and covers the period from 0000 hours to 0800 hours on 03/03/2016. Updates in this report summarise all reports and briefs submitted from various EOC's in the four divisions.

#### 1.0 HIGHLIGHTS OF LAST 12 HOURS

- (i) Wives of Prison officers in Naboro, Korovou and Nasinu distributed clothing and beddings for villagers in Nasinu, Lolomalevu Settlement, Silana, Nataleira and Driti.
- (ii) Telephone calls can now be made to Bua via Vodafone.
- (iii) Donations to the Prime Minister's National Disaster Rehabilitation Fund Account was received from:
  - ❖ Zaid Engineering Limited - \$3,000.00
  - ❖ Vunika Sanatan Faag Ramayan Mandali - \$200.00
- (iv) Larval spray was carried out in the Nasinu, Lolomalevu, Nataleira, Driti and Silana areas.
- (v) MV Vunilagi departed Lautoka Wharf at 0120hrs with one month rations for the villages in the tikinas of Yasawa, Nacula, Waya, Viwa and Vuda.
- (vi) A total of 29 schools are still without water in the Lautoka, Nadi and Yasawa Districts
- (vii) Sharmila Prasad of Waimari, Ra complained that she has yet any food ration and assistance. DIV EOC West has informed District EOC Ra to investigate this claim.
- (viii) 3430188 or 3430024 All calls to Korovou EOC to be diverted to 3430188 or 3430024.
- (ix) Two FNPF Teams are currently based at the Tailevu North District at Nayavu and the Social Welfare Office in Korovou.

#### 1.1 URGENT NEEDS/REQUESTS

- (i) Yasawa High School will resume classes on the 7<sup>th</sup> of March and urgently need tents to be used as classrooms.
- (ii) The following schools urgently needs water:
  - ❖ Namamanuca Primary School
  - ❖ Lololo Primary School
  - ❖ Tuvu Primary School
  - ❖ Raviravi Primary School
  - ❖ Drasa Muslim Primary School
  - ❖ Teidamu Primary School
  - ❖ Tavarau Primary School
- (iii) The villages of Waisa, Naterumai, Navulokani and Waisasavu in the province of Naitasiri are in urgent need of water.

(iv) 10,000 tarpaulins, 6000 (4 men) tent and family tents needed for the Western division.

## 1.2 STATUS SUMMARY

Number of deaths in the four divisions remains the same. There is however an increase in the number of evacuees although there has been a slight decrease in the evacuation centres.

It should be noted that for Tavua the number of evacuation centres decreased but the number of evacuees increased. Furthermore there was a drastic decrease in the number of evacuees in the Western Division from 30,663 to 17,595. This confirmed after the meeting between all DOs late last night.

## 1.3 WEATHER BULLETIN

Forecast to midnight tomorrow for the Fiji group received from Nadi at 0530 this morning (3<sup>rd</sup> March).

Brief showers over the eastern parts and interior of the larger islands. Elsewhere, fine apart from isolated afternoon or evening showers.

Moderate to fresh southeast winds.

Moderate to rough seas.

**Outlook for Friday** : Brief showers.

## 2.0 DIVISIONAL UPDATES

Brief summary of updates for each divisions are given below.

### 2.1 CENTRAL DIVISION

- ❖ Teams will be mobilized by the end of this week to all villagers in the Tailevu North area to carry out awareness on health issues.
- ❖ Agriculture, Livestock, and Infrastructure assessment being carried out in the Tailevu North area.

- ❖ Water restoration works is ongoing. Please refer to Appendix II.
- ❖ Food rations delivered to schools in Tailevu North area. (QVS, RKS, Namena Primary School, Delainakaikai Primary School, Lawaki Primary School, St Vincent College, St Vincent Primary School, and Lodon Primary School).
- ❖ Cleanup at Wainibuka continues.
- ❖ 20 x bags flour and 20 ctn soya bean oil airlifted to Nasiriti in Naitasiri.
- ❖ 15 bags of sugar airlifted to Nasau.
- ❖ Currently awaiting the arrival of RNZAF C130 at Nausori Airport bringing in temporary shelters and hygiene packs.

## **2.2 EASTERN DIVISION**

- ❖ Clean-up and distribution of food rations continues at Ovalau and Koro.
- ❖ Assessment team has conducted interview in various villages in the District of Mualevu and estimates damage cost of \$4,231,000.00. Damage to schools in Vanuabalavu is estimated to be approximately \$2, 676000.00.

## **2.4 NORTHERN DIVISION**

- ❖ Continuation of delivery of food rations in the tikina of Naweni, Nasavusavu, Vuna and Kubulau.
- ❖ 35 youths from Kilaka, Nakorovou completed the second day of clean up at Kubulau district school and will continue till 4 March 2016 as the quarters were destroyed and about 80% of the classrooms. A chain saw was delivered to help the process yesterday.
- ❖ About 40 youths and others from Naruwai began the clean-up at Nadi District School in Bua yesterday.

No further SITREPS received.

## **2.5 WESTERN DIVISION**

Structural assessments will be carried out the Nadroga/Navosa province today.

Reduction in the number evacuees from 30,663 (SITREP 43) to 17,995 (SITUATION UPDATE 0600 HRS).

## **3.0 AGENCY UPDATES**

Below are the agency updates received as of 0600hrs 02/03/2016 to 0000hrs 03/03/16.

### 3.3 Empower Pacific

For all the 9 communities that was assessed and supported through Psychological First Aid, 85% rated that their stress, anxiety and depression level would be most of the time since the traumatic event of TC Winston. Please refer to table below.

Concerns with children raised by the Turaga ni Koros and parents in Naweni, Nagigi and Kiobo was that for some they are not able to send their children to school since all their household goods including children's stationary were either blown away or destroyed during the cyclone and tidal wave. Other concerns raised by parents from Navave, was that now that they have moved out of the evacuation centers and living with extended families and for Naisasavuya still under temporary shelters with young infants and the elderly posing health risks and young girls and women more vulnerable to abuse.
