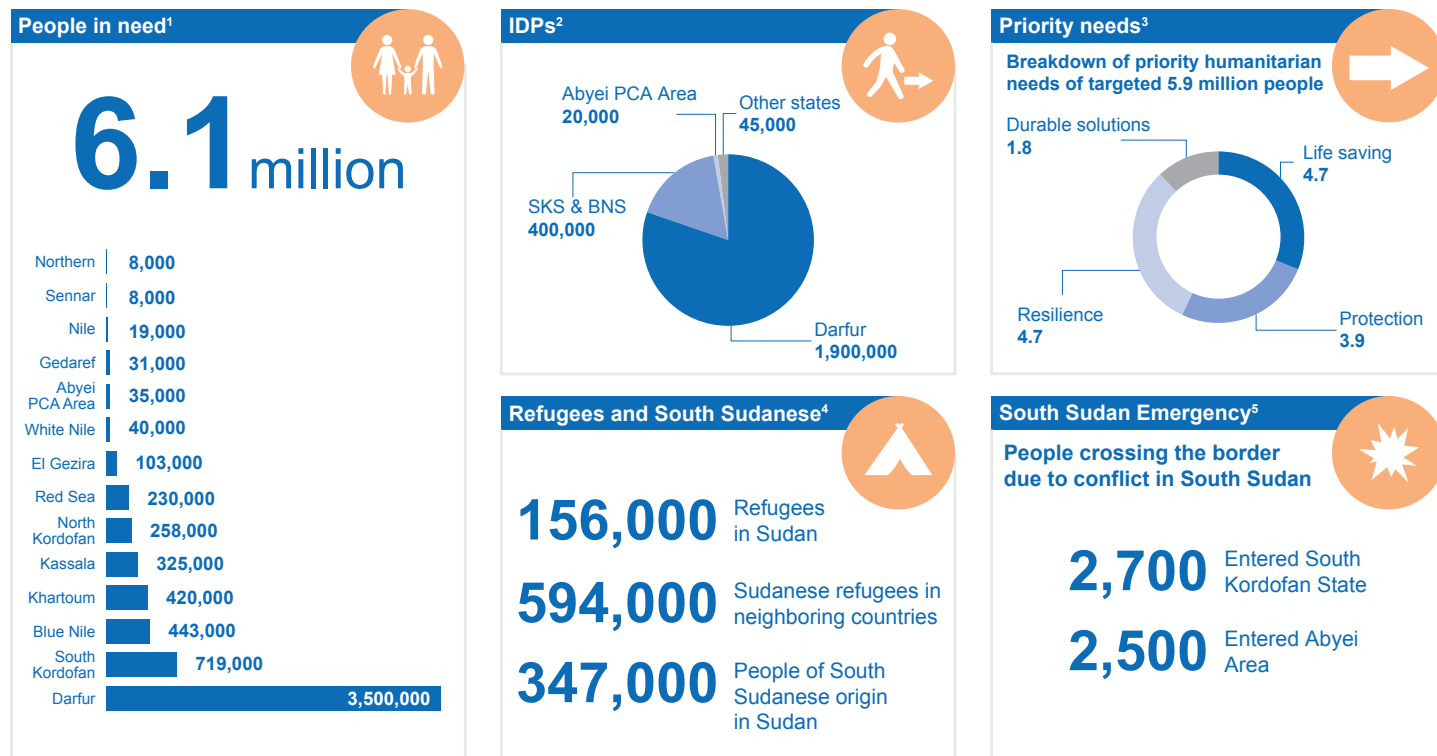


OVERVIEW

A total of 6.1 million people are in need of humanitarian assistance in Sudan. In 2013, the humanitarian situation deteriorated with more people displaced throughout the Darfur states, South and North Kordofan, and Blue Nile. For 2014, the UN and its partners are targeting 5.9 million people for humanitarian assistance. This includes life-saving interventions, protection from conflict and violence, strengthening coping mechanisms, and supporting longer-term solutions to IDPs and Refugees.

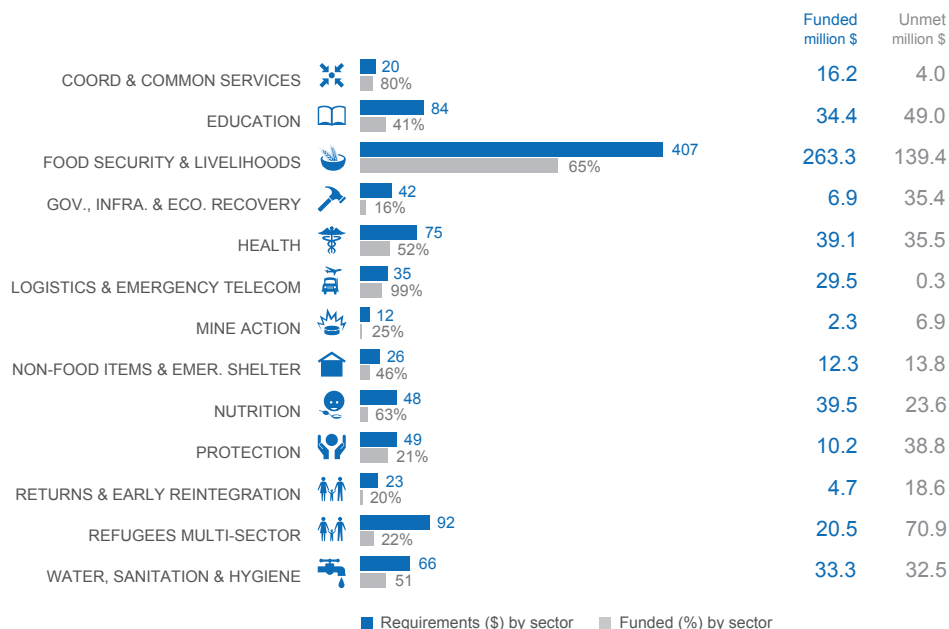


FUNDING: SUDAN HUMANITARIAN WORK PLAN 2013⁶
