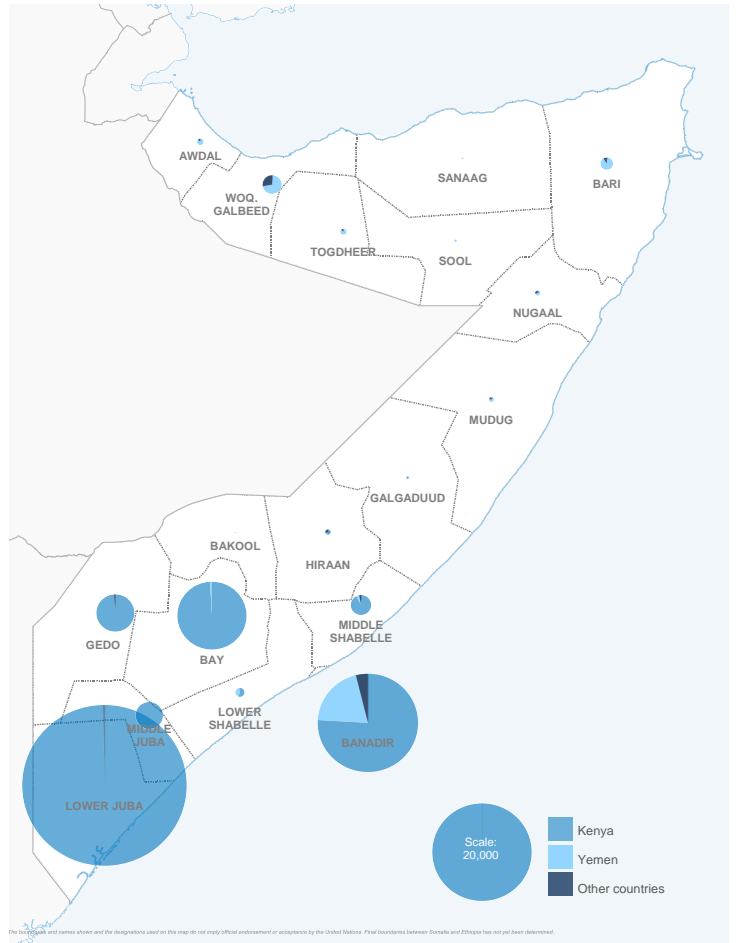
refugee returnees (2014 - 2020)

This figure includes Voluntary Repatriation from Kenya (84,982) and Assisted Spontaneous Returnees (ASR) from Yemen (5,416) as well as 1,431 returnees from other countries such as Djibouti (773), Libya (469), Sudan (143), Eritrea (34), Angola, Tunisia, Pakistan, Gambia and others. Somali refugees from these or other countries who return spontaneously without assistance from UNHCR are not included.

Programmes on voluntary repatriation from Kenya and assisted returns from Yemen are currently suspended as a COVID-19 measure.

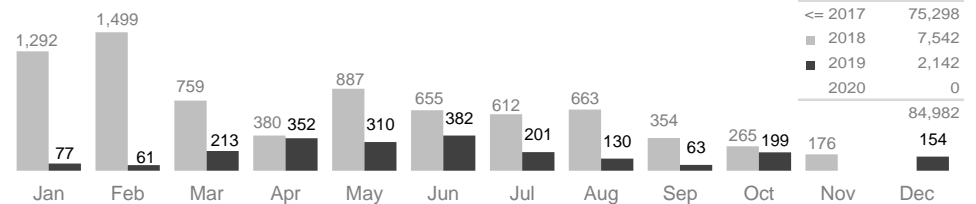

Data on destinations for returnees from Kenya is generally based on the place of initial return. In the case of arrivals by road convoy in 2017, the final destination declared on arrival is used.

RETURNEES FROM KENYA BY MONTH

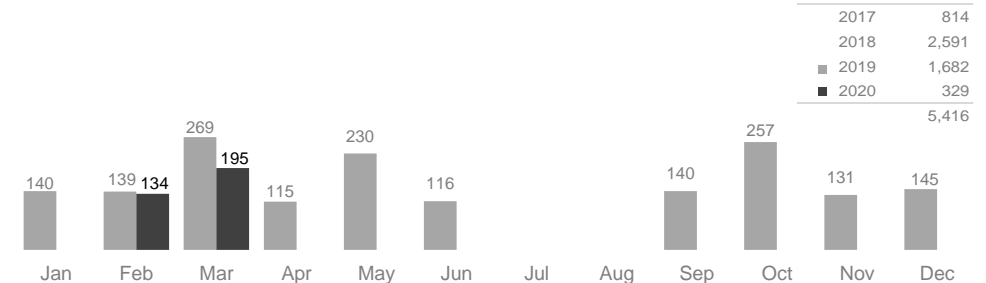

In addition to the 5,416 Assisted Spontaneous Returns (ASR) since 2017, some approximately 38,961 Somalis were monitored as arriving from Yemen since March 2015.

ASR RETURNEES FROM YEMEN BY MONTH

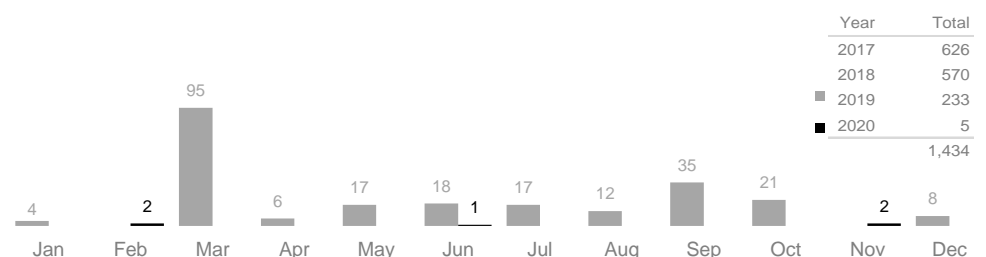

Returns from other countries include Djibouti (773), Libya (469), Sudan (143), Eritrea (34), Angola, Tunisia, Pakistan, Gambia and others. Figures for total returnees from Djibouti have been adjusted downwards by 49 as a result of double counting in reporting for arrivals in Oct 2018.
