There is need for medical supplies and capacity including, orthopedic surgeons, surgeons, paramedics, logistics, field hospital tents and blankets.

Government identified 16 open spaces around Kathmandu for use as camps. Shelter support requested for all 16 identified sites.



Local Water management company (KUKL) is working to restore water supply, supplemented with water tanks.

14 Indian search and rescue (SAR) helicopters mobilized to support efforts. SAR teams from China, Pakistan and Israel have landed and begun operations.



National Emergency Operation Centre is operational. Kathmandu and Pokhara airport remain open. Some commercial flights are coming in.

The UN Disaster Assessment Coordination Team (UNDAC) arrived in Kathmandu and established a Reception & Departure Centre at the airport.



National Health Education and Communication Centre (NHEICC) is communicating key messages through Radio Nepal, Image Radio, Kantipur Radio & Nepal Bani.
