

## DSWD DROMIC Terminal Report on the Social Disorganization in Polomolok, South Cotabato

02 September 2021, 6PM

### I. Situation Overview

*This is the final report on the monitored displacement of families residing at Purok 1, 2, and 6 of Brgy. Lapu, and Purok Datu Tinimbang of Brgy. Bentung in Polomolok, South Cotabato on 24 July 2021 due to the presence of alleged armed group.*

A total of **341 families** or **1,705 persons** were affected in **Polomolok, South Cotabato** (see Table 1).

### III. Status of Displaced Population

#### a. Inside Evacuation Centers

A total of **112 families** or **560 persons** sought temporary shelter in **two (2) evacuation centers** (see Table 2). All of these families have returned home.
