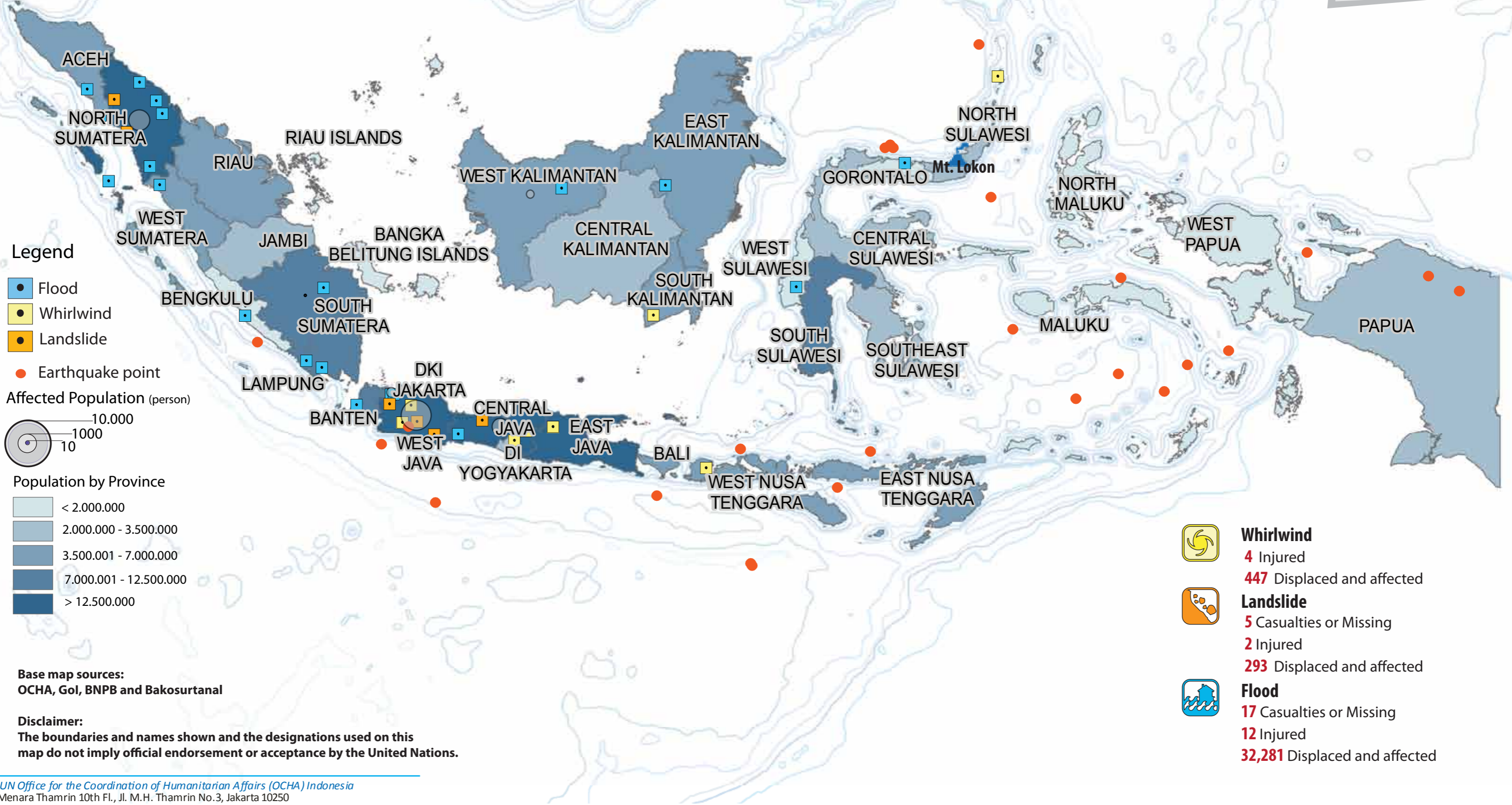


Indonesia Humanitarian Snapshot (November 2012)

- Increased natural disaster events with the second highest impact on people since January 2012.
- Floods, landslides and whirlwinds claimed 22 fatalities and affected over 33,000 people.
- High disaster-impact ratio as disasters hit densely populated island.

This snapshot is prepared based on information provided by UN agencies, INGOs, ASEAN, the Meteorology, Climatology and Geophysics Agency (BMKG), the National Disaster Management Agency (Badan Nasional Penanggulangan Bencana BNPB), the Ministry of Health (MoH), and media reports.
