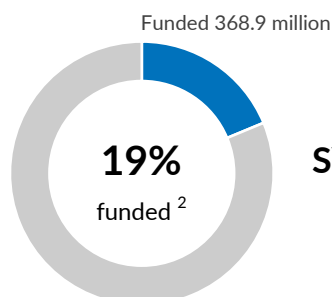

Notes:

1. The financial requirements of the Syria Situation Response include requirements in Albania, Algeria, Armenia, Belarus, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Egypt, Iraq, Italy, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Malta, Mauritania, Montenegro, Morocco, Republic of Moldova, Russian Federation, Saudi Arabia, Serbia, Spain, Sudan, Syria Regional Refugee Coordin, Syrian Arab Republic, the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Tunisia, Turkey and United Arab Emirates. The total figure includes support costs.
2. The percentage funded is calculated using earmarked contributions pending the eventual allocation of broadly earmarked and unearmarked contributions.
3. Contributions are shown by the level of flexibility in the earmarking. Contributions earmarked to a situation within a country are classified as country level.
4. The broadly earmarked contributions listed are those which can potentially be used for the Syria Situation Response due to their earmarking to a related region, sub-region, country or theme. The total amount of the contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$2 million and more.
5. The total amount of unearmarked contributions is shown for donors who have contributed \$10 million and more.
