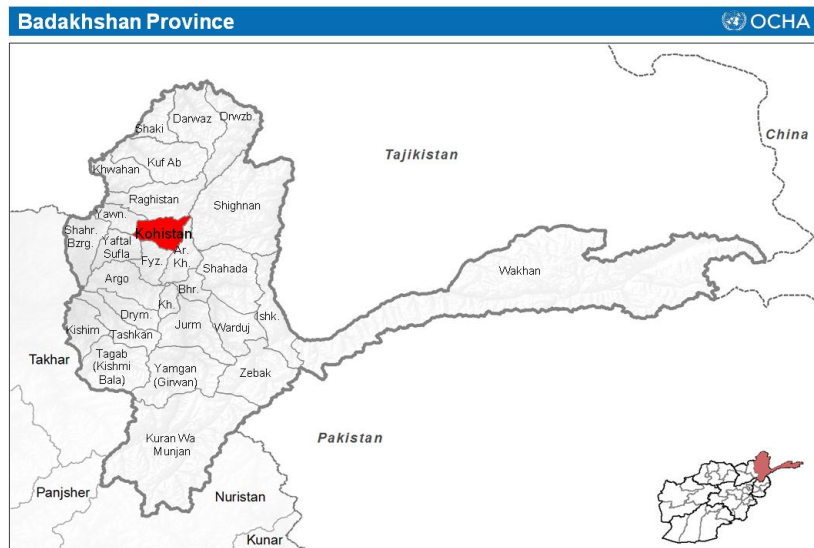
I. HIGHLIGHTS/KEY PRIORITIES

- According to Kohistan district governor and ANDMA Badakhshan, one person died and 14 others injured due to avalanche on 30 December, 2012.
- The injured people were shifted to Kohistan district health clinic for treatment.

II. Situation Overview

On 2 January 2013, ANDMA Badakhshan and Kohistan district governor reported that the toll of injuries due to avalanche increased to 14 people.

ANDMA Badakhshan reported that an avalanche occurred in the morning of 30 December, 2012 in Farghil village of Kohistan district in Badakhshan province. The district chief of Kohistan informed OCHA that a group of people were trapped in avalanche when they were repairing the Farghil village's Micro hydro power.

III. Humanitarian Needs and Response

Needs: The incident has been assessed by district team.

Response: The 14 injured people have been shifted to district health clinic for medical treatment. ANDMA will pay 50,000 Afghanis (~\$1000) to the family of deceased and 15,000 Afghanis (~\$300) for each injured person.

Gaps & Constraints: no gaps
