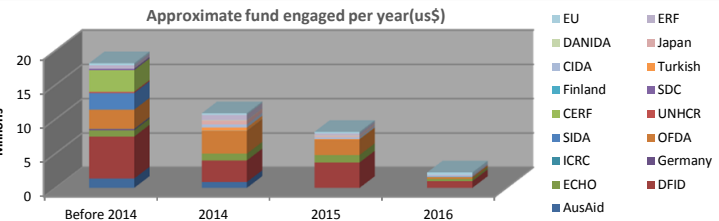
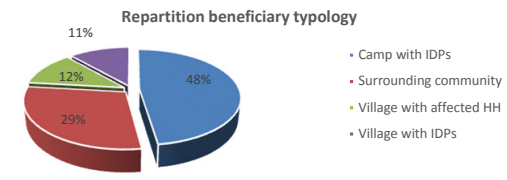
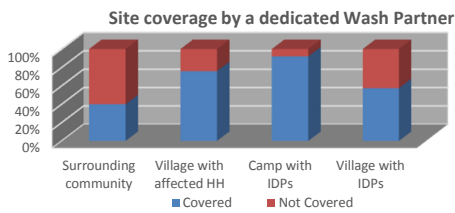
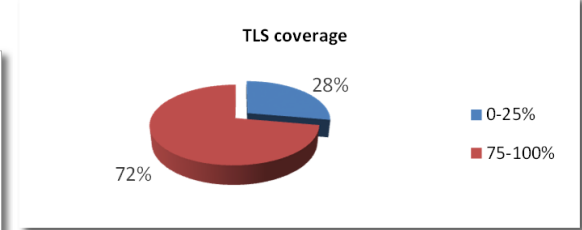
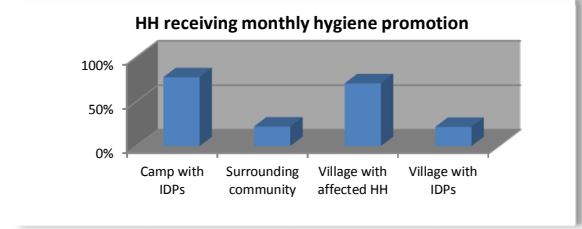
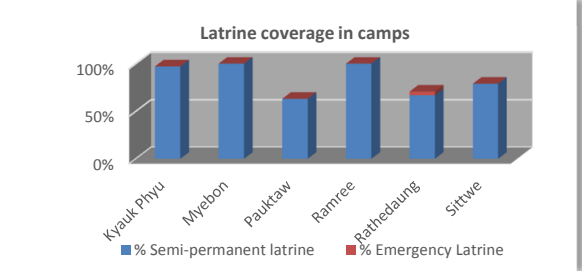
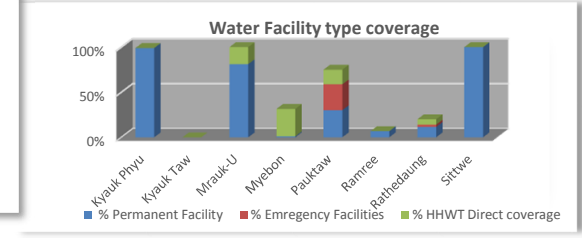
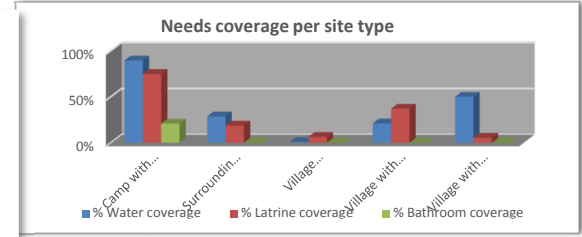
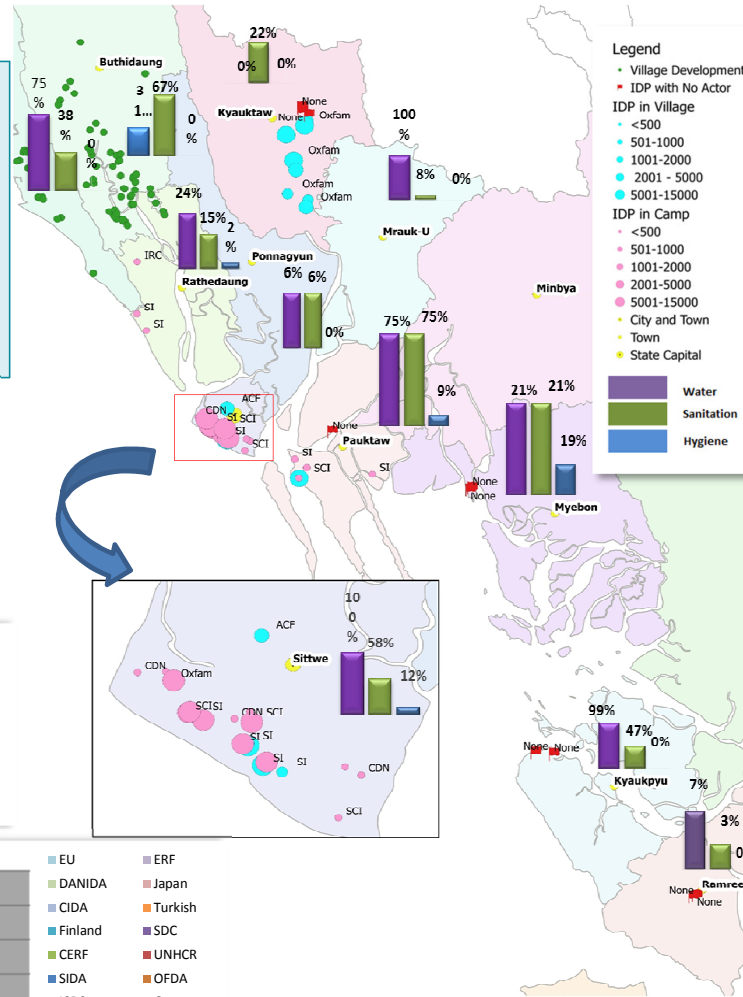


HIGHLIGHTS OF THE MONTH
