KURRAM LATEST

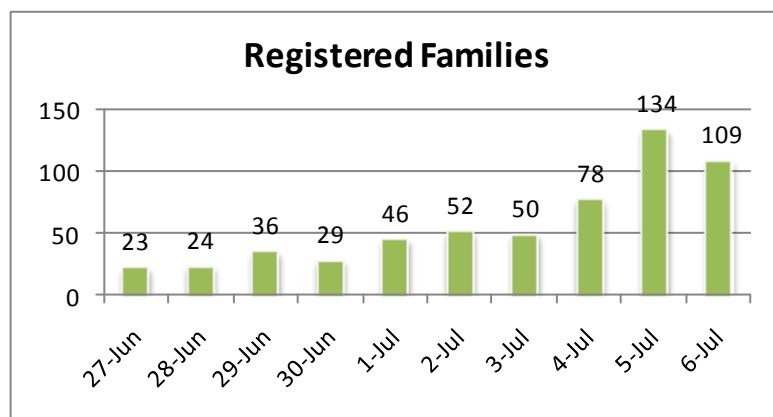
Due to ongoing operation against miscreants in Central Kurram Agency, approx. 6,000+ families are expected to be displaced. FATA Disaster Management Authority, with support of UNHCR has established an IDP camp named as 'New Durani' at Lower Kurram Agency. The camp is situated at distance of 06 km from Sadda, in close proximity of x-Afghan Refugees camp on Tindo Road.



AT A GLANCE

- UN DSS Mission has successfully returned from Kurram, and will share their findings within two days. Based on the UNDSS Security Assessment Report, Humanitarian Agencies will decide about full fledged intervention at New Durrani Camp.
- Off-camp informal registration of IDPs is in progress, and more than 6,000 families have registered in surrounding areas of camp. Majority of these families were already displaced due to sectarian conflict in Kurram.

<p>WaSH:</p> <p>15 Latrines are functional, while work is continued on more latrines.</p> <p>20 Water Tanks are available for drinking water storage.</p> <p>5 Tankers are supplying water, where each tanker make 6-8 rounds a day, which is supplying approx.</p>	<p>Total of 171 Latrines are needed per minimum Sphere Standard (1:20 Latrines/Person).</p> <p>Total of 51,300 liters/day of water is needed as per minimum Sphere Standard (1:15 liters p/p/day)</p> <p>There is fear of breakout of diarrhea and other diseases.</p>
<p>HEALTH:</p> <p>Agency Surgeon is providing OPD Services.</p> <p>WHO has initiated emergency response. They have deployed surveillance officer to monitor the situation, and stocked up the medicine with Health Directorate FATA.</p>	<p>As the population increase quickly, there is dire need of comprehensive health interventions.</p> <p>Insecticides are immediately needed as precaution against poisonous insects.</p>
<p>EDUCATION:</p> <p>One school has been made functional with support of 6 volunteer teachers. Currently 200 children are enrolled in this school</p>	<p>Proper school tent is needed.</p> <p>Stationary kits, and facilities are needed for proper functioning of the school.</p>
